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Sub: Depression over southeast Uttar Pradesh

The Depression over Northeast Madhya Pradesh & adjoining north Chhattisgarh moved very fast north-northwestwards with a speed of 25 kmph during past 06 hours and lay centered at 1730 hrs IST of today, the 26th September 2026 over southeast Uttar Pradesh, near latitude 26.0°N and longitude 81.3°E, about 30 km south-southwest of Fursatganj (Uttar Pradesh), 50 km east of Fatehpur (Uttar Pradesh), 100 km east-southeast of Kanpur (Uttar Pradesh) and 100 km south-southeast of Lucknow (Uttar Pradesh) and 220 km south-southeast of Kheri (Uttar Pradesh).

It is very likely to move north-northwestwards across east Uttar Pradesh and weaken gradually into a Well-Marked Low Pressure Area during next 12 hours.

The system is under continuous surveillance by Doppler Weather Radar at Lucknow.

Forecast track and intensity are given in the following table:

Warnings:

(i) Rainfall Warning:

East Uttar Pradesh: Light to moderate rainfall at most places with **heavy to very heavy rainfall** at a few places and **extremely heavy rainfall** at isolated places is very likely on 26th and **heavy rainfall** at isolated places on 27th September.

West Uttar Pradesh: Light to moderate rainfall at most places with **heavy to very heavy rainfall** at a few places and **extremely heavy rainfall** at isolated places is very likely on 26th September and **very heavy rainfall** at isolated places on 27th September.

Madhya Pradesh: Light to moderate rainfall at many places with **isolated heavy to very heavy rainfall** is very likely on 26th and isolated **heavy rainfall** over North Madhya Pradesh on 27th September.

Uttarakhand: Light to moderate rainfall at most places with **heavy to very heavy rainfall** at a few places and **extremely heavy rainfall** at isolated places is very likely on 26th & 27th and **heavy rainfall** at isolated places on 28th September.

Chhattisgarh: Light to moderate rainfall at most places **heavy to very heavy rainfall** at isolated places over north Chhattisgarh is likely on 26th September.

Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim: Light to moderate rainfall at many places with **isolated heavy to very heavy rainfall** is very likely on 26th September.

Bihar: Light to moderate rainfall at many places with **isolated heavy to very heavy rainfall** is very likely over northwest Bihar on 26th September.

Jharkhand: Light to moderate rainfall at many places with **heavy rainfall** at isolated places is very likely on 26th September.

Odisha: Light to moderate rainfall at most places with **heavy rainfall** at isolated places over North Odisha is likely on 26th September.

(ii) Wind warning:

Squally wind with speed reaching 35-45 kmph gusting to 55 kmph is prevailing over south Uttar Pradesh adjoining north Madhya Pradesh and becoming 25-35 kmph gusting to 45 kmph over north Uttar Pradesh & adjoining areas of Uttarakhand on 27th September and decrease gradually thereafter.

(iii) Impact expected (Madhya Pradesh, Uttar Pradesh, Uttarakhand, adjoining areas of North Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand & Bihar and Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim for heavy rainfall):

- ❖ Breaking of tree branches, uprooting of small trees like banana, papaya, drum sticks.
- ❖ Strong wind and rain may damage plantation, horticulture and standing crops.
- ❖ Partial damage to vulnerable structures due to strong wind & heavy rain.
- ❖ Minor damage to kutcha houses/walls, huts and roads due to heavy rain.
- ❖ Road and rail traffic may be affected due to heavy rain and squally winds.
- ❖ There could be localised landslides, mudslides, landslips in hilly areas and water logging, inundation and flooding over low-lying areas.
- ❖ Occasional reduction in visibility due to heavy rainfall.
- ❖ Helicopter services may get affected.

Action suggested:

- ❖ People are advised to keep a watch on the weather for worsening conditions and be ready to move to safer places accordingly. People may stay in safe places.
- ❖ Surface transport, Tourism and recreational activities to be regulated.
- ❖ Helicopter services to be regulated.
- ❖ Take safe shelters; do not take shelter under trees, as there could be lightning.
- ❖ In case of expected lightning, unplug electrical/ electronic appliances, immediately, get out of water bodies and keep away from all the objects that conduct electricity.

