

Press Release Date: 20th August, 2022 Time of Issue: 1350 hrs IST

Subject: i) Deep Depression over south Jharkhand and adjoining North Odisha continue to move westnorthwestwards across Jharkhand and North Chhattisgarh towards north Madhya Pradesh during next 24 hours and weaken gradually.

ii) Subdued rainfall over southern parts of Peninsula likely to continue during next 3 days.

Weather observed during past 24 hours ending at 0830 hrs IST of today: (Refer Annex. I)

Weather systems, rainfall/thunderstorm Forecast & Warnings: (Warning Graphics in Annexure II)

- > Yesterday's Depression over Northwest and adjoining Northeast Bay of Bengal intensified into a **Deep Depression** same area at 1130 hours IST of 19 Aug, it moved west-northwest wards and crossed West Bengal & adjoining north Odisha coast close to Digha during 1900-2000 IST of 19 Aug. It continued to move west-northwest wards and lay centered at 0830 hrs IST of today, the 20th August, 2022 over south Jharkhand and adjoining North Odisha near latitude 22.7°N and longitude 85.6°E, about 60 km west-southwest of Jamshedpur (Jharkhand), about 70 km south-southeast of Ranchi (Jharkhand), and 170 km east-northeast of Jharsuguda (Odisha). It would continue to move west-northwestwards across Jharkhand and North Chhattisgarh towards north Madhya Pradesh during next 24 hours and weaken gradually. (**Annexure III**).
- The western end of the monsoon trough at mean sea level continues to run along the foothills of Himalayas and its eastern end runs south of the normal position.
- Under the influence of the above systems:
 - Fairly widespread/widespread light/moderate rainfall with isolated/scattered heavy to very heavy rainfall with extremely heavy falls at isolated also likely over East Madhya Pradesh and Chhattisgarh on 20th, West Madhya Pradesh on 21st and East Rajasthan on 22nd, August, 2022.
 - Fairly widespread/widespread light/moderate rainfall with isolated **heavy to very heavy falls** and **thunderstorm/lightning** very likely over Jharkhand, Odisha & Vidarbha on 20th, East Rajasthan on 20th & 21th, East Madhya Pradesh on 21st, ghat areas of Madhya Maharashtra on 21st & 22nd, West Madhya Pradesh on 22nd and West Rajasthan & northern parts of Gujarat Region on 23rd August, 2022.
 - Fairly widespread/widespread light/moderate rainfall with isolated **heavy falls** and **thunderstorm/lightning** very likely over Gangetic West Bengal on 20th, West Madhya Pradesh & ghat areas of Madhya Maharashtra on 20th & 23rd, Vidarbha & Chhattisgarh on 21th, Konkan & Goa during 21st -23rd, East Rajasthan on 23rd and West Rajasthan & northern parts of Gujarat Region on 22nd & 24th August, 2022.

- Fairly widespread/widespread light/moderate rainfall with isolated heavy falls and thunderstorm/lightning very likely over Jammu, Kashmir, Ladakh, Gilgit, Baltistan & Muzaffarabad on 20th, Himachal Pradesh during 20th-24th, Uttarakhand on 20th, 21st & 24th, West Uttar Pradesh on 20th, 21st and over East Uttar Pradesh on 20th & 24th, Punjab on 22nd and over Haryana on 21st & 22nd August, 2022.
- o Isolated very heavy rainfall also likely over Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand on 20th August, 2022.
- Fairly widespread light/moderate rainfall with isolated heavy falls and thunderstorm/lightning very likely over Assam & Meghalaya and Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura on 22nd & 23rd August, 2022.
- Fairly widespread to widespread light/moderate rainfall with isolated heavy falls and thunderstorm/lightning very likely over Coastal Karnataka during 22nd-24th, South Interior Karnataka and Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal on 23rd & 24th and Kerala & Mahe on 22nd & 23rd August, 2022.
- o Isolated **very heavy** rainfall also likely over Kerala & Mahe on 24th August, 2022.
- Widespread light/moderate rainfall with isolated heavy falls and thunderstorm/lightning very likely over Andaman & Nicobar Islands during 20th-22nd August, 2022.



Heavy to very heavy rainfall with extremely heavy falls at isolated places occurred over Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand and Odisha; heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places over Jharkhand, Gangetic West Bengal and ghat area of Madhya Maharashtra and heavy rainfall at isolated places over Jammu & Kashmir, Uttar Pradesh, East Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Bihar, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal, Meghalaya, Marathwada and Tamil Nadu.

EXPECTED IMPACT & ACTION SUGGESTED DUE TO-

- i) Isolated extremely heavy rainfall over East Rajasthan on 22th; over West Madhya Pradesh on 21st; East Madhya Pradesh and Chhattisgarh on 20th August, 2022.
- ii) Isolated very heavy rainfall over Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand on 20th; West Rajasthan on 23rd; East Rajasthan on 20th & 21st; West Madhya Pradesh on 22nd; East Madhya Pradesh on 21st; Vidarbha, Jharkhand and Odisha on 20th August, 2022.


A. Impact Expected

- Localized Flooding of roads, water logging in low lying areas and closure of underpasses mainly in urban areas of the above region.
- Occasional reduction in visibility due to heavy rainfall.
- Disruption of traffic in major cities due to water logging in roads leading to increased travel time.
- Minor damage to kutcha roads.
- Possibilities of damage to vulnerable structure.
- Localized Landslides/Mudslides
- Damage to horticulture and standing crops in some areas due to inundation.
- It may lead to riverine flooding in some river catchments (for riverine flooding please visit Web page of CWC)

B. Action Suggested

- Check for traffic congestion on your route before leaving for your destination.
- Follow any traffic advisories that are issued in this regard.
- Avoid going to areas that face the water logging problems often.
- Avoid staying in vulnerable structure.

- 5) **West India:** Gujarat Region, Saurashtra & Kutch, Konkan & Goa, Madhya Maharashtra and Marathwada.
- 6) **South India:** Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Telangana, Rayalaseema, Coastal Karnataka, North Interior Karnataka, South Interior Karnataka, Kerala & Mahe, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal and Lakshadweep.
