Significant Weather Features

- **Isolated thunderstorm & lightning** likely over Vidarbha on 6th August; Chhattisgarh during 6th-10th August.
- **Isolated heavy rainfall** likely over West Madhya Pradesh during 7th-11th August; East Madhya Pradesh on 6th August and during 8th-10th August; Chhattisgarh during 6th-7th August with isolated **very heavy rainfall** also likely over West Madhya Pradesh on 6th August; East Madhya Pradesh on 7th August.

East India:

- **Fairly Widespread to Widespread** rainfall likely over Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Gangetic West Bengal, Odisha and Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim during 6th-12th August; Jharkhand during 6th-8th August and during 10th-12th August; Bihar during 6th-9th August.
- **Isolated to Scattered** rainfall likely over Jharkhand on 9th August; Bihar during 10th-12th August.
- **Isolated heavy rainfall** likely over Andaman & Nicobar Islands and Jharkhand during 6th-8th August; Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim during 8th-9th August; Gangetic West Bengal on 7th August and on 9th August; Bihar during 6th-9th August; Odisha during 8th-12th August with isolated **very heavy rainfall** also likely over Gangetic West Bengal on 6th August; Odisha during 6th-7th August.

Northeast India:

- **Isolated to Scattered** rainfall likely over Arunachal Pradesh during 6th-12th August; Assam & Meghalaya during 8th-11th August.
- **Fairly Widespread to Widespread** rainfall likely over Assam & Meghalaya during 6th-7th August and on 12th August; Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura during 6th-12th August.

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- Isolated **thunderstorm & lightning** likely over Arunachal Pradesh on 6th August; Assam & Meghalaya and Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura during 6th-10th August.
- Isolated **heavy rainfall** likely over Arunachal Pradesh during 7th-8th August and during 11th-12th August; Assam & Meghalaya during 6th-12th August; Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura during 7th-12th August with isolated **very heavy rainfall** also likely over Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura on 6th August.

West India:

- **Isolated to Scattered** rainfall likely over Madhya Maharashtra on 7th August and during 10th-12th August; Marathwada and Saurashtra & Kutch during 6th-12th August; Gujarat Region during 6th-7th August and during 11th-12th August.
- Isolated **thunderstorm, lightning & gusty winds (speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph)** likely over Madhya Maharashtra during 6th-8th August, **with gusty winds (speed reaching 30-40 kmph gusting to 50 kmph)** likely over Marathwada on 6th August and during 8th-9th August.
- Isolated **thunderstorm & lightning** likely over Gujarat Region and Saurashtra & Kutch during 8th-9th August.
- Isolated **heavy rainfall** likely over Konkan & Goa on 6th August; Madhya Maharashtra on 7th August; Gujarat Region during 9th-10th August; Saurashtra & Kutch on 9th August with isolated **very heavy rainfall** also likely over Madhya Maharashtra on 6th August.

❖ **Heavy Rainfall observed** (from 0830 hours IST of yesterday to 0830 hours IST of today): **Extremely heavy rain** at isolated places over Bihar. **Heavy to very heavy rain** at a few places over Lakshadweep and at isolated places over East Rajasthan, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, Bihar, West Uttar Pradesh and Madhya Maharashtra. **Heavy rain** at isolated places over Assam & Meghalaya, Gangetic West Bengal, Odisha, Jharkhand, East Uttar Pradesh,

