Significant Weather Features

Weather forecast and Warnings:

Northwest India:

- **Fairly Widespread to Widespread** rainfall likely over Himachal Pradesh, Jammu-Kashmir-Ladakh-Gilgit-Baltistan-Muzaffarabad and Uttarakhand during 2nd-7th August.
- **Fairly Widespread to Widespread** rainfall likely over Punjab during 3rd-4th August; Haryana Chandigarh & Delhi and West Uttar Pradesh during 3rd-7th August; East Uttar Pradesh during 2nd-7th August; West Rajasthan on 2nd August.

- Isolated **heavy rainfall** likely over Himachal Pradesh, Jammu-Kashmir-Ladakh-Gilgit-Baltistan-Muzaffarabad and Uttarakhand during 2nd-7th August; Haryana Chandigarh & Delhi and Punjab during 2nd-4th August; West Uttar Pradesh during 3rd-5th August; East Uttar Pradesh during 2nd-6th August with isolated **very heavy rainfall** also likely over East Rajasthan and West Rajasthan on 2nd August.

Central India:

- **Fairly Widespread to Widespread** rainfall likely over East Madhya Pradesh during 4th-7th August; Vidarbha during 5th-6th August; Chhattisgarh during 3rd-7th August.
- **Isolated to Scattered** rainfall likely over West Madhya Pradesh during 2nd-7th August; East Madhya Pradesh during 2nd-3rd August; Vidarbha during 2nd-4th August and on 7th August; Chhattisgarh on 2nd August.
- Isolated **thunderstorm, lightning & gusty winds (speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph)** likely over West Madhya Pradesh during 2nd-5th August, **with gusty winds (speed reaching 30-40 kmph gusting to 50 kmph)** likely over East Madhya Pradesh during 2nd-5th August.
- Isolated **thunderstorm & lightning** likely over Vidarbha during 2nd-5th August; Chhattisgarh during 2nd-5th August.
- Isolated **heavy rainfall** likely over East Madhya Pradesh during 4th-7th August; Chhattisgarh during 3rd-7th August.

East India:

- **Fairly Widespread to Widespread** rainfall likely over Andaman & Nicobar Islands and Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim during 2nd-7th August; Gangetic West Bengal, Jharkhand and Odisha during 2nd-7th August; Bihar during 2nd-6th August.
- **Isolated to Scattered** rainfall likely over Bihar on 2nd August and on 7th August.
- Isolated **thunderstorm, lightning & gusty winds (speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph)** likely over Andaman & Nicobar Islands during 2nd-7th August; Jharkhand during 2nd-5th August, **with gusty winds (speed reaching 30-40 kmph gusting to 50 kmph)** likely over Gangetic West Bengal during 2nd-3rd August; Bihar during 2nd-7th August.
- Isolated **thunderstorm & lightning** likely over Gangetic West Bengal on 4th August; Odisha during 2nd-7th August.
- Isolated **heavy rainfall** likely over Andaman & Nicobar Islands during 2nd-7th August; Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim on 6th August; Gangetic West Bengal on 3rd August and during 5th-7th August; Jharkhand on 5th August; Bihar during 2nd-5th August; Odisha during 2nd-7th August with isolated **very heavy rainfall** also

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likely over Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim during 2nd-5th August.

Northeast India:

- **Fairly Widespread to Widespread** rainfall likely over Arunachal Pradesh on 4th August; Assam & Meghalaya during 2nd-5th August; Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura during 2nd-7th August.
- **Isolated to Scattered** rainfall likely over Arunachal Pradesh during 2nd-3rd August and during 5th-7th August; Assam & Meghalaya during 6th-7th August.
- **Isolated thunderstorm & lightning** likely over Arunachal Pradesh on 2nd August; Assam & Meghalaya and Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura during 2nd-5th August.
- **Isolated heavy rainfall** likely over Arunachal Pradesh and Assam & Meghalaya during 2nd-3rd August and during 5th-7th August; Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura during 5th-7th August with isolated **very heavy rainfall** also likely over Arunachal Pradesh and Assam & Meghalaya on 4th August; Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura during 2nd-4th August.

West India:

- **Fairly Widespread to Widespread** rainfall likely over Konkan & Goa during 2nd-7th August; Gujarat Region on 2nd August; Saurashtra & Kutch during 2nd-3rd August.
- **Isolated to Scattered** rainfall likely over Madhya Maharashtra during 2nd-7th August; Marathwada during 2nd-7th August; Gujarat Region during 3rd-7th August; Saurashtra & Kutch during 4th-7th August.
- **Isolated heavy rainfall** likely over Konkan & Goa during 2nd-3rd August; Madhya Maharashtra during 2nd-3rd August; Gujarat Region and Saurashtra & Kutch on 2nd August.

