PRESS RELEASE

Subject: Wet spell very likely over Himachal Pradesh during night of 25th Feb. 2025 till noon/evening of 01st Mar. 2025 with <u>isolated</u> <u>heavy to very heavy rain/snowfall on 26th, 27th and 28th Feb. 2025.</u>

Weather System

- A fresh Western Disturbance is seen as a cyclonic circulation over north Iran & neighbourhood from lower to upper tropospheric levels. Higher moisture feeding is also likely over Western Himalayan Region in lower tropospheric levels from Arabian Sea mainly during 25th-28th February, 2025. Under the influence of this western disturbance and other favourable atmospheric conditions:
- Fairly widespread to widespread rainfall/snowfall activity accompanied with thunderstorm, lightning and very likely to commence over Himachal Pradesh from midnight of 25th Feb till noon of 01th Mar. 2025 with isolated heavy to very heavy rain/snowfall on 26th, 27th and 28th Feb. 2025.

Rainfall/Snowfall:

- Light snowfall at many places with few spells of moderate snowfall very likely in the districts Lahaul-Spiti, Kinnaur and over the higher reaches of Kangra, Chamba, Shimla, Kullu, Mandi and Sirmaur districts from midnight of 25th Feb. 2025 till forenoon of 01st Mar. 2025.
- Isolated spells of heavy snowfall very likely in the district Lahaul-Spiti on dated 27th and 28th
 Feb. 2025 and in the district Kinnaur on dated 28th Feb. 2025. (*Yellow Alert*)
- 3. Light **rainfall** over many places with few spells of **moderate** rainfall accompanied with **thunderstorm & lightning** and very likely in the districts of Solan, Hamirpur, Bilaspur & Una and in the remaining parts of Kangra, Chamba, Shimla, Mandi, Sirmaur and Kullu districts from mid night of 25th Feb. 2025 till noon of 01th Mar. 2025.
- 4. <u>Isolated heavy rain/snowfall</u> very likely over Chamba, Kangra, Kullu and Mandi during 26th
 Feb. to 28th Feb. 2025 with isolated <u>very heavy rain/snowfall</u> likely on 27th Feb. 2025.
 Isolated rain/snowfall also likely over Shimla and Sirmaur on 27th and 28th Feb. 2025.
 (Orange Alert)

- 5. <u>Isolated **heavy rainfall**</u> likely in districts Una, Bilaspur, Hamirpur on 27th and 28th Feb.2025 and over Solan on 2^{8th} Feb.2025. (Yellow Alert)
- 6. Few spells of light snowfall with one or two moderate spells very likely over most of the tourist destinations in the state including Kufri, Narkanda, Manali, Solang Valley, Dalhousie and Sissu & adjoining areas and few spells of light rain/snowfall over Shimla City & adjoining areas from morning of 26th Feb. 2025 to noon of 01th Mar. 2025.

Moderate/heavy spells of rain/snowfall over the region may lead to:

- Vehicles skidding due to slippery roads.
- Low visibility.
- Possibility of vehicle collision
- Traffic congestion.
- Localised essential services may affect.
- Routine outdoor business may affect.
- Essential services may affect at some locations

Therefore, it is advised to:

- Drive carefully.
- Limit outdoor activities during the event.
- Take adequate safety measures
- Follow the state government and concerned departments advisories.

✤ <u>Temperatures</u>

No large change in minimum and maximum temperatures till 25th Feb. 2025. Thereafter, minimum temperatures very likely to rise by 4-5 °C over many parts of the state and maximum temperatures very likely to fall by 5-7 °C till 28th Feb. 2025 over many parts of the state.

<u>Cold day Conditions (Yellow Alert)</u>

Cold day conditions very likely to prevail over some parts over lower hills/ plain areas and mid hills of the state on 26th and 27th Feb. 2025. *(Impacts and advisories are attached in annexure).*


Thunderstorm/Lightning (Yellow Alert)

Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning very likely at isolated places over lower hills/ plain areas and adjoining mid hills of the state on 25th, 26th and 27th Feb. 2025. *(Impacts and advisories are attached in annexure).*


Expected Impact and Action suggested due to Cold Day, Snowfall & Thunderstorm/ Lightning conditions over Himachal Pradesh

Heavy Rain/Snowfall	High & Mid Hill areas	 Disruptions of essential services viz. water and electricity, communications and related services. Visibility conditions very likely to decrease. Vehicles skidding due to slippery roads and possibility of vehicle collision. Traffic congestion. Localised essential services may affect. Routine outdoor business may affect. Essential services may affect at some locations. 			
Thunderstorm/ Lightning	Lower & Mid hills	 Close windows and doors. Stay indoors and avoid travel if possible. Stay away from the water bodies and electrical equipments 			
Cold Day	Lower & Mid hills	 Wear several layers of loose fitting, light weight, warm woolen clothing. Keep dry, if wet, change cloths immediately. Take safety measures while using electrical and gas heating devices. Extreme care needed for vulnerable people. Seek medical attention as soon as possible if suffering from frostbite/ Hypothermia. Protect livestock from cold weather. Make adequate arrangements for animals. Make necessary arrangements to protect crops from cold and frost. Limit outdoor activities.