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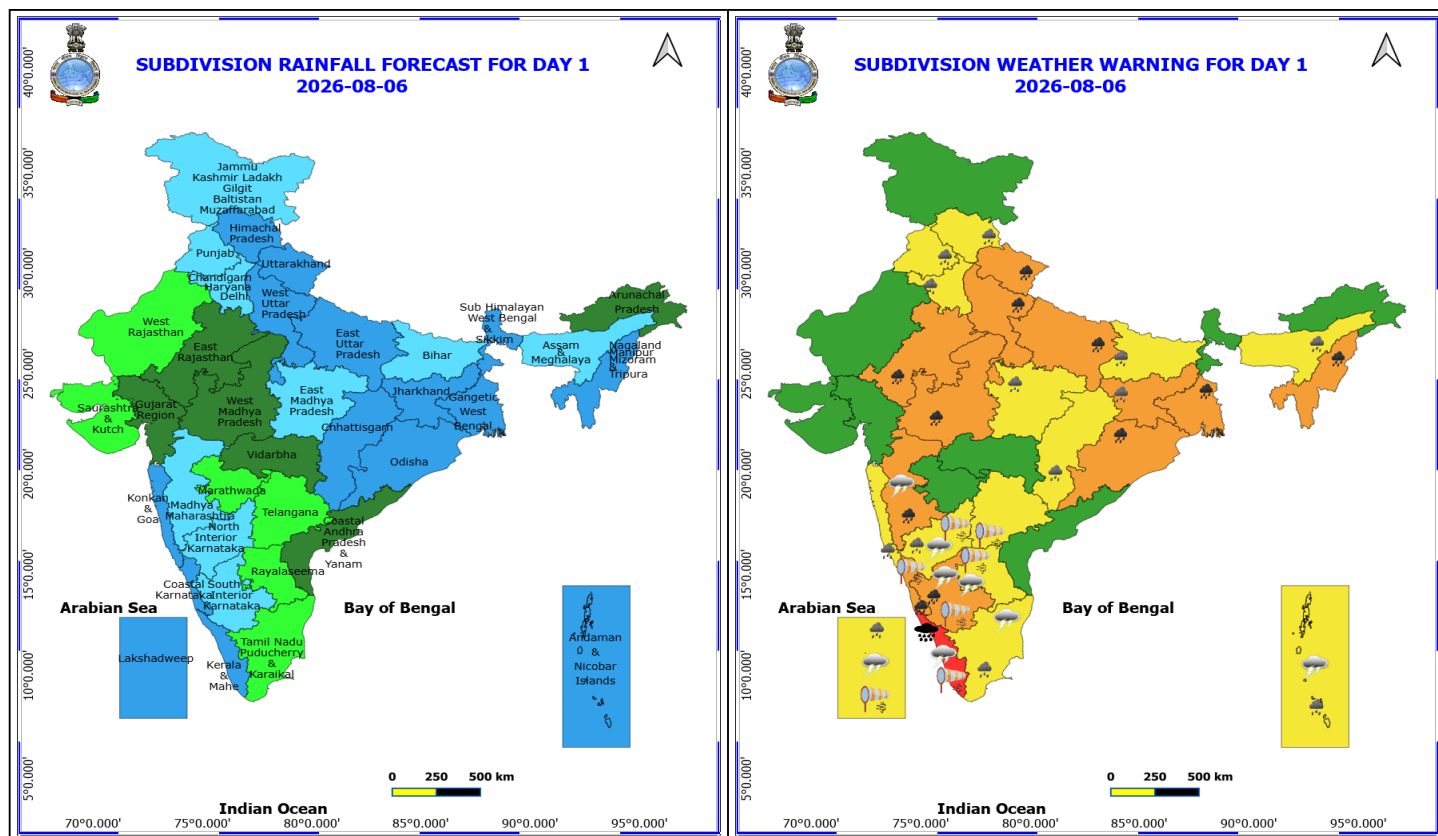

❖ **Minimum Temperature Departures (as on 06-08-2026):** **markedly above normal(> 5.1°C)** at isolated places over Assam & Meghalaya, Bihar, West Uttar Pradesh, Himachal Pradesh, West Madhya Pradesh, East Madhya Pradesh and Saurashtra & Kutch. **appreciably above normal(3.1°C to 5.0°C)** at few places over East Madhya Pradesh; at isolated places over Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Assam & Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, Odisha, East Uttar Pradesh, West Uttar Pradesh, West Rajasthan, West Madhya Pradesh, Gujarat Region, Madhya Maharashtra, Vidarbha and Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal. **above normal(1.6°C to 3.0°C)** at most places over Arunachal Pradesh; at few places over Uttarakhand, Himachal Pradesh, East Rajasthan, Gujarat Region, Vidarbha, Chhattisgarh, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal and Coastal Karnataka; at isolated places over Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Gangetic West Bengal, Odisha, Bihar, East Uttar Pradesh, Jammu-KashmirLadakh-Gilgit-Baltistan-Muzaffarabad, West Madhya Pradesh, Saurashtra & Kutch, Marathwada, Telangana and Rayalaseema. **near normal(-1.5°C to 1.5°C)** at many places over Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Assam & Meghalaya, Gangetic West Bengal, East Uttar Pradesh, West Uttar Pradesh, Haryana-Chandigarh-Delhi, Jammu-KashmirLadakh-Gilgit-Baltistan-Muzaffarabad, East Rajasthan, West Madhya Pradesh, Gujarat Region, Saurashtra & Kutch, Chhattisgarh, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal, Coastal Karnataka and Lakshadweep; at most places over Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, Sub Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim, Jharkhand, Punjab, West Rajasthan, Konkan & Goa, Madhya Maharashtra, Marathwada, Rayalaseema, North Interior Karnataka, South Interior Karnataka and Kerala & Mahe; at few places over Odisha, Bihar, Uttarakhand, East Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha and Telangana; at isolated places over Himachal Pradesh. **The lowest minimum temperature** of 18.4°C was reported at YEOTMAL (MAHARASHTRA) over the Plains of India.

❖ **Maximum Temperature Departures (as on 05-08-2026):** **markedly above normal(> 5.1°C)** at most places over Jammu-KashmirLadakh-Gilgit-Baltistan-Muzaffarabad; at few places over Arunachal Pradesh; at isolated places over Assam & Meghalaya and Himachal Pradesh. **appreciably above normal(3.1°C to 5.0°C)** at isolated places over West Rajasthan, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam and Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal. **above normal(1.6°C to 3.0°C)** at few places over Punjab; at isolated places over Odisha. **near normal(-1.5°C to 1.5°C)** at many places over Haryana-Chandigarh-Delhi and Lakshadweep; at most places over Uttarakhand; at few places over Sub Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim and West Uttar Pradesh; at isolated places over Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, Gangetic West Bengal, East Uttar Pradesh, East Rajasthan, Saurashtra & Kutch and Konkan & Goa. **The highest maximum temperature** of 40.5°C was reported at MADURAI (A) (TAMIL NADU).