South Peninsular India:

- **Isolated to Scattered** rainfall likely over North Interior Karnataka, Rayalaseema, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal and Telangana during 2nd-7th August; Lakshadweep during 5th-7th August; Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam and South Interior Karnataka during 2nd-7th August.
- **Fairly Widespread to Widespread** rainfall likely over Coastal Karnataka and Kerala & Mahe during 2nd-7th August; Lakshadweep during 2nd-4th August.
- **Isolated thunderstorm, lightning & gusty winds (speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph)** likely over Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Lakshadweep, Rayalaseema and Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal during 2nd-3rd August; Coastal Karnataka and Kerala & Maheon 2nd August; North Interior Karnataka on 3rd August, **with gusty winds (speed reaching 30-40 kmph gusting to 50 kmph)** likely over North Interior Karnataka on 4th August; Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam and Rayalaseema during 4th-5th August; Telangana during 2nd-5th August.
- **Isolated heavy rainfall** likely over Kerala & Mahe during 5th-7th August; Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Lakshadweep and Coastal Karnataka and South Interior Karnataka on 3rd August with isolated **very heavy rainfall** also likely over Coastal Karnataka, Kerala & Mahe and South Interior Karnataka on 2nd August.
- **Thundersquall (wind speed reaching 50-60 kmph gusting to 70 kmph)** likely over North Interior Karnataka and South Interior Karnataka on 2nd August.
- **Strong Surface Winds** likely over Coastal Karnataka, Kerala & Mahe and South Interior Karnataka on 2nd August; North Interior Karnataka during 2nd-4th August; Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Rayalaseema and Telangana during 2nd-5th August.

Fishermen Warning:

- **Arabian Sea:** Along and off Somalia, Oman coasts, over most parts of westcentral adjoining some parts of southwest Arabian Sea till 06th August; along and off Gujarat coasts, Karnataka, Kerala coasts, Lakshadweep Area and Comorin area and most parts of eastcentral and adjoining some parts of north Arabian Sea and during 2nd to 03rd August and few parts of east central Arabian Sea during 03rd to 06th August.
- **Bay of Bengal:** Along and off Sri Lanka Coast adjoining south Bay of Bengal till 06th August, over Andaman Sea during 03rd to 06th August.

❖ **Rainfall distribution** (from 0830 hours IST of yesterday to 0530 hours IST of today): **at most places** over Assam & Meghalaya, East Rajasthan, Sub-himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim, Uttarakhand, Himachal Pradesh, Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh, West Uttar Pradesh, Arunachal Pradesh, Saurashtra & Kutch, Telangana, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Konkan & Goa, Madhya Maharashtra, Marathwada, Vidarbha, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, West Madhya Pradesh, Rayalaseema, Coastal Karnataka, North Interior Karnataka, South Interior Karnataka and Gujarat Region; **at many places** over Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, Gangetic West Bengal, Odisha, Jharkhand, East Uttar Pradesh, Kerala & Mahe, Bihar, Haryana Chandigarh & Delhi, Punjab, West Rajasthan, Chhattisgarh, Tamilnadu Puducherry & Karaikal and Lakshadweep; **Dry** over rest of the country.

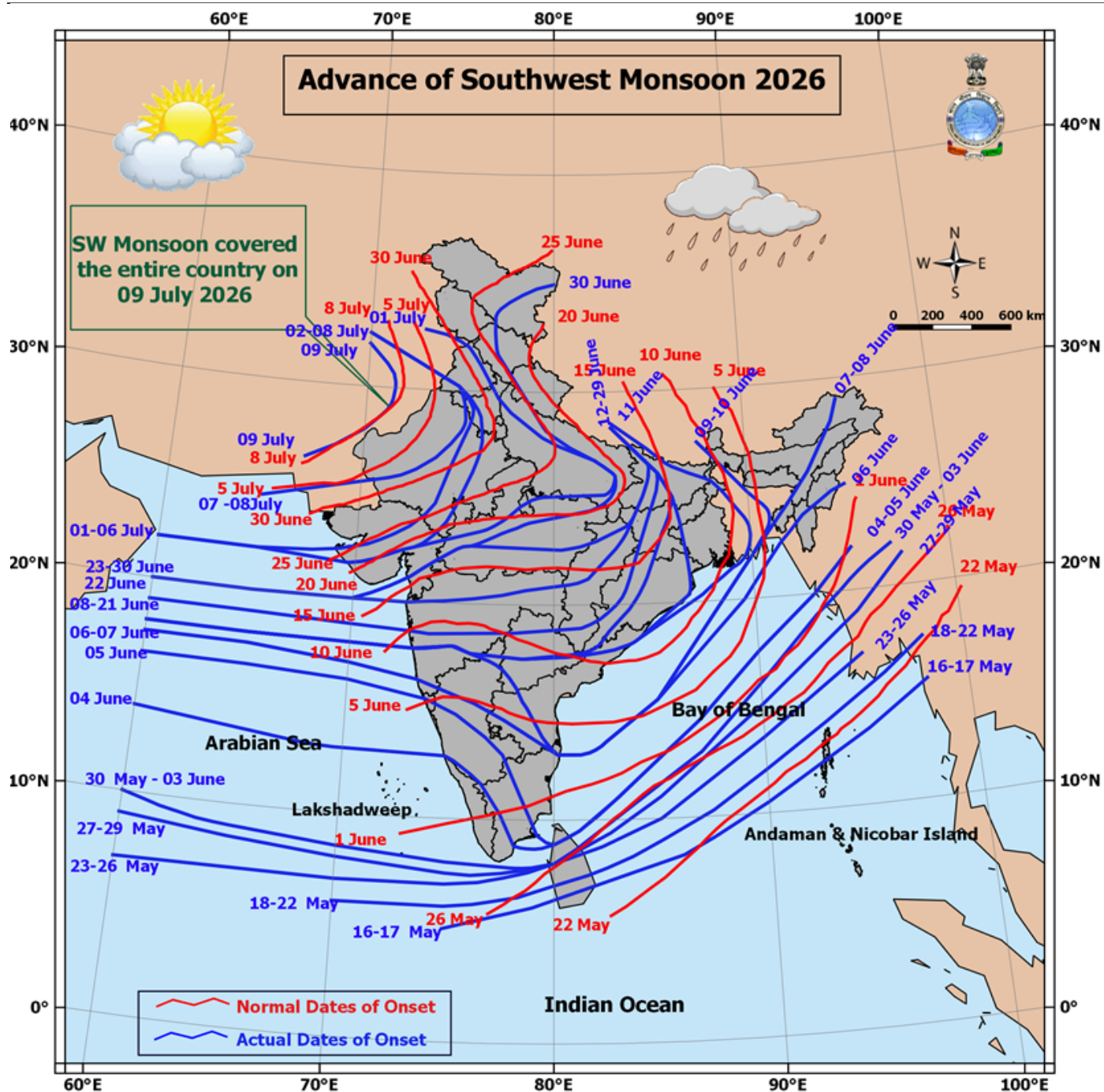
❖ **Heavy Rainfall observed** (from 0830 hours IST of yesterday to 0530 hours IST of today): **Heavy rain** at a few places over Saurashtra & Kutch and Kerala & Mahe

