## ALL INDIA WEATHER SUMMARY AND FORECAST BULLETIN

### Significant Weather Features

#### Advance of Southwest Monsoon 2026

- The Northern Limit of Monsoon continues to pass through 22°N/60°E, 22°N/65°E, Jamnagar, Udaipur, Ajmer, Jhunjhunu, Hisar, Bhatinda and 32.5°N/70°E as on 04<sup>th</sup> July.
- Conditions are favourable for further advance of southwest monsoon into some more parts of North Arabian Sea, Gujarat, remaining parts of Haryana & Punjab, and some more parts of Rajasthan during next 4 days.

- Isolated **thunderstorm, lightning & gusty winds (speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph)** likely over Haryana Chandigarh & Delhi and Punjab during 4th-5th July; West Rajasthan during 4th-6th July; East Rajasthan during 4th-9th July, **with gusty winds (speed reaching 30-40 kmph gusting to 50 kmph)** likely over West Rajasthan during 7th-10th July; East Rajasthan on 10th July.
- Isolated **thunderstorm & lightning** likely over Uttarakhand during 4th-10th July; West Uttar Pradesh on 4th July and during 7th-8th July; East Uttar Pradesh during 7th-8th July.
- Isolated **heavy rainfall** likely over Haryana Chandigarh & Delhi, Jammu-Kashmir-Ladakh-Gilgit-Baltistan-Muzaffarabad and Punjab during 6th-8th July; Himachal Pradesh during 4th-5th July and during 8th-9th July; Uttarakhand on 4th July and during 6th-10th July; West Uttar Pradesh during 9th-10th July; East Uttar Pradesh during 8th-10th July; West Rajasthan on 4th July and during 6th-8th July; East Rajasthan on 8th July and on 10th July with isolated **very heavy rainfall** also likely over Himachal Pradesh during 6th-7th July; Uttarakhand on 5th July; East Rajasthan during 4th-7th July and on 9th July.

##### Central India:

- **Fairly Widespread to Widespread** rainfall likely over Chhattisgarh, East Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha and West Madhya Pradesh during 4th-10th July.
- Isolated **thunderstorm, lightning & gusty winds (speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph)** likely over East Madhya Pradesh and West Madhya Pradesh during 4th-8th July; Chhattisgarh during 6th-8th July, **with gusty winds (speed reaching 30-40 kmph gusting to 50 kmph)** likely over Vidarbha during 4th-8th July.
- Isolated **heavy rainfall** likely over West Madhya Pradesh on 4th July and during 9th-10th July; East Madhya Pradesh during 9th-10th July; Vidarbha on 6th July; Chhattisgarh during 6th-7th July and during 9th-10th July with isolated **very heavy rainfall** also likely over West Madhya Pradesh during 5th-8th July; East Madhya Pradesh during 4th-8th July; Chhattisgarh and Vidarbha during 4th-5th July.
- **Heavy to very heavy rainfall with extremely heavy rainfall likely at isolated places over West Madhya Pradesh on 04<sup>th</sup> July.**

##### East India:

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- **Fairly Widespread to Widespread** rainfall likely over Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Gangetic West Bengal, Jharkhand and Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim during 4th-10th July; Odisha during 4th-8th July.
- **Isolated to Scattered** rainfall likely over Bihar during 4th-10th July; Odisha during 9th-10th July.
- **Isolated thunderstorm, lightning & gusty winds (speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph)** likely over Andaman & Nicobar Islands and Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim during 4th-10th July; Gangetic West Bengal during 4th-7th July; Jharkhand during 4th-8th July, **with gusty winds (speed reaching 30-40 kmph gusting to 50 kmph)** likely over Gangetic West Bengal during 8th-10th July; Bihar during 4th-8th July.
- **Isolated heavy rainfall** likely over Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim during 6th-8th July and on 10th July; Gangetic West Bengal on 4th July and on 6th July; Jharkhand during 5th-7th July; Bihar during 6th-7th July and on 10th July; Odisha during 4th-5th July and on 10th July with isolated **very heavy rainfall** also likely over Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim on 9th July; Gangetic West Bengal on 5th July; Odisha during 6th-7th July.
- **Moderate to intense lightning activity** over Jharkhand on 04<sup>th</sup> July.
- **Heavy to very heavy rainfall with extremely heavy rainfall likely at isolated places over Odisha on 04<sup>th</sup> & 05<sup>th</sup> July.**

#### Northeast India:

- **Isolated to Scattered** rainfall likely over Arunachal Pradesh during 4th-6th July and during 9th-10th July; Assam & Meghalaya during 4th-6th July and on 10th July.
- **Fairly Widespread to Widespread** rainfall likely over Arunachal Pradesh during 7th-8th July; Assam & Meghalaya during 7th-9th July; Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura during 4th-10th July.
- **Isolated thunderstorm & lightning** likely over Arunachal Pradesh during 6th-8th July; Assam & Meghalaya on 4th July; Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura during 4th-8th July.