Meteorological Analysis (Based on 0830 hours IST)

- The **Monsoon trough** at mean sea level now passes through Firozpur, Rohtak, Shahjahanpur, Kanpur, Daltonganj, Digha and thence east-southeastwards towards Northeast Bay of Bengal.
- The **Western Disturbance** as a trough in middle & upper tropospheric westerlies with its axis at 5.8 km above mean sea level roughly along Long. 73°E to the north of Lat. 29°N persists.
- The **upper air cyclonic circulation** over southwest Uttar Pradesh & neighbourhood persists and now lies at 0.9 km above mean sea level.
- The **upper air cyclonic circulation** over Northeast Bihar & adjoining Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim now lies over southeast Uttar Pradesh & neighbourhood and extends upto 7.6 km above mean sea level.
- The **upper air cyclonic circulation** over North Odisha & adjoining Gangetic West Bengal now lies over Northwest Bay of Bengal & adjoining north Odisha-Gangetic West Bengal coasts at 0.9 km above mean sea level.
- The **upper air cyclonic circulation** over Southeast Bay of Bengal persists and lies between 4.5 & 5.8 km above mean sea level.
- An **upper air cyclonic circulation** lies over south Gangetic West Bengal & adjoining Bangladesh between 1.5 & 5.8 km above mean sea level.
- The **cyclonic circulation** over northwest Uttar Pradesh & neighbourhood extending upto 3.1 km above mean sea level has become less marked.
- The **upper air cyclonic circulation** over Northeast Bangladesh & neighbourhood at 0.9 km above mean sea level has become less marked.



6 August (Day 1)

- ❖ **Heavy to Very Heavy Rainfall with isolated Extremely Heavy Rainfall** very likely at isolated places over Kerala & Mahe.
- ❖ **Heavy to Very Heavy Rainfall** very likely at isolated places over Coastal Karnataka, East Rajasthan, Gangetic West Bengal, Madhya Maharashtra, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram and Tripura, Odisha, South Interior Karnataka, Uttar Pradesh, Uttarakhand and West Madhya Pradesh.
- ❖ **Heavy Rainfall** very likely at isolated places over Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Assam & Meghalaya, Bihar, Chhattisgarh, East Madhya Pradesh, Haryana, Chandigarh & Delhi, Himachal Pradesh, Jharkhand, Konkan & Goa, Lakshadweep, North Interior Karnataka, Punjab and Tamil Nadu Puducherry & Karaikal.
- ❖ **Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning & gusty winds(40-50kmph)** very likely at isolated places over Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Interior Karnataka, Kerala & Mahe, Lakshadweep, Madhya Maharashtra, Rayalaseema and Tamil Nadu Puducherry & Karaikal.
- ❖ **Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning & gusty winds(30-40kmph)** very likely at isolated places over Bihar, Coastal Karnataka, East Rajasthan, Jammu-Kashmir-Ladakh-Gilgit-Baltistan-Muzaffarabad, Jharkhand, Madhya Pradesh, Marathwada, Odisha, Telangana and West Bengal & Sikkim.
- ❖ **Thunderstorm accompanied with Lightning** very likely at isolated places over Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya, Chhattisgarh, Coastal Andhra Pradesh, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram and Tripura, Uttarakhand, Vidarbha and West Rajasthan.
- ❖ **Strong Surface Winds** very likely at isolated places over Karnataka, Kerala & Mahe, Lakshadweep, Rayalaseema and Telangana.