❖ **Minimum Temperature Departures (as on 01-08-2026)**: **markedly above normal(> 5.1°C)** at few places over Assam & Meghalaya and Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura; at isolated places over Sub Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim, Bihar, East Uttar Pradesh, West Uttar Pradesh, Himachal Pradesh, West Rajasthan, West Madhya Pradesh, East Madhya Pradesh and Saurashtra & Kutch. **appreciably above normal(3.1°C to 5.0°C)** at few places over East Madhya Pradesh; at isolated places over Gangetic West Bengal, Odisha, West Uttar Pradesh, East Rajasthan, West Madhya Pradesh, Madhya Maharashtra and Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal. **above normal(1.6°C to 3.0°C)** at many places over Konkan & Goa and Rayalaseema; at few places over Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Gangetic West Bengal, Odisha, Bihar, Uttarakhand, Himachal Pradesh, West Rajasthan, Gujarat Region, Madhya Maharashtra, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal, Coastal Karnataka and South Interior Karnataka; at isolated places over Jharkhand, East Uttar Pradesh, West Uttar Pradesh, Haryana-Chandigarh-Delhi, Punjab, Jammu-KashmirLadakh-Gilgit-Baltistan-Muzaffarabad, East Rajasthan, West Madhya Pradesh, East Madhya Pradesh, Saurashtra & Kutch, Marathwada, Vidarbha, Chhattisgarh and Telangana. **near normal(-1.5°C to 1.5°C)** at many places over Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Assam & Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, Sub Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim, Gangetic West Bengal, East Uttar Pradesh, West Uttar Pradesh, Punjab, Himachal Pradesh, East Rajasthan, Marathwada, Vidarbha, Telangana, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal, Coastal Karnataka, South Interior Karnataka and Kerala & Mahe; at most places over Arunachal Pradesh, Jharkhand, Haryana-Chandigarh-Delhi, Chhattisgarh, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, North Interior Karnataka and Lakshadweep; at few places over Odisha, Bihar, Uttarakhand, Jammu-KashmirLadakh-Gilgit-Baltistan-Muzaffarabad, West Rajasthan, West Madhya Pradesh, East Madhya Pradesh, Gujarat Region, Saurashtra & Kutch, Madhya Maharashtra and Rayalaseema; at isolated places over Konkan & Goa. **The lowest minimum temperature** of 18.2°C was reported at KHARGONE-OBS (MADHYA PRADESH) over the Plains of India.

❖ **Maximum Temperature Departures (as on 01-08-2026)**: **markedly above normal(> 5.1°C)** at isolated places over Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal. **appreciably above normal(3.1°C to 5.0°C)** at few places over Himachal Pradesh; at isolated places over Odisha, East Uttar Pradesh, Haryana-Chandigarh-Delhi, Vidarbha, Chhattisgarh and Rayalaseema. **above normal(1.6°C to 3.0°C)** at many places over Jharkhand and North Interior Karnataka; at few places over Uttarakhand, Jammu-KashmirLadakh-Gilgit-Baltistan-Muzaffarabad, West Rajasthan, East Madhya Pradesh, Konkan & Goa, Madhya Maharashtra, Telangana and Coastal Karnataka; at isolated places over Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Assam & Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, Gangetic West Bengal, Bihar, West Uttar Pradesh, Gujarat Region, Marathwada and Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam. **near normal(-1.5°C to 1.5°C)** at most places over Punjab, East Rajasthan, South Interior Karnataka and Lakshadweep; at few places over Sub Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim, West Madhya Pradesh, Saurashtra & Kutch and Kerala & Mahe. **The highest maximum temperature** of 40.5°C was reported at TONDI (TAMIL NADU).