- **Isolated to Scattered** rainfall likely over Madhya Maharashtra during 8th-10th July; Marathawada during 6th-10th July; Gujarat Region during 9th-10th July; Saurashtra & Kutch during 7th-10th July.
- **Isolated thunderstorm, lightning & gusty winds (speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph)** likely over Madhya Maharashtra during 4th-5th July; Marathawada during 4th-6th July; Saurashtra & Kutch on 4th July.
- **Isolated thunderstorm & lightning** likely over Gujarat Region during 4th-6th July.

#### South Peninsular India:

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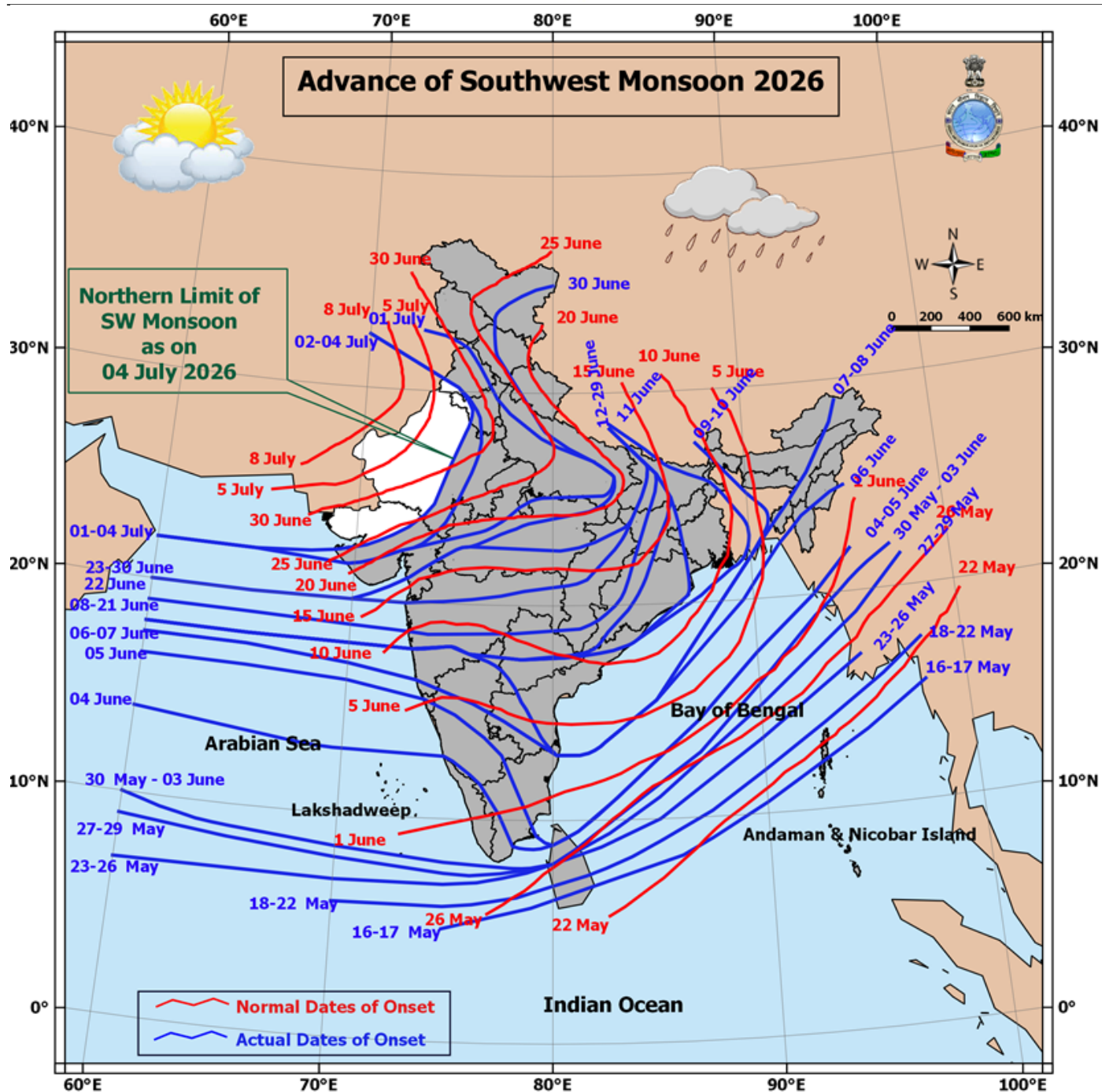