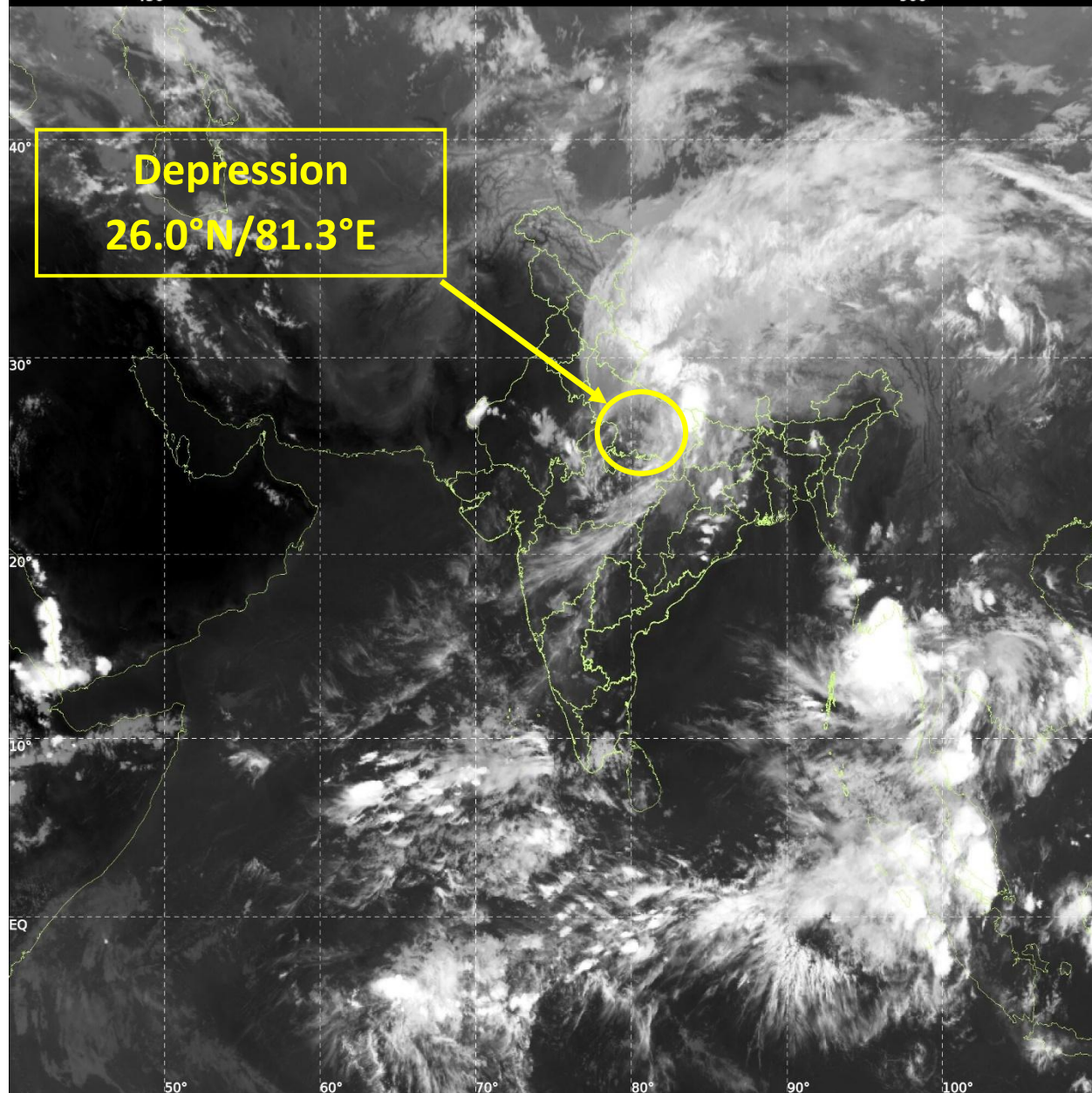

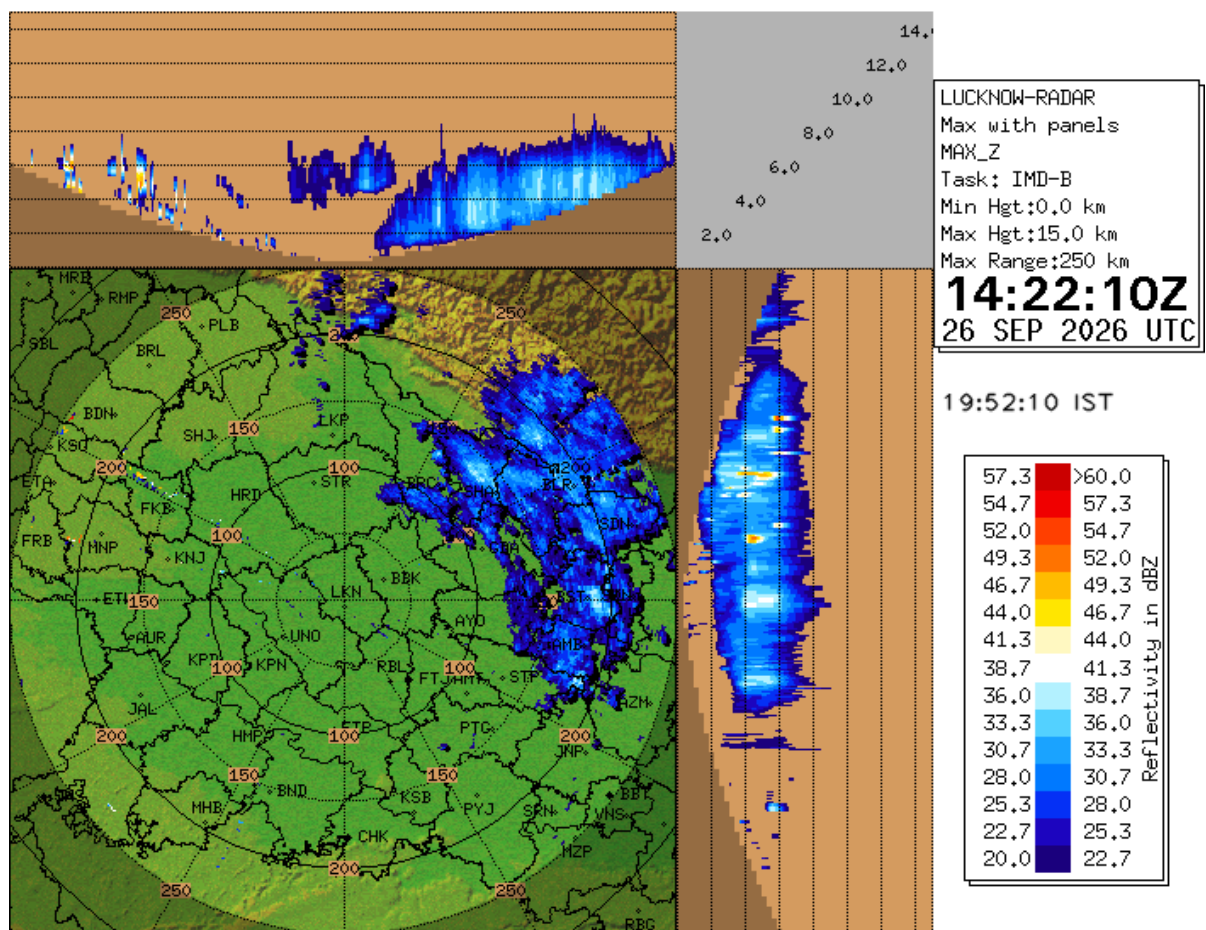