Meteorological Analysis (Based on 0530 hours IST)

- The **Low Pressure area** over Southwest Rajasthan & neighbourhood has become less marked. However, the associated cyclonic circulation persists and now extends upto 5.8 km above mean sea level.
- The **Monsoon trough** at mean sea level now passes through Bikaner, Guna, Daltonganj, Bankura thence eastwards towards Manipur.
- The **trough** from southwest Rajasthan to northeast Bihar across cyclonic circulation over Southwest Rajasthan & neighbourhood, northern parts of Madhya Pradesh, southeast Uttar Pradesh and extends upto 4.5 km above mean sea level tilting southwestwards with height persists.
- The **off-Shore trough** at mean sea level from South Gujarat to Kerala persists.
- The **upper air cyclonic circulation** over Northeast Assam & neighbourhood extending upto 3.1 km above mean sea level persists.
- The **upper air cyclonic circulation** over southeast Himachal Pradesh & neighbourhood at 1.5 km above mean sea level persists.
- The **Western Disturbance** as a **cyclonic circulation** over Himachal Pradesh & neighbourhood at 5.8 km above mean sea level has moved away.
- The **upper air cyclonic circulation** lies over North Tamilnadu & neighbourhood and extending upto 1.5 km above mean sea level has become less marked.

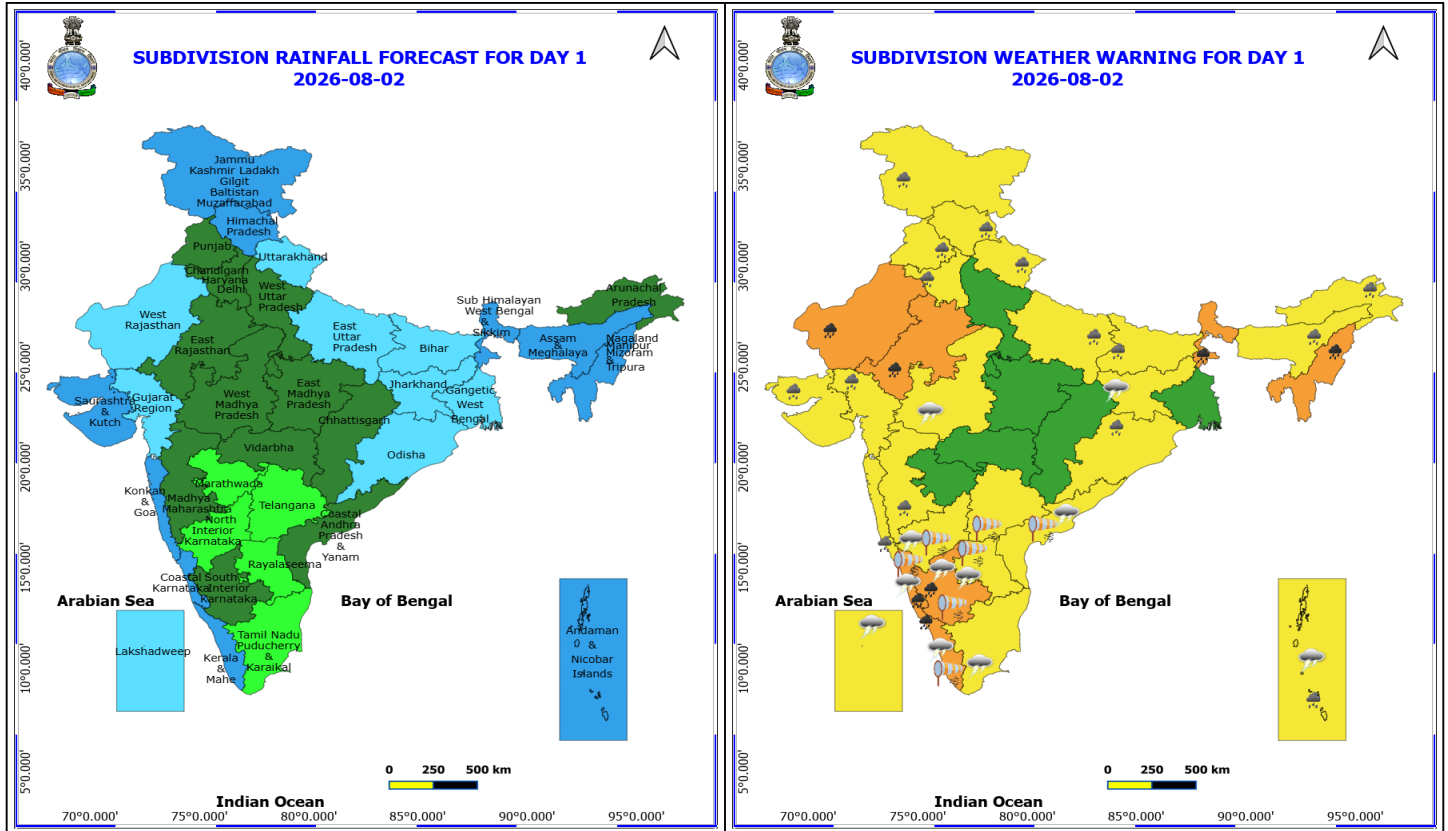


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2 August (Day 1)