**Meteorological Analysis (Based on 0830 hours IST)**

- The **Northern Limit** of Monsoon continues to pass through 22°N/60°E, 22°N/65°E, Jamnagar, Udaipur, Ajmer, Jhunjhunu, Hisar, Bhatinda and 32.5°N/70°E as on 4th July.
- **Conditions are favourable** for further advance of southwest monsoon into some more parts of North Arabian Sea, Gujarat, remaining parts of Haryana & Punjab, and some more parts of Rajasthan during next 4 days.
- The **Well Marked Low Pressure Area** over Northwest Bay of Bengal & adjoining north Odisha-West Bengal coasts persists over the same region at 0830 hrs IST of today, 04<sup>th</sup> July, 2026. The associated cyclonic circulation extends upto 9.4 km above mean sea level tilting southwestwards with height. It is very likely to move west-northwestward across north Odisha and north Chhattisgarh during next 3 days.
- The **seasonal trough** at mean sea level now runs from southwest Rajasthan to the centre of **Well Marked Low Pressure Area** over Northwest Bay of Bengal & adjoining north Odisha-West Bengal coasts across Madhya Pradesh, north Chhattisgarh, north Odisha extending upto 1.5 km above mean sea level.
- The **shear zone** now runs roughly along latitude 21°N between 3.1 & 7.6 km above mean sea level.
- The **off-shore trough** at mean sea level now runs from south Gujarat to Karnataka coast.
- The **Western Disturbance** as a trough in middle tropospheric westerlies with its axis at 5.8 km above mean sea level roughly along Long. 70°E to the north of Lat. 29°N persists.