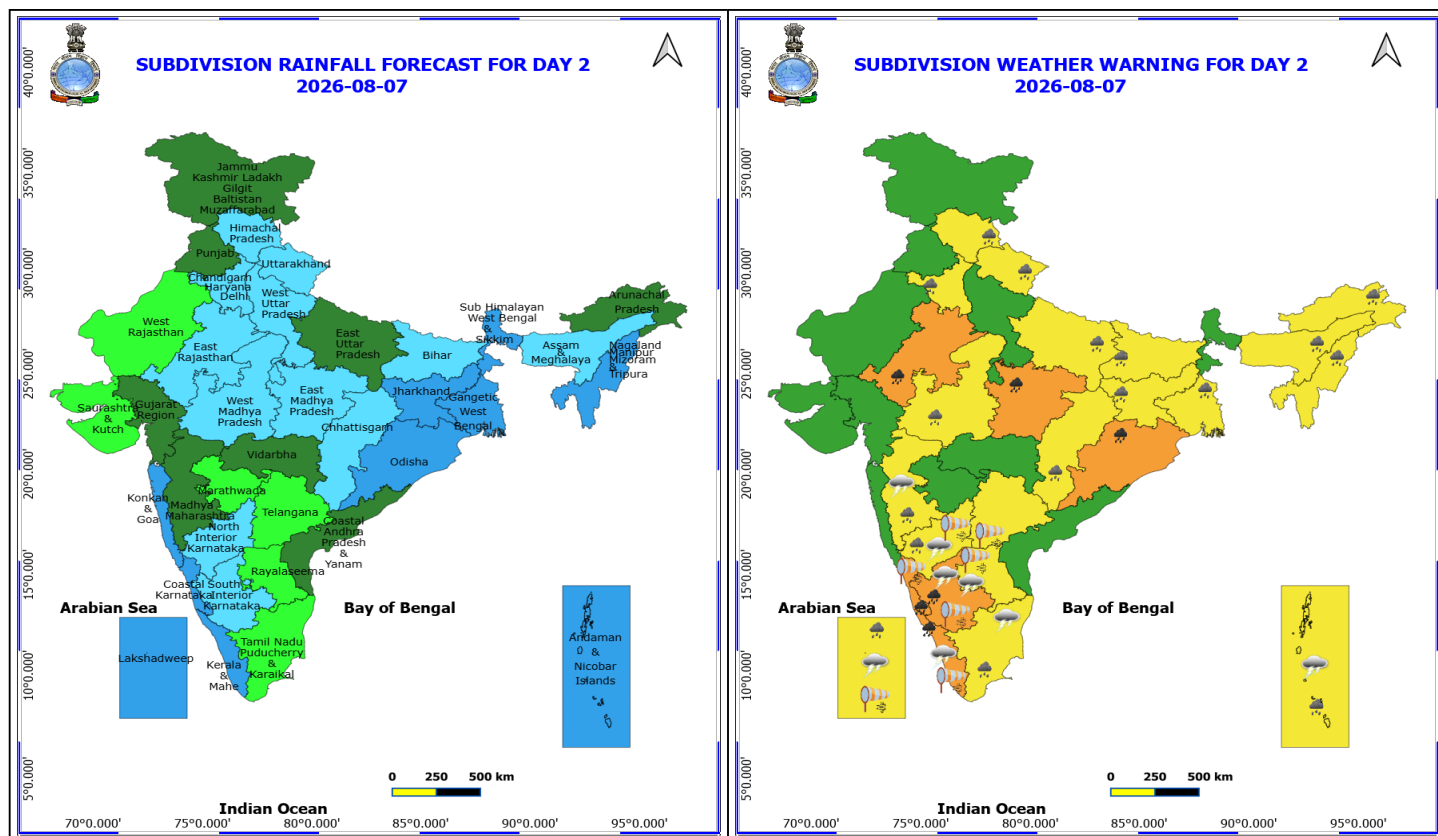
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- ❖ **Arabian Sea: Squally wind with speed 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph** is likely to prevail along and off Somalia and Oman coasts, over most parts of central, some parts of southwest and few parts of north Arabian Sea.
- ❖ **Squally Weather with wind speed 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph** is likely to prevail along and off Karnataka, Kerala coasts, Lakshadweep area adjoining sea areas and few parts of Comorin areas.
- ❖ **Bay of Bengal: Squally wind with speed 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph** is likely to prevail over south Sri Lanka Coast and some parts of south Bay of Bengal and few parts of westcentral Bay of Bengal.
- ❖ **Squally Weather with wind speed 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph** is likely to prevail along and off Odisha coast and over Andaman Sea.



7 August (Day 2)

- ❖ **Heavy to Very Heavy Rainfall** very likely at isolated places over Coastal Karnataka, East Madhya Pradesh, East Rajasthan, Kerala & Mahe, Odisha and South Interior Karnataka.

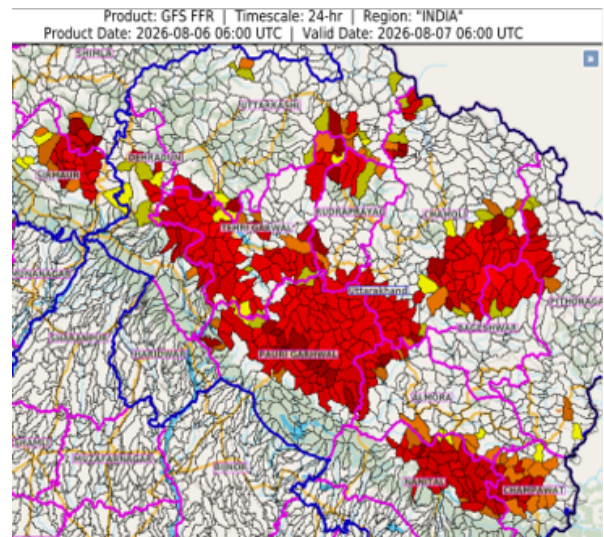

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Fig. 1: Maximum Temperatures Dated 2026-08-05