- ❖ **Heavy Rainfall** very likely at isolated places over Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya, Bihar, East Uttar Pradesh, Gujarat State, Haryana, Chandigarh & Delhi, Himachal Pradesh, Jammu-Kashmir-Ladakh-Gilgit-Baltistan-Muzaffarabad, Konkani & Goa, Madhya Maharashtra, Odisha, Punjab and Uttarakhand.
- ❖ **Thundersquall with wind speed reaching(50-60kmph)** very likely at isolated places over Interior Karnataka.
- ❖ **Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning & gusty winds(40-50kmph)** very likely at isolated places over Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Andhra Pradesh, Coastal Karnataka, Jharkhand, Kerala & Mahe, Lakshadweep, Tamil Nadu Puducherry & Karaikal and West Madhya Pradesh.
- ❖ **Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning & gusty winds(30-40kmph)** very likely at isolated places over Bihar, East Madhya Pradesh, Gangetic West Bengal, Jammu-Kashmir-Ladakh-Gilgit-Baltistan-Muzaffarabad, Rajasthan and Telangana.
- ❖ **Thunderstorm accompanied with Lightning** very likely at isolated places over Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya, Chhattisgarh, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram and Tripura, Odisha, Uttarakhand and Vidarbha.
- ❖ **Strong Surface Winds** very likely at isolated places over Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka, Kerala & Mahe and Telangana.
- ❖ **Arabian Sea:** Squally wind with speed 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph is likely to prevail along and off Somalia and Oman coasts, over most parts of westcentral adjoining some parts of eastcentral, southwest & northeast and few

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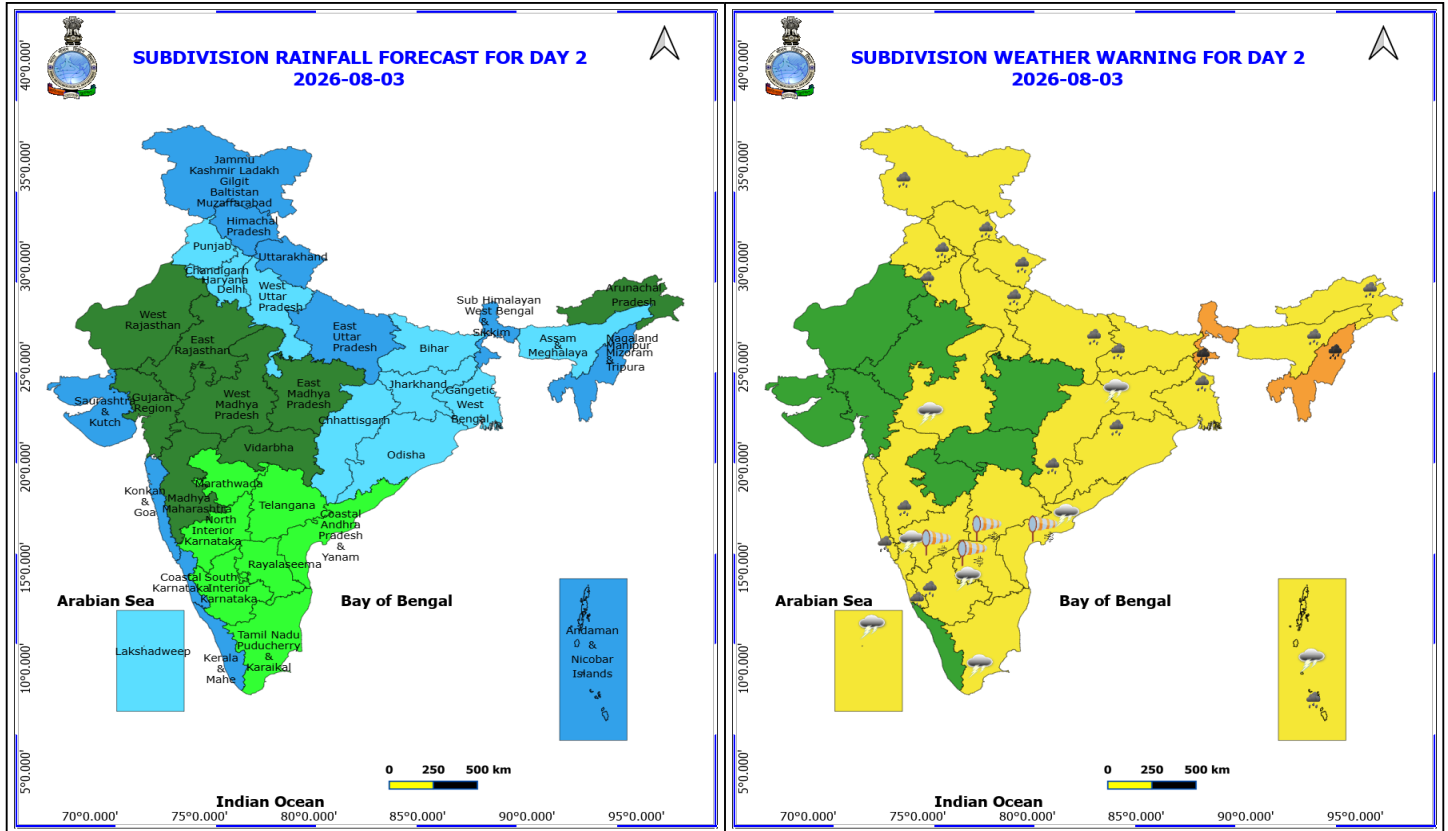
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parts of northwest Arabian Sea.