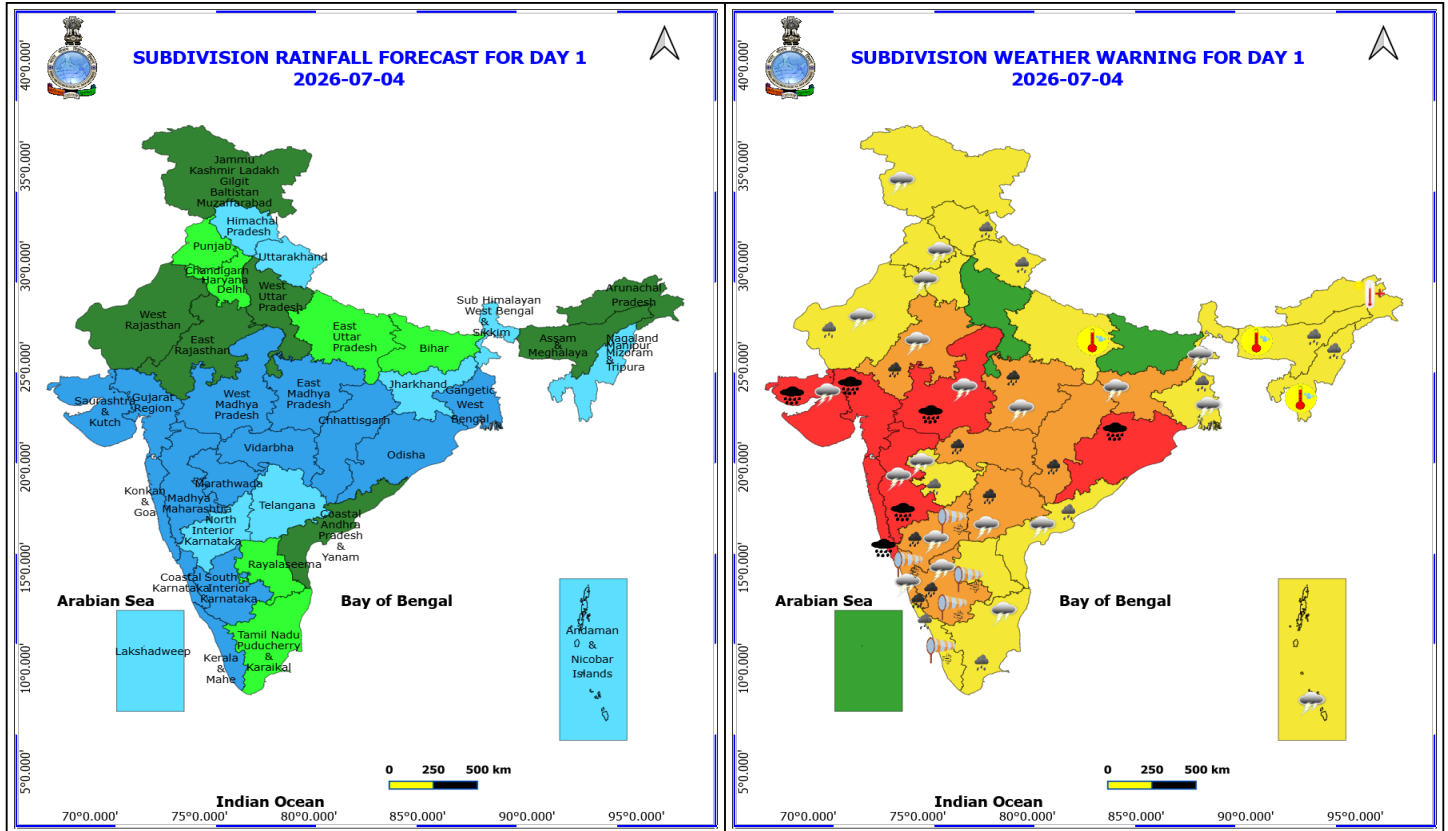

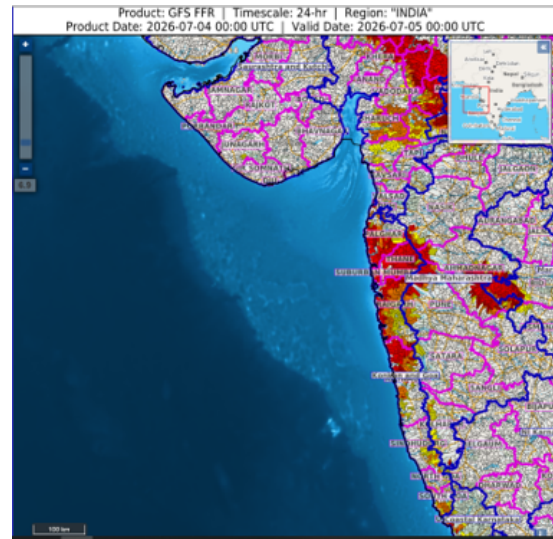

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Fig. 1: Maximum Temperatures Dated 2026-07-03