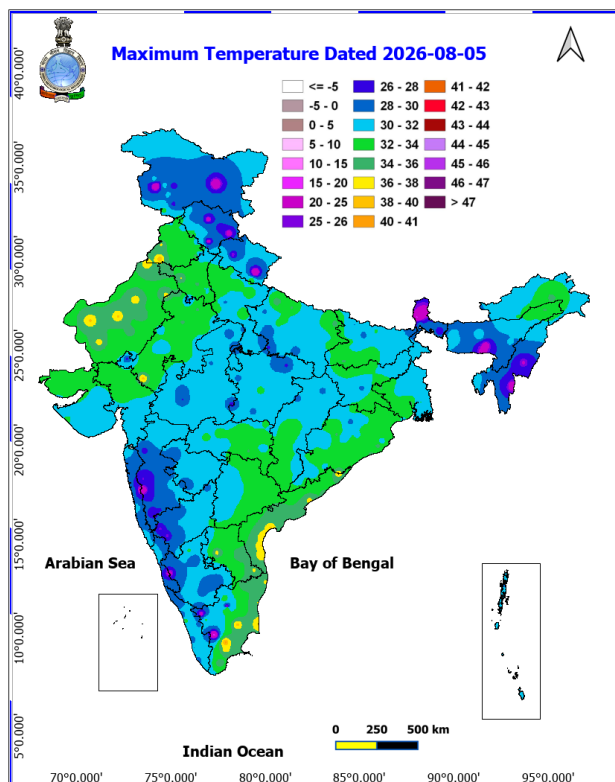


Fig. 2: Departure of Maximum Temp. Dated 2026-08-05

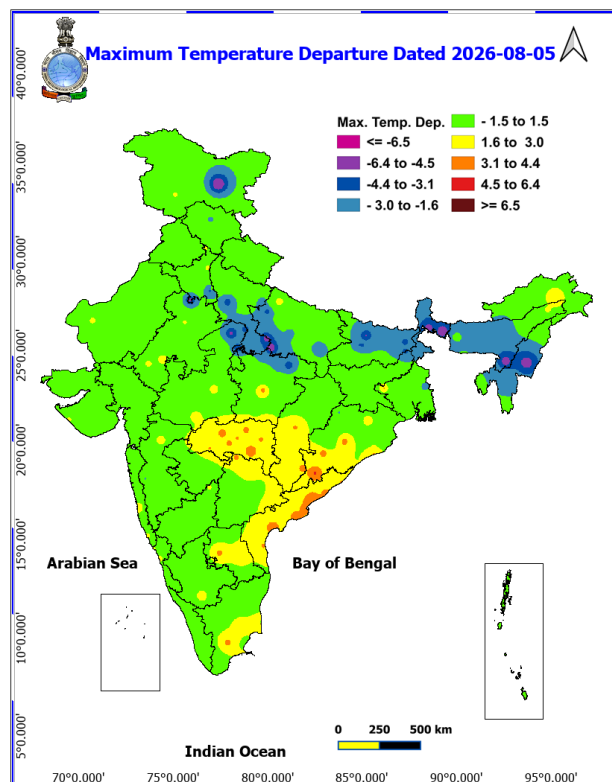


Fig. 3: Minimum Temperatures Dated 2026-08-06

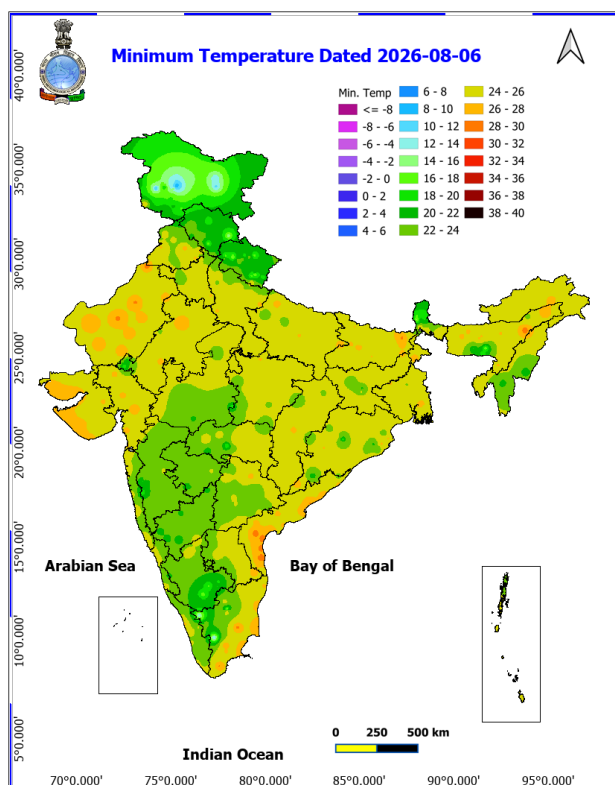
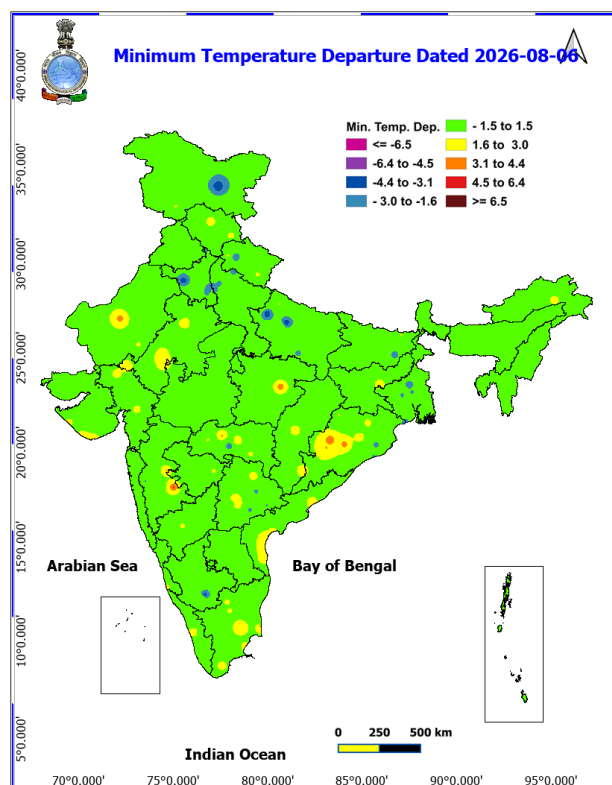
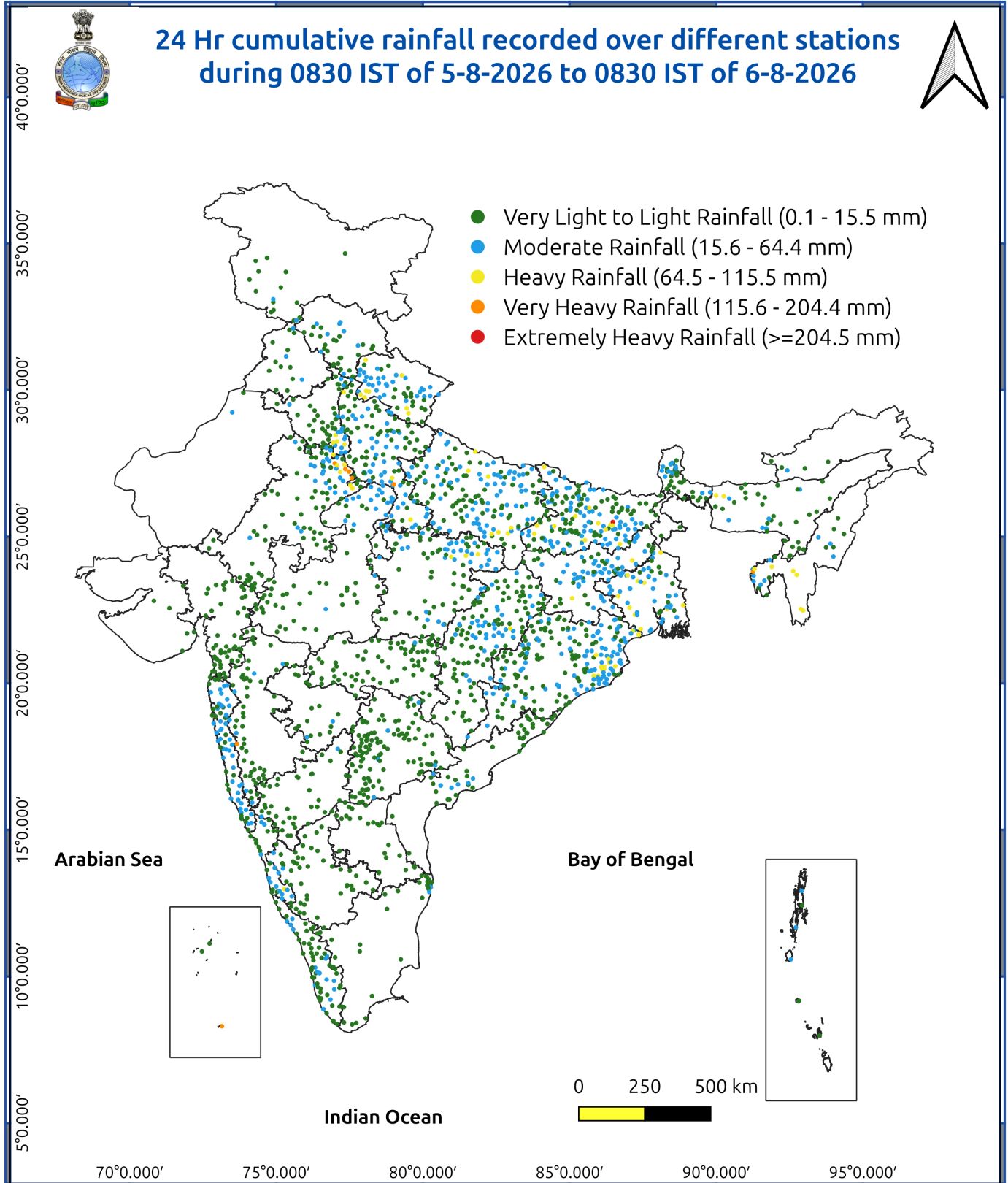


Fig. 4: Departure of Minimum Temp. Dated 2026-08-06





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Impact and Actions

Impact Expected and Action Suggested due to very heavy rainfall:

- **Heavy to Very Heavy Rainfall with isolated Extremely Heavy Rainfall** very likely at isolated places over Kerala & Mahe on 6th August.
- **Isolated very heavy rainfall** also likely over East Uttar Pradesh, Uttarakhand, West Uttar Pradesh, West Madhya Pradesh, Gangetic West Bengal, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, Madhya Maharashtra on 6th; Odisha, Coastal Karnataka, Kerala & Mahe and South Interior Karnataka during 6th-7th; East Madhya Pradesh on 7th; East Rajasthan during 6th-9th August.

