> Press Release Date: 18th July, 2023 Time of Issue: 1345 hours IST

Subject: i) Increase in rainfall activity along west coast likely to continue with heavy to very heavy rainfall spell over Konkan & Goa & Madhya Maharashtra during next 05 days and over Gujarat, Chhattisgarh, Vidarbha, Telangana & Odisha during next 03 days.

ii) Subdued rainfall activity likely over northeast & adjoining east India and over plains of northwest India (except East Rajasthan) during next 4-5 days.

Weather observed during past 24 hours ending at 0830 hours IST of today (Annexure I):

Significant Weather features:

- A cyclonic circulation lies over Northwest Bay of Bengal & adjoining coastal Odisha and extends up to middle tropospheric levels. Under its influence, a Low Pressure Area is likely to form over Northwest Bay of Bengal during next 48 hours.
- Yesterday's cyclonic circulation over south Jharkhand & neighbourhood, now lies over south Chhattisgarh & neighbourhood in lower tropospheric levels.
- The shear zone now runs roughly along Lat. 18° N between 4.5 km & 7.6 km above mean sea level tilting southwards with height.

Weather Forecast and Warning (Annexure II):

Northwest India: Light/moderate Fairly widespread to widespread rainfall with isolated **heavy rainfall** is very likely over Jammu-Kashmir-Ladakh-Gilgit-Baltistan-Muzaffarabad, Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, East Rajasthan during 18th-22nd; Himachal Pradesh on 18th, 20th & 21nd; West Rajasthan during 18th-19th; Haryana, Chandigarh& Delhi, West Uttar Pradesh on 18th July 2023.

Isolated very heavy rainfall also very likely over Uttarakhand on 18th, 21st and 22nd and over East Rajasthan on 18th & 22nd July.

Central India: Light/moderate fairly widespread to widespread rainfall **and thunderstorm & lightning** and **isolated heavy rainfall** is very likely over the region during next 5 days. **Isolated very heavy rainfall** also likely over Madhya Pradesh on 18th & 22nd, Vidarbha during 18th -20th and over Chhattisgarh during 18-22nd July.

West India: Light/moderate fairly widespread to widespread rainfall with **isolated heavy to very heavy rainfall** very likely to continue over Maharashtra (except Marathwada) during next 5 days and over Gujarat during next 3 days.

Isolated heavy to very heavy rainfall very likely to continue over Mumbai during next 03 days.

Isolated extremely heavy rainfall likely over Konkan & Goa, ghat areas of Madhya Maharashtra on 18th & 19th and over Gujarat state on 19th July.

South India: Light/moderate fairly widespread to widespread rainfall with **isolated heavy rainfall** very likely to over Kerala, Coastal & South Interior Karnataka & Telangana during next 5 days; over coastal Andhra Pradesh on 18th, 19th & 22nd and over North interior Karnataka during 18th-20nd July. **Isolated very heavy rainfall** also likely over coastal Andhra Pradesh and North interior Karnataka on 18th, over coastal Karnataka on 18th & 19th and over Telangana (including Hyderabad) on 18th -20th July.

Isolated Extremely Heavy rainfall also very likely over Telangana on 18th July.

East India: Light/moderate Fairly widespread to widespread rainfall with isolated **heavy to very heavy rainfall** very likely over Odisha and **heavy rainfall** over Andaman & Nicobar Islands during next 5 days. **Isolated extremely heavy rainfall also likely over south Odisha on 18th July.**

Northeast India: Light/moderate Scattered to Fairly widespread rainfall likely over the region. **Isolated heavy rainfall** likely over South Assam & Meghalaya and Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura 20th-22nd July.





Agromet advisories for heavy rainfall likely over various parts of the country

- Drain out excess water from crop fields to avoid water stagnation in Jammu & Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Rajasthan, Odisha, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Gujarat state, Konkan & Goa, ghat areas of Madhya Maharashtra, Vidarbha, Kerala, Karnataka, Coastal Andhra Pradesh and Telangana.
- Postpone transplanting of rice in Uttarakhand and South Gujarat. Postpone direct sowing of rice in Telangana.
- > Postpone sowing of maize, soybean and vegetables in Uttarakhand.

Impact & Action Suggested due to very heavy rainfall over

Konkan & Goa(including Mumbai) & Madhya Maharashtra during next 05 days and over Gujarat, Chhattisgarh, Vidarbha, Telangana(including Hyderabad) & Odisha during next 03 days.

Uttarkahand, East Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh, Coastal Andhara Pradesh, Coastal Karnataka on 18th July.

A. Impact Expected

- Localized Flooding of roads, water logging in low lying areas and closure of underpasses mainly in urban areas of the above region.
- Occasional reduction in visibility due to heavy rainfall.
- Disruption of traffic in major cities due to water logging in roads leading to increased travel time.
- ✤ Minor damage to kutcha roads.

- Possibilities of damage to vulnerable structure.
- Localized Landslides/Mudslides in the hilly areas.
- ◆ Damage to horticulture and standing crops in some areas due to inundation.
- It may lead to riverine flooding in some river catchments (for riverine flooding please visit Web page of CWC).


B. Action Suggested

- Check for traffic congestion on your route before leaving for your destination.
- Follow any traffic advisories that are issued in this regard.
- ✤ Avoid going to areas that face the water logging problems often.
- ✤ Avoid staying in vulnerable structure.

24 hours Outlook for the Flash Flood Risk (FFR) till 1130 IST of 19-07-2023 :



24 hours Outlook for the Flash Flood Risk (FFR) till 1130 IST of 19-07-2023 :

Moderate flash flood risk likely over few watersheds & neighbourhoods of Konkan & Goa adjoining Southern parts of Gujarat Region and Saurashtra & Kutch Met Subdivisions during next 24 hours.

Surface runoff/ Inundation may occur at some fully saturated soils & low-lying areas over AoC as shown in map due to expected rainfall occurrence in next 24 hours.