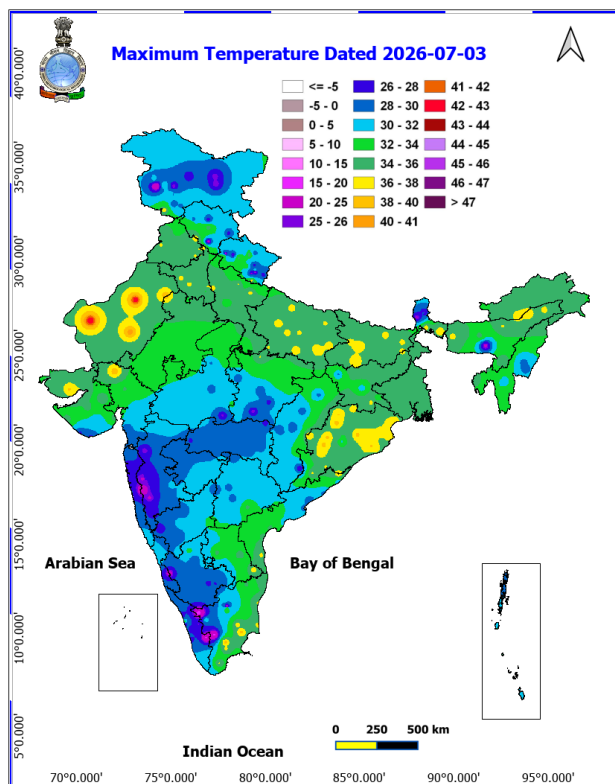


Fig. 2: Departure of Maximum Temp. Dated 2026-07-03

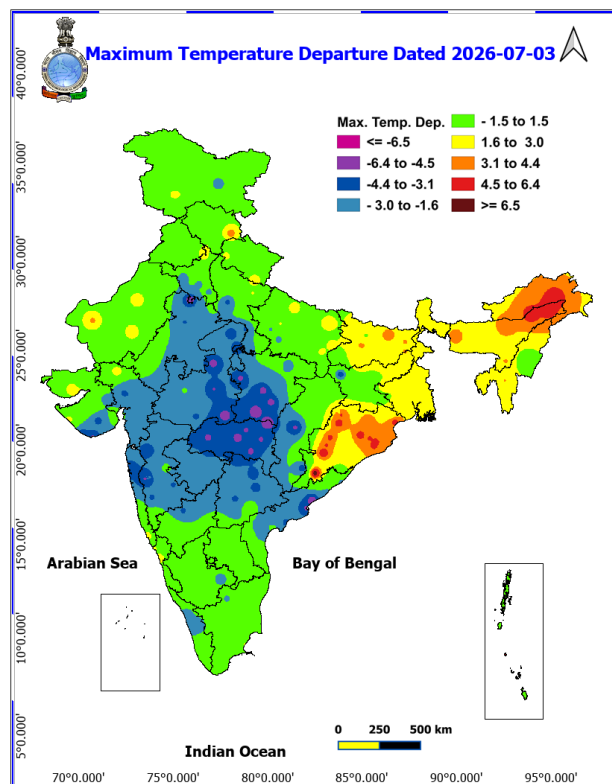


