Sub: Weather warnings for Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal

I. Chief synoptic situations

The Northern Limit of Monsoon continues to pass through 17.0°N/55°E, 17.5°N/60°E, 18°N/65°E, 18.5°N/70°E, Mumbai, Pune, Sholapur, Kalaburagi, Mahbubnagar, Kavali, 16.5°N/83°E, 19°N/86°E, 21°N/89°E, Agartala, Goalpara and 28.5°N/89°E.

Conditions are favourable for further advance of Southwest Monsoon into some more parts of Bay of Bengal during next 2-3 days.

Under the influence of a **cyclonic circulation** over Northwest and adjoining Westcentral Bay of Bengal, a **Low Pressure Area** has formed over Northwest Bay of Bengal off Odisha coast at 0830 hrs IST of today, the 27th May 2025. The associated cyclonic circulation extends upto 7.6 km above mean sea level tilting southwards with height. It is likely to move slowly northwards and become more marked during next 48 hours.

A **shear zone** runs roughly along the Lat. 17°N over the Indian Region between 3.1 and 7.6 km above mean sea level tilting southwards with height

II. Weather information & warnings for Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal

(i) Past rainfall summary

Southwest monsoon has been active-vigorous over Kerala, Coastal and South Interior Karnataka and western ghat districts of Tamilnadu during the past two days (24-hr ending 0830 IST of 26th & 27th May 2025.

Associated with the onset and advance of monsoon, *fairly widespread* to *widespread* rainfall has occurred over Kerala and Karnataka during the past four days (24-hr ending 0830 IST of 24th-27th May 2025) with *heavy* rainfall at *a few* places and *very heavy* – *extremely heavy* rainfall at *isolated* places over Kerala and Coastal Karnataka. *Isolated heavy to very heavy* rain with *extremely heavy* rain at *one or two places* also occurred over the ghat areas of South Interior Karnataka & Tamilnadu during the same period.

Widespread rainfall occurred **Coimbatore, Dindigul, Kanyakumari, Tenkasi, Nilgiris, Theni, Thirunelveli and Tiruppur** districts of Tamilnadu during the past two days (24-hr ending 0830 IST of 26th & 27th May 205).

Heavy-very heavy rain occurred at *a few* places over Nilgiris and ghat areas of Coimbatore district with *extremely* heavy rain at *isolated* places during the period 25th-27th May.

Avalanche (Nilgiris) reported *extremely heavy* rainfall consecutively for three days - 21 cm, 35 cm & 26 cm respectively on 25th, 26th & 27th May 2025. **Upper Bavani** (Nilgiris) recorded 30 cm and **Chinnakalar** (ghat areas of Coimbatore district) recorded 21 cm on 26th May 2025.

So far, Avalanche (Nilgiris) district has received 94 cm of rain during the past 4 days (24th-27th May 2025). Upper Bavani (Nilgiris) & Chinnakalar (Coimbatore) have recorded 53 cm & 56 cm respectively. Emerald, Pandalur, Upper Gudalur & Gudalur bazar in Nilgiris district and Siruvani dam, Cincona and Valparai in Coimbatore district have recorded 30-50 cm of rain during the same period.

(ii) Rainfall forecast and Heavy rainfall & wind warnings for the next five days

Light-moderate rainfall is likely at *isolated* places on 27th, 28th & 31st May and at *a few* places on 29th & 30 May 2025 over Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal. *Isolated heavy to very heavy rain* is very likely over the western ghat districts of Tamilnadu during 27th-30th May. *Extremely heavy rain* is also likely *at one or two places* over the Nilgiris and ghat areas of Coimbatore districts on 27th May 2025.

- ✓ Water logging and damages to crops
- ✓ Uprooting of trees and blockage of roads
- ✓ Landslides / Mudslides likely in hilly areas
- ✓ Damages to temporary structures and informal settlements
- ✓ Increase in water levels in rivers, lakes & reservoirs
- ✓ Inland flooding in some low lying areas

(vii) Advice to public: People are advised to be cautious and follow the government advisories with respect to tourism activities in the western ghat areas.

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