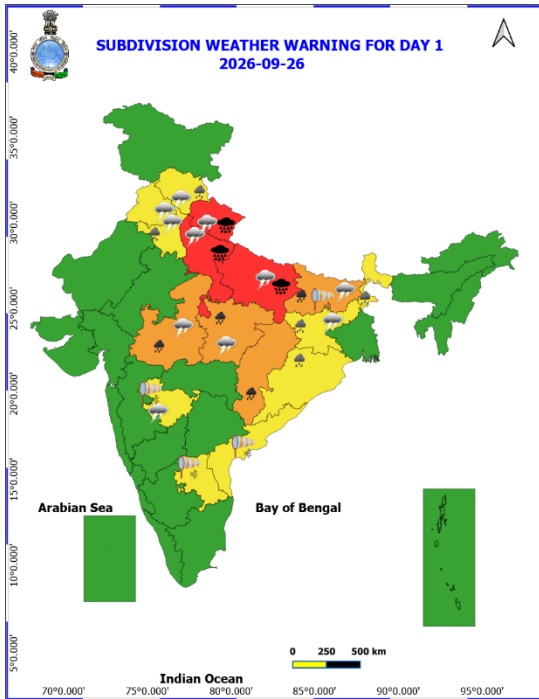

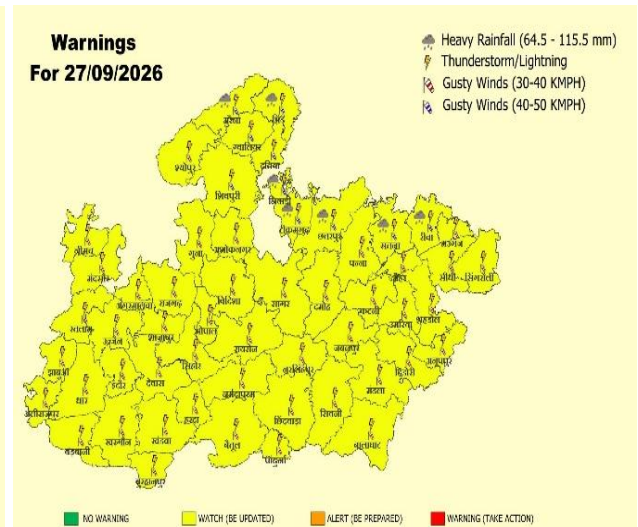
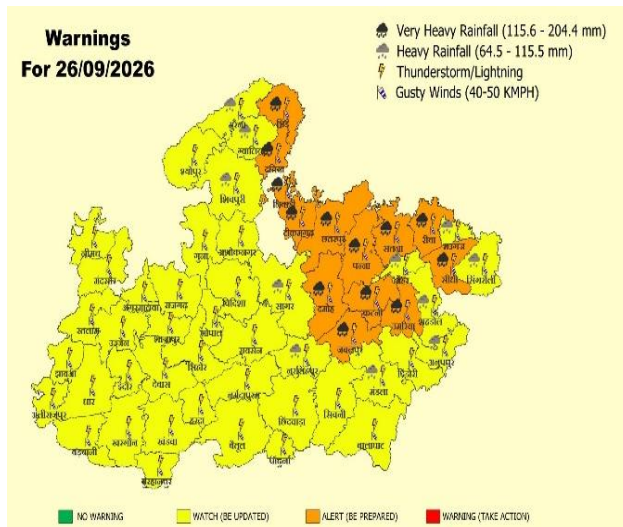