Fig. 3: Minimum Temperatures Dated 2026-07-04

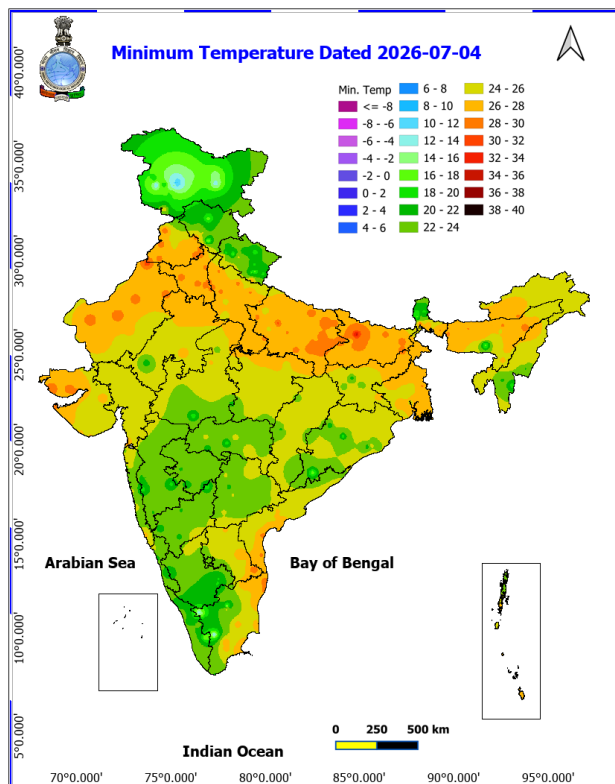
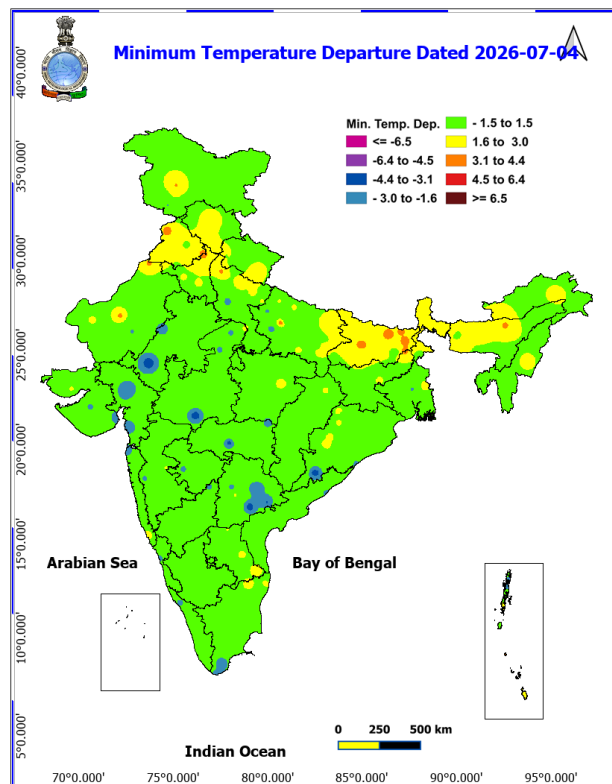
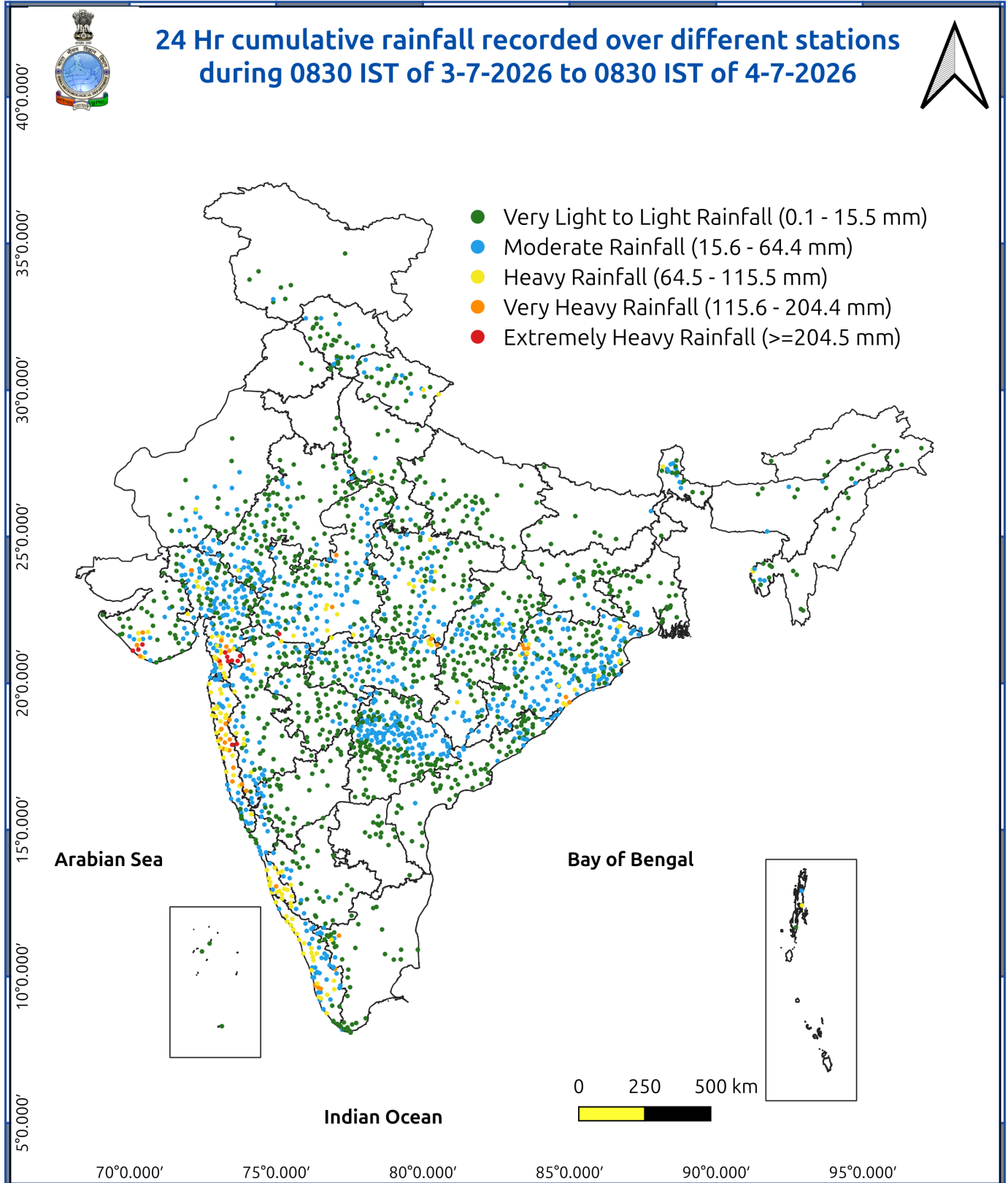