Impact expected:

- Breaking of tree branches, uprooting of small trees like banana, papaya, drum sticks. Strong wind and rain may damage plantation, horticulture and standing crops.
- Partial damage to vulnerable structures due to strong winds and rain.
- Minor damage to kutch houses/walls, huts and roads due to heavy rain.
- Loose objects may fly.
- Small ships, trawlers and boats may be affected.
- Road and rail traffic may be affected due to heavy rain and squally winds.
- There could be localised landslides, mudslides, landslips, water logging, inundation and flooding over low lying areas.
- Occasional reduction in visibility due to heavy rainfall.
- Helicopter services may get affected.

Action suggested:

- People are advised to keep a watch on the weather for worsening conditions and be ready to move to safer places accordingly.
- Take safe shelters; do not take shelter under trees, as there could be lightning.
- In case of expected lightning, unplug electrical/ electronic appliances, immediately, get out of water bodies and keep away from all the objects that conduct electricity.
- Tourism and recreational activities to be regulated.
- Onshore and offshore activities to be judiciously regulated.
- Helicopter services to be regulated.

Agromet advisories for various parts of the country

Agromet advisories for likely impact of Heavy Rainfall

- In **Odisha**, maintain effective drainage in rice nurseries and fields of kharif crops such as maize, pulses (green gram, black gram, pigeon pea), oilseeds (groundnut, sesame), cotton, vegetables and fruit orchards to prevent waterlogging. Provide staking/support to banana, papaya, sugarcane, tomato and climbing vegetable.
- In **Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram and Tripura**, ensure proper drainage from soybean, black gram, ginger, turmeric, cole crop and vegetable fields to prevent residual waterlogging. Provide bamboo staking/support to banana and other vulnerable crops and avoid prolonged water stagnation in rice and groundnut fields.
- In **Jharkhand**, maintain proper drainage in paddy, finger millet, maize, tomato nursery and other standing crop fields to prevent waterlogging. Postpone intercultural operations and ensure excess rainwater is drained quickly from crop fields.
- In **Konkan**, ensure proper drainage in turmeric, groundnut, transplanted rice, finger millet, proso millet, vegetable fields and orchards. Remove excess rainwater from low-lying areas to prevent prolonged waterlogging.
- In **Ghat areas of Madhya Maharashtra**, drain out excess rainwater from rice nurseries and fields of rice, finger millet, maize, cotton, pigeon pea, groundnut, green gram and black gram to prevent waterlogging.
- In **Keralam**, drain out excess rainwater from plantations of banana, coconut, cardamom, ginger, black pepper

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and fields of turmeric and vegetables to prevent waterlogging. Provide strong support for banana plants and trellis-grown crops.

- In **Coastal and South Interior Karnataka**, keep field drainage channels clear and drain out excess rainwater from paddy, maize, millets, vegetables, arecanut plantations and fruit orchards to prevent prolonged waterlogging. Provide mechanical support to banana and tomato crops.
- In **Assam**, keep field drainage channels clear and maintain proper drainage in rice nurseries, jute, sugarcane, soybean, pigeon pea, sesame and vegetable fields to prevent prolonged waterlogging.
- In **Meghalaya**, ensure proper drainage from rice nurseries and fields of maize, cowpea, okra and ginger to prevent prolonged waterlogging. Open drainage channels immediately and provide propping/support to banana and other heavily laden crops.
- In **West Bengal**, maintain proper drainage in rice nurseries and fields of rice, ginger, tomato, chilli, Dalley Khorsani, finger millet and fruit orchards to prevent waterlogging. Strengthen terrace bunds in transplanted rice fields.
- In **Uttarakhand**, maintain effective drainage in rice, sugarcane, black gram, green gram, soybean, maize, groundnut, sesame, barnyard millet, finger millet, tomato and chilli fields to prevent prolonged waterlogging. Harvest mature tomato, French bean and potato wherever field conditions permit.
- In **Bihar**, make proper arrangements for drainage of excess rainwater from crop fields and postpone the application of fertilizers and pesticides.
- In **Himachal Pradesh**, carry out harvesting of pea pods and vegetables (tomato, capsicum, brinjal, etc.) wherever possible and keep harvested produce in a safe place. Maintain proper drainage in rice, maize, finger millet, tomato, brinjal, capsicum, chilli and cucumber fields and apple and pear orchards for quick removal of excess rainwater.
- In **Haryana**, ensure proper field drainage in standing crop fields to prevent waterlogging and promptly remove excess rainwater from crop fields and orchards.
- In **Uttar Pradesh**, maintain proper drainage to remove excess rainwater from pigeon pea, maize, groundnut, sesame, rice, vegetable and other standing crop fields, particularly from low-lying areas prone to waterlogging.
- In **Tamil Nadu**, ensure proper drainage in paddy, sugarcane, banana, coconut, black pepper, ginger, turmeric and vegetable fields to prevent waterlogging.