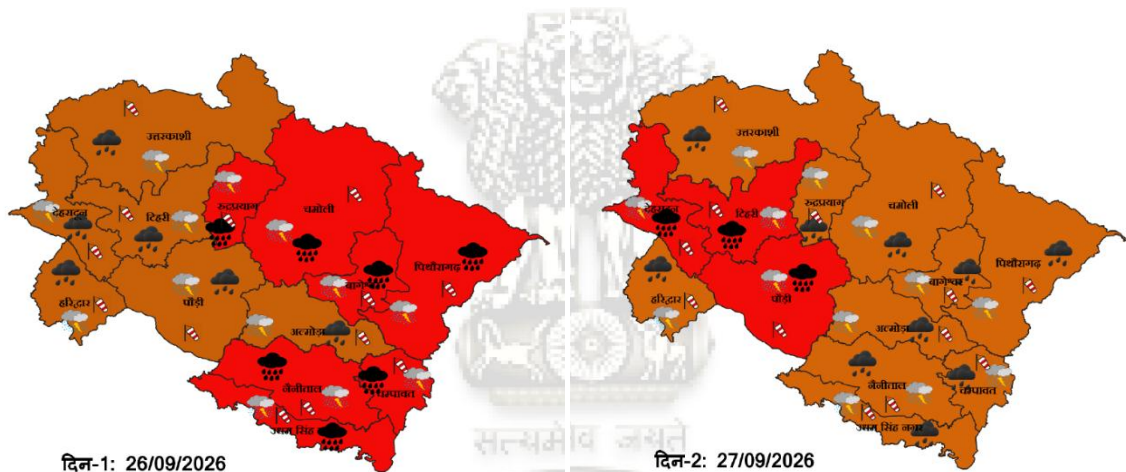
District-wise Warning of Uttar Pradesh

District-wise Warning of Uttarakhand

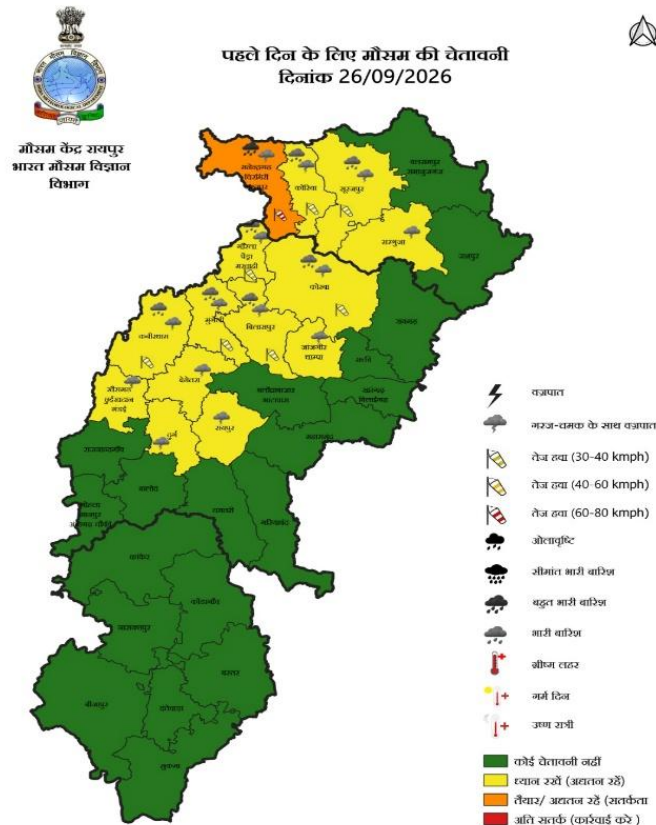

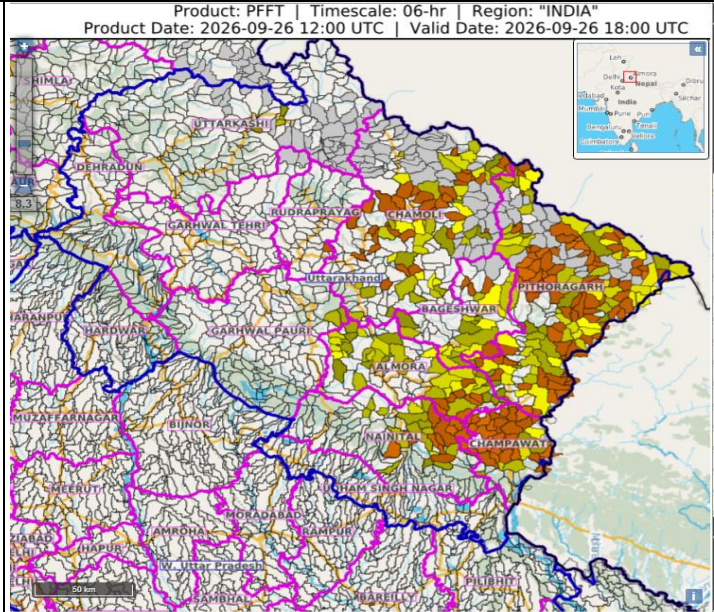
Flash Flood Guidance

Persistent Flash Flood Threat (PFFT) till 2330 IST of 26-09-2026:

Low to Moderate flash flood threat likely over few watersheds & neighbourhoods of following Met Sub-divisions during next 6 hours.

Uttarakhand: Almora, Bageshwar, Champawat, Chamoli, Nainital and Pithoragarh district

Surface runoff/ Inundation may occur at some fully saturated soils & low-lying areas over Area of Concern (AoC) as shown in map due to expected rainfall occurrence in next 6 hours.



Flash Flood Risk (FFR) till 1730 IST of 27-09-2026:

Moderate flash flood risk likely over few watersheds & neighbourhoods of following Met Sub-divisions during next 24 hours.

Uttarakhand: Almora, Bageshwar, Chamoli, Champawat, Dehradun, Garhwal Pauri, Haridwar, Nainital, Pithoragarh, Garhwal Tehri, Rudrapur, Udham Singh Nagar and Uttarkashi districts

Himachal Pradesh: Sirmour, Shimla, Kullu Kinnaur districts

Low to Moderate flash flood risk likely over few watersheds & neighbourhoods of following Met Sub-divisions during next 24 hours.

West Uttar Pradesh: Amroha, Bijnour, Badaun, Bareilly, Firozabad, Kasganj, Muzzaffarpur, Pilibhit, Shahjahanpur, Sambhal. Rampur and Moradabad districts

Surface runoff/ Inundation may occur at some fully saturated soils & low-lying areas over Area of Concern (AoC) as shown in map due to expected rainfall occurrence in next 24 hours.