Fig. 4: Departure of Minimum Temp. Dated 2026-07-04





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## Impact and Actions

### Impact Expected & Action Suggested due to heavy/very heavy rainfall over

- Heavy to very heavy rainfall with extremely heavy rainfall likely at isolated places over West Madhya Pradesh on 04<sup>th</sup>; over Odisha and Saurashtra & Kutch on 04<sup>th</sup> & 05<sup>th</sup>; over Konkan & Goa and Gujarat Region during 04<sup>th</sup> -07<sup>th</sup>; Madhya Maharashtra during 04<sup>th</sup> -06<sup>th</sup> July.

#### Impact Expected

- Localized Flooding of roads, water logging in low lying areas and closure of underpasses mainly in urban areas.
- Occasional reduction in visibility due to heavy rainfall.
- Disruption of traffic in major cities due to water logging in roads leading to increased travel time.
- Minor damage to kutcha roads.
- Possibilities of damage to vulnerable structure.
- Localized Landslides/Mudslides/landslips/mudslips/landsinks/mudsinks.
- Damage to horticulture and standing crops in some areas due to inundation.
- It may lead to riverine flooding in some river catchments (for riverine flooding please visit Web page of CWC)

#### Action Suggested

- Check for traffic congestion on your route before leaving for your destination.
- Follow any traffic advisories that are issued in this regard.
- Avoid going to areas that face the water logging problems often.
- Avoid staying in vulnerable structure.

### Impact & suggested expected due to isolated thunderstorm with lightning/gusty & Squally winds over

- **Thundersquall (wind speed reaching 50-60 kmph gusting to 70 kmph)** likely over Telangana on 4th July. **Moderate to intense lightning activity** over Jharkhand on 04<sup>th</sup> July.

#### Impact expected:

- Breaking of tree branches, uprooting of large avenue trees. Large dead limbs blown from trees. Damage to Standing crops.
- Minor to Major damage to banana and papaya trees.
- Minor to major damage to power and communication lines due to breaking of branches.
- Strong wind/hail may damage plantation, horticulture and standing crops.
- Partial damage to vulnerable structures due to strong winds.
- Minor damage to kutcha houses/walls and huts.
- Loose objects may fly.

#### Action suggested:

- People are advised to keep a watch on the weather for worsening conditions and be ready to move to safer places accordingly.
- Stay indoors, close windows & doors and avoid travel if possible.
- Take safe shelters; do not take shelter under trees.
- Do not lie on concrete floors and do not lean against concrete walls.
- Unplug electrical/ electronic appliances.
- Immediately get out of water bodies.
- Keep away from all the objects that conduct electricity.

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**Agromet advisories for various parts of the country**