- ❖ Squally weather with wind speed 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph is likely to prevail along and off Gujarat coast adjoining northeast Arabian Sea.
- ❖ Squally Weather with wind speed 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph is likely to prevail along and off Karnataka, Kerala coasts, Lakshadweep area, Comorin area and adjoining sea areas.
- ❖ Bay of Bengal: Squally weather with wind speed 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph is likely to prevail over Gulf of Mannar, South Sri Lanka coasts and some parts of south Bay of Bengal

- ❖ **Thunderstorm accompanied with Lightning** very likely at isolated places over Assam & Meghalaya, Chhattisgarh, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram and Tripura, Odisha, Uttarakhand and Vidarbha.
- ❖ **Strong Surface Winds** very likely at isolated places over Andhra Pradesh, North Interior Karnataka and Telangana.

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Fig. 1: Maximum Temperatures Dated 2026-08-01

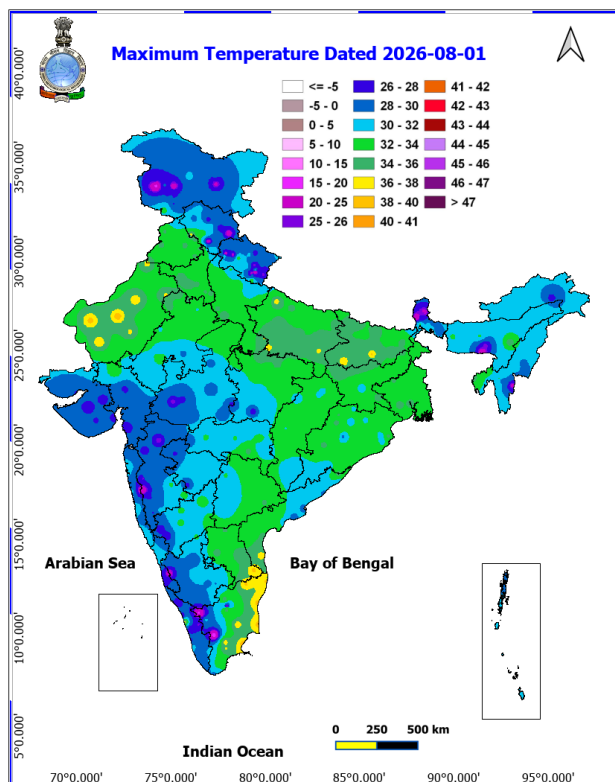


Fig. 2: Departure of Maximum Temp. Dated 2026-08-01

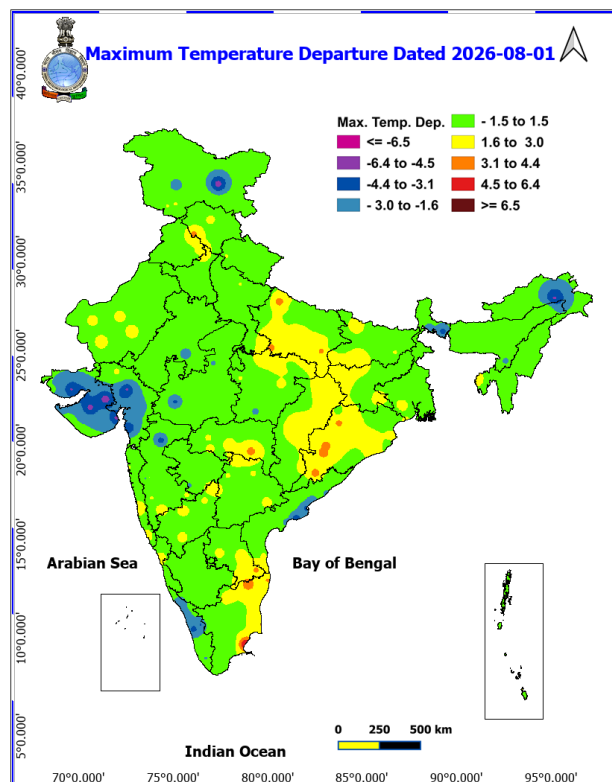


Fig. 3: Minimum Temperatures Dated 2026-08-01

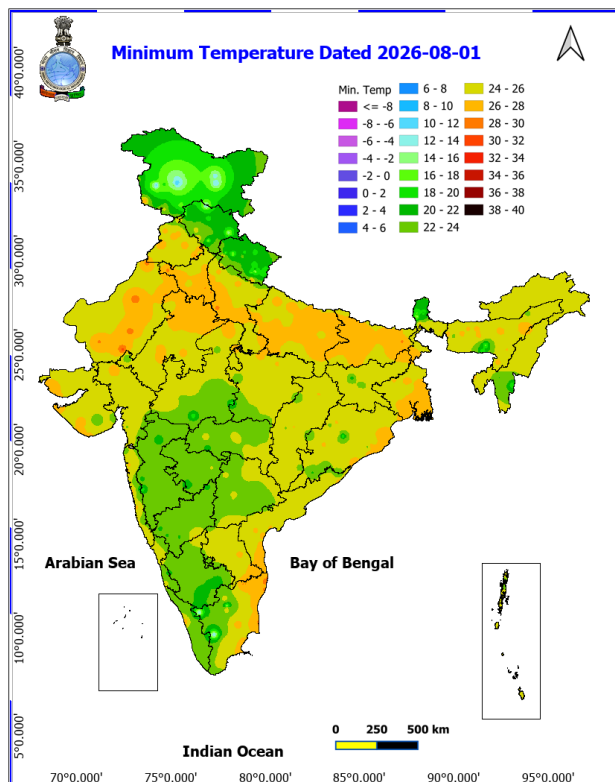
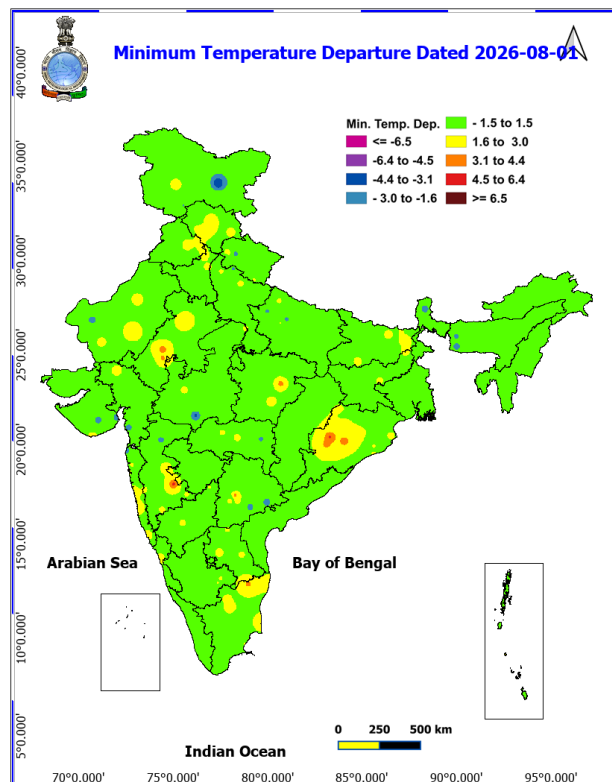
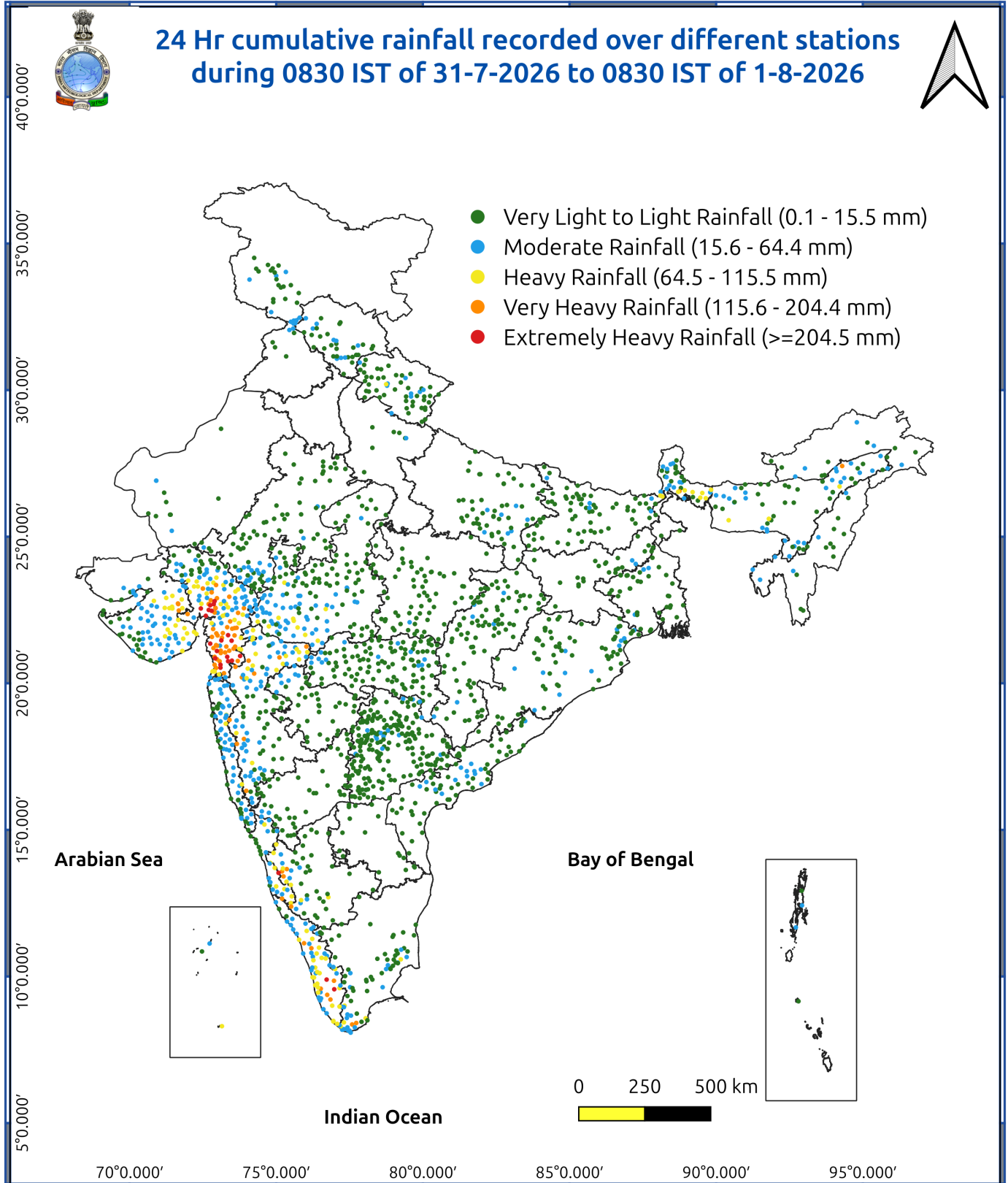


