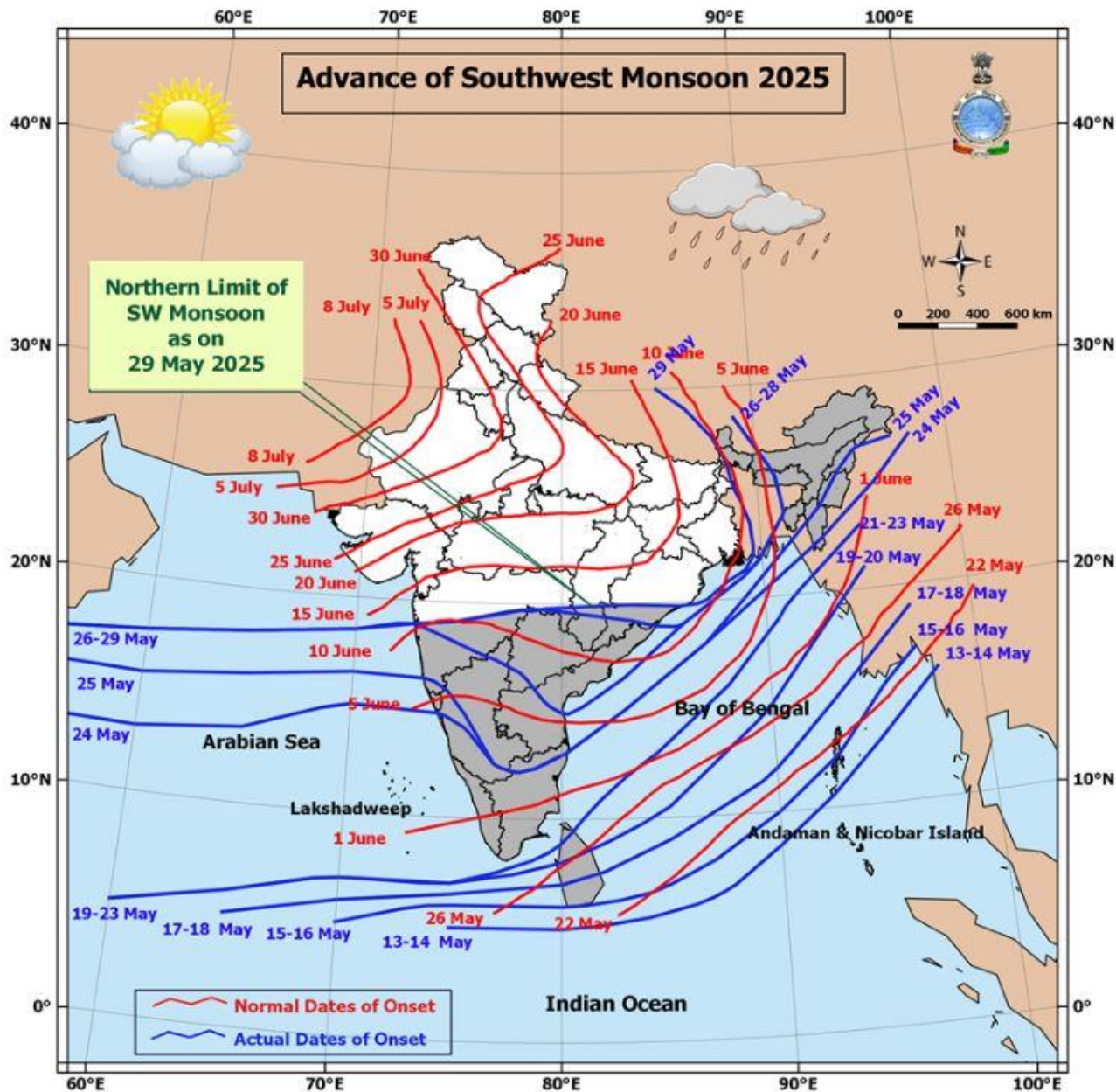

**Subject: Information on Southwest Monsoon set in over some parts of North Bengal, today the 29th May 2025.**

Southwest Monsoon has further advanced into some more parts of Chhattisgarh & Odisha, some more parts of North Bay of Bengal, remaining parts of Northeastern states and some parts of Sub-Himalayan West Bengal and entire Sikkim today, the 29th May 2025. Thus, Southwest Monsoon has set in over some parts of North Bengal today, the 29th May 2025.

The Northern Limit of Monsoon continues to pass through 17.0°N/55°E, 17.5°N/60°E, 18°N/65°E, 18.5°N/70°E, Mumbai, Ahilyanagar, Adilabad, Bhawanipatna, Puri, Sandheads, 22°N/89°E, Balurghat, 30°N/85°E.

Conditions are favourable for further advance of southwest monsoon over some more parts of West Bengal during next 1-2 days.
