Sub: <u>Enhanced rainfall activity over the western ghat areas:</u> <u>Weather warnings for Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal</u>

I. Chief synoptic situations

An upper air cyclonic circulation lies over Northwest Bay of Bengal & neighbourhood between 3.1 & 7.6 km above mean sea level tilting southwestwards with height.

Yesterday's cyclonic circulation over Westcentral Bay of Bengal off North Coastal Andhra Pradesh coast at 5.8 km above mean sea level has merged with the above cyclonic circulation over Northwest Bay of Bengal & neighbourhood.

Yesterday's upper air cyclonic circulation over Marathwada now lies over South Madhya Maharashtra & neighbourhood and extends up to 7.6 km above mean sea level titling southwestwards with height.

Moderate to strong westerly winds prevail over the southern peninsular region in the lower tropospheric levels.

II. Realised weather

Southwest monsoon over the western ghat districts has been *active* on 14th & *vigorous* on 15th June 2025.

Rainfall occurred at many places over western ghat districts and at a few places over the rest Tamilnadu, Puducherrry & Karaikal during the 24-hr ending 08:30 IST of 14th & 15th Jun 2025. *Heavy to very heavy* rain occurred at *a few* places over the **ghat areas of Coimbatore** district and *at isolated* places over **Nilgiris** district during the 24-hr ending 08:30 IST of 15th and isolated heavy rain occurred over Nilgiris district during the 24-hr ending 08:30 IST of 14th. **Avalanche (Nilgiris** district) recorded 7 cm on 14th & 14 cm on 15th Jun 2025.

III. Weather warnings for Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal

(i) Rainfall forecast and warnings for the next five days

Light to moderate rain is likely at *a few* places over Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal area during the next two days; and at *isolated* places during the subsequent three days. Strong surface winds, speed reaching 40-50 kmph at times, likely at isolated places over Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal during the next two days.

Thunderstorm & lightning is also likely at one or two places during the next two days.

Isolated heavy to very heavy rain is likely along the western ghat areas during 15th & 16th June 2025 with *extremely heavy* rain at *one or two* places over Nilgiris district on 15th. *Isolated heavy* rain is likely along the western ghat areas on 17th Jun 2025.

(iv) Impacts expected over the western ghat areas of Tamilnadu (due to recurrent heavy rainfall activity over Kerala and ghat areas of Tamilnadu during the past 2-3 days)

- \checkmark Water logging and damages to crops
- \checkmark Uprooting of trees and blockage of roads
- \checkmark Landslides / Mudslides likely in hilly areas
- \checkmark Damages to informal settlements
- \checkmark Increase in water levels in rivers, lakes & reservoirs
- \checkmark Inland flooding in some low lying areas