Agromet advisories for likely impact of Thunderstorm / Gusty Winds

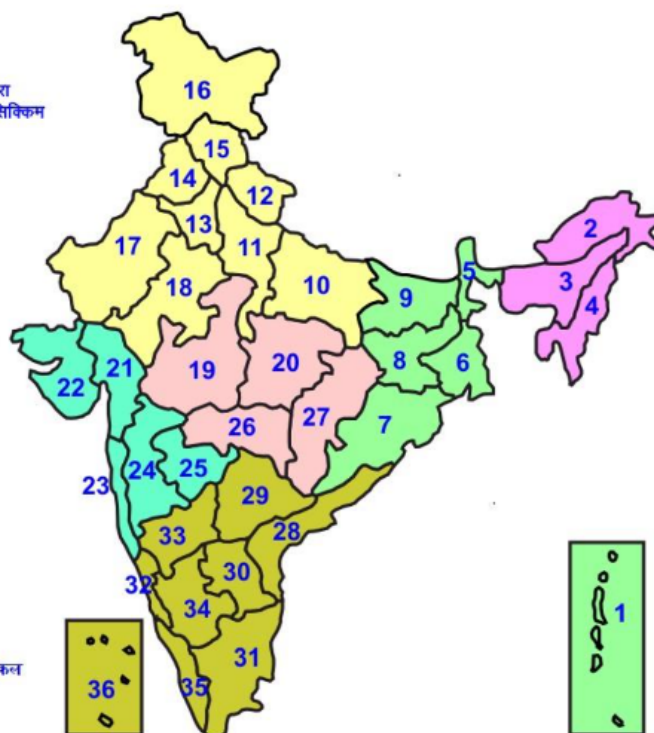
- Shift the harvested produce in safer places or cover the produce with tarpaulin sheets in the fields. Tie the harvested crops securely and cover them to minimize the risk of displacement from strong surface winds.
- Provide mechanical support to horticultural crops and staking or support to vegetables and young fruit plants / fruit-bearing plants to avoid lodging due to strong winds.

Livestock / Poultry / Fisheries

- Keep the animals inside the shed during heavy rainfall and provide them balanced feed.
- Store the feed and fodder in a safe place to prevent spoilage.
- Construct an outlet with proper netting around the ponds to drain excess water, thereby preventing fish from escaping in the event of overflow.

(a) Based on Departure from normal

Heat Wave: Maximum Temperature Departure from normal 4.5°C to 6.4°C .
Severe Heat Wave: Maximum Temperature Departure from normal $\geq 6.5^{\circ}\text{C}$

(b). Based on Actual maximum temperature

Heat Wave: When actual maximum temperature $\geq 45^{\circ}\text{C}$.
Severe Heat Wave: When actual maximum temperature $\geq 47^{\circ}\text{C}$

(c). Criteria for heat wave for coastal stations

When maximum temperature departure is $> 4.5^{\circ}\text{C}$ from normal. Heat Wave may be described provided maximum temperature $\geq 37^{\circ}\text{C}$



When maximum temperature remains 40°C

Warm Night: When minimum temperature departure 4.5°C to 6.4°C .
Severe Warm Night: When minimum temperature departure $> 6.4^{\circ}\text{C}$.

Cold Wave: Minimum Temperature Departure from normal -4.5°C to -6.4°C .

Cold Wave: When Minimum Temperature is $\leq 4.0^{\circ}\text{C}$

(c) For Coastal Stations

Cold Day: Maximum Temperature Departure from normal -4.5°C to -6.4°C .

Phenomenon of small droplets suspended in air and the horizontal visibility $< 1\text{km}$

Moderate Fog: When the visibility between 500-200 metres
Dense Fog: when the visibility between 50-200 metres
Very Dense Fog: when the visibility < 50 metres



Sudden electrical discharges manifested by a flash of light (Lightning) and a sharp rumbling sound (thunder)



An ensemble of particles of dust or sand energetically lifted to great heights by a strong and turbulent wind.



Ice deposits on ground

Air temperature $\leq 4^{\circ}\text{C}$ (over Plains)



A strong wind that rises suddenly, lasts for atleast 1 minute.

Moderate: Wind speed 52-61 kmph
Severe: Wind speed 62-87 kmph
Very Severe: Wind speed > 87 kmph



Effect of various waves in the sea over specific area

Rough to very rough: Wind speed 41-62 kmph (22-33 knots) & Wave height 2.5-6 metre
High to very high: Wind speed 63-117 kmph (34-63 knots) & Wave height 6-14 metre
Phenomenal: Wind speed > 117 kmph (> 63 knots) & Wave height > 14 metre



Cyclonic Storm: Wind speed 62-87 kmph (34-47 knots)

Severe Cyclonic Storm: Wind speed 88-117 kmph (48-63 knots)
Very Severe Cyclonic Storm: Wind speed 118-165 kmph (64-89 knots)
Extremely Severe Cyclonic Storm: Wind speed 166-220 kmph (90-119 knots)
Super Cyclone Storm: Wind speed > 220 kmph (> 119 knots)
