Significant Weather Features

Advance of Southwest Monsoon 2026

- The **Northern Limit** of Monsoon continues to pass through 22°N/60°E, 22°N/65°E, Jamnagar, Udaipur, Ajmer, Jhunjhunu, Hisar, Bhatinda and 32.5°N/70°E as on 5th July.
- Conditions are favourable** for further advance of southwest monsoon into some more parts of North Arabian Sea, Gujarat, remaining parts of Haryana & Punjab, and some more parts of Rajasthan during next 3 days.

Weather forecast and Warnings:

Northwest India:

- Isolated to Scattered** rainfall likely over Jammu-Kashmir-Ladakh-Gilgit-Baltistan-Muzaffarabad during 5th-6th July.
- Isolated to Scattered** rainfall likely over Haryana Chandigarh & Delhi and Punjab during 5th-6th July and on 10th July; West Uttar Pradesh during 5th-8th July; East Uttar Pradesh during 5th-7th July; West Rajasthan during 5th-11th July; East Rajasthan on 5th July and on 11th July.
- Fairly Widespread to Widespread** rainfall likely over Jammu-Kashmir-Ladakh-Gilgit-Baltistan-Muzaffarabad during 7th-11th July; Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand during 5th-11th July.

- Isolated **thunderstorm, lightning & gusty winds (speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph)** likely over Jammu-Kashmir-Ladakh-Gilgit-Baltistan-Muzaffarabad during 5th-11th July.
- Isolated **thunderstorm, lightning & gusty winds (speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph)** likely over Haryana Chandigarh & Delhi, Uttar Pradesh and Punjab on 5th July; East Rajasthan and West Rajasthan during 5th-11th July.
- Isolated **thunderstorm & lightning** likely over Uttarakhand during 5th-11th July; East Uttar Pradesh and West Uttar Pradesh during 6th-8th July.
- Isolated **heavy rainfall** likely over Jammu-Kashmir-Ladakh-Gilgit-Baltistan-Muzaffarabad during 6th-8th July; Himachal Pradesh on 5th July and during 8th-11th July; Uttarakhand during 7th-11th July; Haryana Chandigarh & Delhi and Punjab during 6th-9th July and on 11th July; West Uttar Pradesh during 9th-11th July; East Uttar Pradesh during 8th-9th July; West Rajasthan during 7th-8th July; East Rajasthan on 5th July and on 11th July with isolated **very heavy rainfall** also likely over Himachal Pradesh during 6th-7th July; Uttarakhand during 5th-6th July; East Uttar Pradesh during 10th-11th July; East Rajasthan during 6th-10th July.

Central India:

- Fairly Widespread to Widespread** rainfall likely over West Madhya Pradesh during 5th-9th July; East Madhya Pradesh and Vidarbha during 5th-10th July; Chhattisgarh during 5th-6th July and on 11th July.
- Isolated to Scattered** rainfall likely over West Madhya Pradesh during 10th-11th July; East Madhya Pradesh and Vidarbha on 11th July; Chhattisgarh during 7th-10th July.
- Isolated **thunderstorm, lightning & gusty winds (speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph)** likely over Chhattisgarh on 5th July.
- Isolated **thunderstorm & lightning** likely over East Madhya Pradesh and West Madhya Pradesh during 5th-9th July; Vidarbha on 5th July.
- Isolated **heavy rainfall** likely over East Madhya Pradesh and West Madhya Pradesh during 9th-10th July; Vidarbha during 6th-7th July; Chhattisgarh during 5th-8th July with isolated **very heavy rainfall** also likely over East Madhya Pradesh and West Madhya Pradesh during 5th-8th July; Vidarbha on 5th July.
- Heavy to very heavy rainfall with extremely heavy rainfall likely at isolated places over Chhattisgarh on 05th & 06th July.**
- Moderate to intense lightning activity over West Madhya Pradesh on 05th July.**

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East India:

- **Fairly Widespread to Widespread** rainfall likely over Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Gangetic West Bengal, Jharkhand and Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim during 5th-11th July; Odisha during 5th-7th July.
- **Isolated to Scattered** rainfall likely over Bihar during 5th-11th July; Odisha during 8th-11th July.
- **Isolated thunderstorm, lightning & gusty winds (speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph)** likely over Andaman & Nicobar Islands during 7th-11th July; Gangetic West Bengal during 5th-7th July; Jharkhand during 5th-9th July; Bihar on 6th July, **with gusty winds (speed reaching 30-40 kmph gusting to 50 kmph)** likely over Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim during 5th-11th July; Gangetic West Bengal during 8th-11th July; Bihar on 5th July and during 7th-11th July.
- **Isolated heavy rainfall** likely over Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim during 5th-7th July and during 10th-11th July; Gangetic West Bengal on 6th July; Jharkhand during 5th-8th July; Bihar during 6th-8th July and on 11th July; Odisha on 5th July and during 7th-8th July with isolated **very heavy rainfall** also likely over Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim during 8th-9th July; Gangetic West Bengal on 5th July; Odisha on 6th July.
- **Thundersquall (wind speed reaching 50-60 kmph gusting to 70 kmph)** likely over Andaman & Nicobar Islands during 5th-6th July.
- **Heavy to very heavy rainfall with extremely heavy rainfall likely at isolated places over Odisha on 05th July.**
- **Moderate to intense lightning activity over Bihar on 06th July.**

Northeast India:

- **Isolated to Scattered** rainfall likely over Arunachal Pradesh and Assam & Meghalaya during 5th-6th July.
- **Fairly Widespread to Widespread** rainfall likely over Arunachal Pradesh and Assam & Meghalaya during 7th-11th July; Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura during 5th-11th July.
- **Isolated thunderstorm, lightning & gusty winds (speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph)** likely over Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura on 5th July.
- **Isolated thunderstorm & lightning** likely over Arunachal Pradesh and Assam & Meghalaya during 5th-9th July; Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura during 6th-9th July.
- **Isolated heavy rainfall** likely over Arunachal Pradesh during 6th-11th July; Assam & Meghalaya and Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura during 5th-11th July.