**Agromet advisories for likely impact of Heavy Rainfall**

- In **Assam**, ensure proper drainage arrangements for quick removal of excess water from rice nurseries, jute, ginger, turmeric, vegetables, banana, citrus and papaya. Avoid nursery sowing of *Sali* rice and sowing of jute, maize and vegetables during heavy rainfall. Cover the already seeded area with natural mulching materials like straw, farm residues etc. Provide mechanical support to the sugarcane crop to prevent lodging.
- In **Meghalaya**, ensure proper drainage channels in rice nurseries, maize, ginger, cowpea, vegetable fields and banana plantations. Protect young seedlings from direct exposure to heavy rainfall. Use propping (bamboo or wooden poles) to support heavily laden plants.
- In **Nagaland**, delay transplanting of brinjal in main field. For already transplanted seedlings, maintain proper drainage in and around the fields of maize, vegetables and orchard.
- In **Manipur**, avoid transplanting of rice during heavy rainfall. Ensure proper drainage in soybean, chilli, ginger, turmeric, banana and other crop fields and newly transplanted seedlings and nursery crops to avoid water stagnation.
- In **Mizoram**, create drainage channels surrounding the rice fields and utilize grass mulch to cover the seeds. Provide support to fruit-bearing or partially lodge plants/trees. Propping should be done to prevent maize plants from lodging.
- In **Tripura**, ensure adequate drainage arrangements to remove excess water from rice and vegetable fields during heavy rainfall.
- In **Odisha**, avoid sowing of green gram during heavy rainfall. Make provision to drain out excess rain water from fields of rice, maize, millets and pulse crops and fruit orchards.
- In **Himachal Pradesh**, maintain proper drainage channels in fields of maize, finger millet and vegetables to prevent waterlogging.
- In **Uttarakhand**, ensure proper field drainage in fields of rice, maize, tomato, chilli, barnyard millet and finger millet to drain out excess rain water from the field.
- In **Madhya Pradesh**, harvest mature green gram, vegetables and fruits and store the produce in safe place.
- In **Chhattisgarh**, ensure proper drainage in nurseries of rice and vegetables.
- In **Gujarat**, drain out excess water from rice nursery; fields of sugarcane, okra, vegetables, yam and sapota orchards.
- In **Konkan**, postpone nursery sowing of rice, finger millet and vegetables; sowing of groundnut and cucurbitaceous vegetables and planting of new orchards like mango, coconut, cashewnut and arecanut. Drain out excess water from nurseries of rice and finger millet and fields of rice and vegetables.
- In *ghat* areas of **Madhya Maharashtra**, make arrangement to drain out excess water from nurseries of rice and finger millet.
- In **Vidarbha**, ensure proper drainage in vegetable nurseries and fruit orchards.
- In **Keralam**, drain out excess water from banana, coconut, cardamom, ginger, black pepper and vegetables. Provide staking support in banana plants and strengthen the pandals of vegetable crops. Avoid transplanting of rice during heavy rain.
- In **Karnataka**, ensure proper drainage in rice seedbeds, rice fields, arecanut and coconut fields and fruit orchards to prevent water stagnation.
- In the regions expecting heavy rainfall, including **Telangana, Coastal Andhra Pradesh, Rajasthan, Gangetic West Bengal and Andaman and Nicobar** withhold irrigation in standing crops, make necessary arrangements to remove excess rain water from the crop fields.

**Agromet advisories for likely impact of Thunderstorm / Gusty Winds**

- Shift the harvested produce in safer places or cover the produce with tarpaulin sheets in the fields. Tie the harvested crops securely and cover them to minimize the risk of displacement from strong surface winds.
- Provide mechanical support to horticultural crops and staking or support to vegetables and young fruit plants / fruit-bearing plants to avoid lodging due to strong winds.

**Livestock / Poultry / Fisheries**

- Keep the animals inside the shed during heavy rainfall and provide them balanced feed.



- Store the feed and fodder in a safe place to prevent spoilage.
- In regions with high temperatures and heat wave conditions, provide clean, cool drinking water to animals, and cover the roofs of poultry sheds with grass to reduce the adverse effects of heat.
- Construct an outlet with proper netting around the ponds to drain excess water, thereby preventing fish from escaping in the event of overflow.

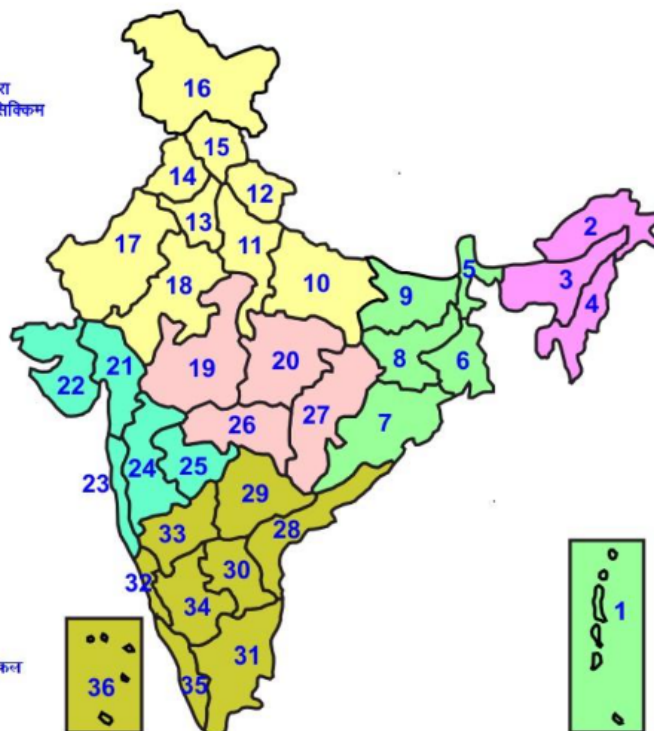
