

Subject: Depression over East Central Arabian Sea and associated weather over Maharashtra during 26-30, October 2025


#### Weather systems:

- Yesterday's Depression over eastcentral Arabian Sea moved nearly southwestwards with a speed of 13 kmph during past 6 hours and lay centered at 0830 hrs IST of today, the 26th October 2025, over the same region, near latitude 16.0°N & longitude 66.5°E, about 760 km west-southwest of Mumbai (Maharashtra), about 790 km west of Panjim (Goa), 870 km northwest of Aminidivi (Lakshadweep) and about 970 km west-northwest of Mangalore (Karnataka). It is likely to move nearly southwestwards initially and then south-southwestwards across Eastcentral Arabian Sea during the next 24 hours.
- A trough runs from the upper air cyclonic circulation associated with Depression over east central Arabian sea to West Madhya Pradesh across northeast Arabian sea and south Gujarat region between 1.5 & 3.1 km above mean sea level

Under its influence, thunderstorms accompanied with lightning & gusty wind speed reaching 40-50 kmph are very likely to occur over parts of Maharashtra between 26-30 October 2025. Fairly Widespread to Widespread moderate rainfall activity with Heavy rainfall at isolated places is expected over Konkan and Madhya Maharashtra during the above period. Isolated to scattered light/moderate rainfall accompanied with thunderstorms is expected over Marathwada, during 26-29 October 2025.

Forecast and Warning for any day is valid from 0830 hours IST of day till 0830 hours IST of next day.



#### Fishermen Warning for next 5 days:

- Warning for coastal areas for North- Maharashtra coast (upto 75km from the coast):Squally weather with wind speed 35 kmph to 45 kmph gusting to 55 kmph likely to prevail along and off North Konkan coast from 26th Oct to 30th Oct 2025. Fishermen are advised not to venture along and off the coast during this period.
- Warning for coastal areas for South Maharashtra-Goa coast (upto 75km from the coast):Squally weather with wind speed 35 kmph to 45 kmph gusting to 55 kmph likely to prevail along and off South Konkan-Goa coast from 26th Oct to 30th Oct 2025. Fishermen are advised not to venture along and off the coast during this period.
- Wind warning: Squally wind with speed reaching 45-55 gusting to 65 kmph prevailing around the system center and continue to prevail over Eastcentral and adjoining Southeast Arabian Sea till 27th October. Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph is very likely to prevail over Lakshadweep & Comorin Area and along & off Karnataka and Kerala coasts till 27th October, and wind speed reaching 35-45 kmph gusting to 55 kmph is very likely to prevail over northeast Arabian Sea and along & off Maharashtra-Goa and Gujarat coasts on 26th & 27th October.
- Sea Condition: Sea Condition is likely to be rough to very rough over Eastcentral and adjoining Southeast Arabian Sea till 27th October. Sea Condition is likely to be rough over Lakshadweep & Comorin Area and along & off Karnataka and Kerala coasts till 27th October. Sea Condition is likely to be moderate to rough over northeast Arabian Sea and along & off Maharashtra-Goa and Gujarat coasts on 26th-27th October.
- Fishermen are advised not to venture into Eastcentral and adjoining Southeast Arabian Sea, Lakshadweep & Comorin Area and along & off Karnataka and Kerala coasts till 27th October, and northeast Arabian Sea and along & off Maharashtra-Goa and Gujarat coasts on 26th-27th October.

## **Port Warning**

- Keep hoisted LC-III( Local Cautionary signal number -III) repeat LC-III at all ports from Dahanu to Shrivardhan Coast off North Maharashtra Coast.
- Keep hoisted LC-III( Local Cautionary signal number -III) repeat LC-III at all ports from Bankot to Mormugao Coast off South Maharashtra Goa Coast.



### **Impact Expected:**

- Possibility of cloud to ground lightning at isolated places.
- Fall of weak trees or weak structures due to gusty winds.
- Localized and short-term disruption of power.
- Damage to crops due to unseasonal rainfall.
- Strong wind/hail may damage plantation, horticulture, and standing crops.
- Minor damage to kutcha houses/walls and huts.
- Localized inundation/flooding of low-lying areas and urban areas.

## **Action Suggested:**

- Avoid working in open areas and fields while thunderstorms are taking place.
- Avoid taking shelter under tall trees and structures when a thunderstorm is occurring.
- Unplug electrical/electronic appliances.
- Immediately get out of water bodies.
- Keep away from all objects that conduct electricity.
