Special weather bulletin - 11 Heavy to very heavy rainfall activity over Goa

1. Heavy to very heavy rainfall activity over Goa

- ❖ The trough at mean sea level now runs off Maharashtra-north Kerala coasts
- ❖ A shear zone runs roughly along 17° N between 3.1 & 5.8 km above mean sea level tilting southwards with height.
- ❖ The cyclonic circulation over westcentral & adjoining northwest Bay of Bengal now lies over northwest & adjoining westcentral Bay of Bengal and extends upto 5.8 km above mean sea level tilting southwestwards with height.
- The cyclonic circulation over central Gujarat & neighbourhood persists and extends upto 4.5 km above mean sea level tilting southwards with height.
- With the strengthening of Southwest Monsoon, strong south-westerly/westerly winds are likely to prevail in the lower levels.
- ♦ Heavy rainfall (rainfall>64.4mm in 24 hrs) to very heavy rainfall (rainfall>115.5mm in 24 hrs) is very likely at isolated places over North & South Goa districts on 27th June 2024.
- Heavy rainfall is very likely at isolated places over North & South Goa districts on 28th, 29th, 30th June 2024 & 1st July 2024. Short intense spells and strong surface winds gusting to 50kmph likely along with the rainfall spells.





5. 24 HOURS OUTLOOK FOR THE FLASH FLOOD RISK (FFR) TILL 1130 IST OF 28-06-2024



Low to Moderate flash flood risk likely over few watersheds & neighbourhoods of Konkan & Goa during next 24 hours. Surface runoff/ Inundation may occur at some fully saturated soils & low-lying areas over AoC as shown in map due to expected rainfall occurrence in next 24 hours.

6. PROBABLE IMPACT OF HEAVY TO VERY HEAVY RAINFALL a) HEAVY RAINFALL

- Some pooling of water on roads and low-lying areas
- Rough sea conditions along the coast
- Possibility of traffic congestions
- Short term water logging/inundation on roads and low-lying areas
- Possibility of water inundation on agriculture fields
- Fall of weak trees and weak structures
- Localized and short-term disruption to municipal services (water, electricity, etc.)
- Temporary fall in visibility during intense spells of rain

b) VERY HEAVY RAINFALL

- Some pooling of water on roads and low-lying areas
- Localized mudslides
- Rough sea conditions along the coast
- Possibility of traffic congestions
- Short term water logging/flooding of roads and low-lying areas leading water entering homes and shops at areas such as 18th June road, Patto, Mala, Taleigao and other vulnerable areas.
- Roofing sheets may get dislocated in strong winds
- Possibility of water inundation on agriculture fields
- Fall of weak trees and weak structures, trees may uproot, breaking of branches and major damage to horticulture crops
- Localized and short-term disruption to municipal services (water, electricity, etc.)
- Temporary fall in visibility during intense spells of rain
- Community services may be affected

The warnings are issued based on latest observations and numerical weather prediction model guidance. Please be regularly updated with the latest warnings and forecasts issued by IMD in coming days as the warning colours may be upgraded.