Fig. 4: Departure of Minimum Temp. Dated 2026-08-01





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Impact and Actions

Impact Expected & Action Suggested due to heavy/very heavy/extremely heavy rainfall:

Heavy to Very Heavy Rainfall very likely at isolated places over Coastal Karnataka, Kerala & Mahe, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram and Tripura, Rajasthan, South Interior Karnataka and Sub Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim on 2nd August 2026.

Impact Expected

- Localized Flooding of roads, water logging in low lying areas and closure of underpasses mainly in urban areas.
- Occasional reduction in visibility due to heavy rainfall.
- Disruption of traffic in major cities due to water logging in roads leading to increased travel time.
- Minor damage to kutcha roads.
- Possibilities of damage to vulnerable structure.
- Localized Landslides/Mudslides/landslips/mudslips/landsinks/mudsinks.
- Damage to horticulture and standing crops in some areas due to inundation.
- It may lead to riverine flooding in some river catchments (for riverine flooding please visit Web page of CWC)

Action Suggested

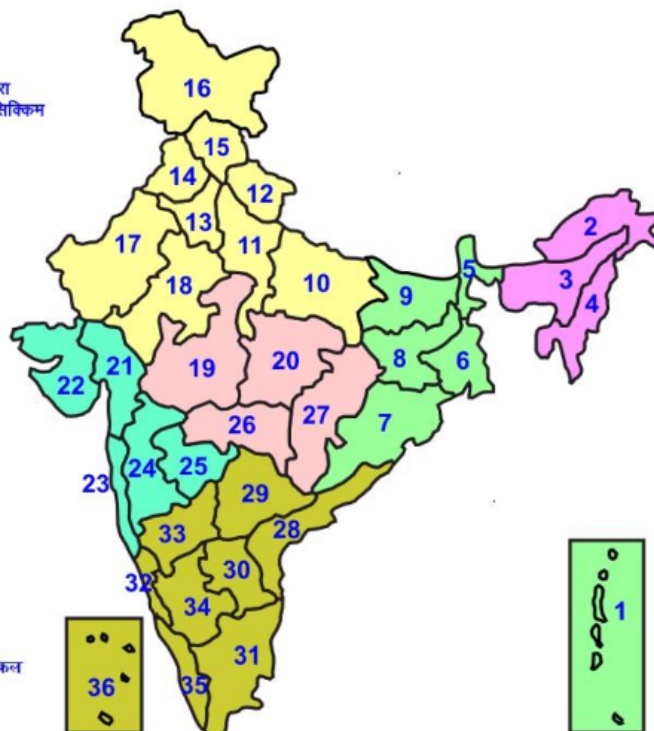
- Check for traffic congestion on your route before leaving for your destination.

Extremely Severe Cyclonic Storm: Wind speed 166-220 kmph (90-119 knots)
Super Cyclone Storm: Wind speed > 220 kmph (> 119 knots)

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