West India:

- **Fairly Widespread to Widespread** rainfall likely over Konkan & Goa during 5th-11th July; Madhya Maharashtra during 5th-8th July; Marathwada and Saurashtra & Kutch during 5th-6th July; Gujarat Region during 5th-9th July.
- **Isolated to Scattered** rainfall likely over Madhya Maharashtra during 9th-11th July; Marathwada and Saurashtra & Kutch during 7th-11th July; Gujarat Region during 10th-11th July.
- **Isolated thunderstorm, lightning & gusty winds (speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph)** likely over Gujarat Region, Madhya Maharashtra, Marathwada and Saurashtra & Kutch during 5th-6th July.
- **Isolated heavy rainfall** likely over Gujarat Region and Konkan & Goa during 5th-7th July and on 9th July; Madhya Maharashtra during 5th-6th July and during 8th-9th July; Marathwada during 5th-6th July; Saurashtra & Kutch on 5th July and during 8th-9th July with isolated **very heavy rainfall** also likely over Gujarat Region and Konkan & Goa on 8th July; Madhya Maharashtra on 7th July; Saurashtra & Kutch during 6th-7th July.
- **Heavy to very heavy rainfall with extremely heavy rainfall likely at isolated places over Konkan & Goa, Gujarat Region during 05th -07th; Madhya Maharashtra on 05th & 06th; Saurashtra & Kutch on 05th July.**

South Peninsular India:

- **Isolated to Scattered** rainfall likely over Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Rayalaseema, South Interior Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal and Telangana during 5th-11th July; Lakshadweep during 5th-6th July and during 10th-11th July; North Interior Karnataka during 8th-11th July.
- **Fairly Widespread to Widespread** rainfall likely over Coastal Karnataka and Kerala & Mahe during 5th-11th July; Lakshadweep during 7th-9th July; North Interior Karnataka during 5th-7th July.
- **Isolated thunderstorm, lightning & gusty winds (speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph)** likely

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over Kerala & Mahe and Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal during 5th-7th July; Coastal Karnataka and North Interior Karnataka during 8th-9th July; Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam during 6th-9th July; Rayalaseema during 5th-9th July; Telangana during 8th-11th July, **with gusty winds (speed reaching 30-40 kmph gusting to 50 kmph)** likely over Coastal Karnataka and North Interior Karnataka during 10th-11th July.

- Isolated **heavy rainfall** likely over Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal on 5th July; Kerala & Mahe on 5th July and during 8th-9th July; Coastal Karnataka during 10th-11th July; North Interior Karnataka during 8th-9th July; South Interior Karnataka during 9th-10th July with isolated **very heavy rainfall** also likely over Kerala & Mahe during 6th-7th July; Coastal Karnataka during 5th-9th July; North Interior Karnataka during 5th-7th July; South Interior Karnataka during 5th-8th July; Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam on 5th July.
- **Thundersquall (wind speed reaching 50-60 kmph gusting to 70 kmph)** likely over Coastal Karnataka, North Interior Karnataka and Telangana during 5th-7th July; Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam on 5th July.
- Strong Surface Winds likely over Coastal Karnataka, Kerala & Mahe and Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal during 5th-7th July; Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam during 7th-9th July; Rayalaseema during 5th-9th July; Telangana during 5th-11th July.

Hot & Humid weather warning:

- **Hot and humid** weather conditions likely to prevail over Arunachal Pradesh on 5th July; Assam & Meghalaya during 5th-6th July.

Wind Warning:

- Squally wind speed reaching 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph is likely to prevail over northwest Bay of Bengal, along & off Odisha, West Bengal and north Andhra Pradesh coasts till morning of 6th July. Thereafter, it is likely to decrease gradually becoming 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph over the same region by 6th evening and likely to prevail till morning of 7th July.
- Squally wind speed reaching 35-45 kmph gusting to 55 kmph is likely to prevail over central and northeast Bay of Bengal during 5th and 6th July.
- Squally wind speed reaching 30-40 kmph gusting to 50 kmph is likely to prevail over north interior Odisha, north Chhattisgarh and adjoining areas of Jharkhand on 5th July. It is likely to increase becoming 35-45 kmph gusting to 55 kmph from 6th July and till morning of 7th July and decrease gradually thereafter.

Sea Condition:

- **Sea condition is very likely to be rough to very rough** over northwest Bay of Bengal, along & off Odisha, West Bengal and north Andhra Pradesh coasts during next 24 hours. Thereafter, it is likely to decrease gradually becoming rough over the same region by 6th evening and likely to prevail till morning of 7th July and improve gradually thereafter.
- **Sea condition is very likely to be moderate to rough** over central and northeast Bay of Bengal during 5th and 6th July and improve gradually thereafter.

- Fishermen are advised not to venture into northwest Bay of Bengal, along & off Odisha, West Bengal and north Andhra Pradesh coasts till 7th July.

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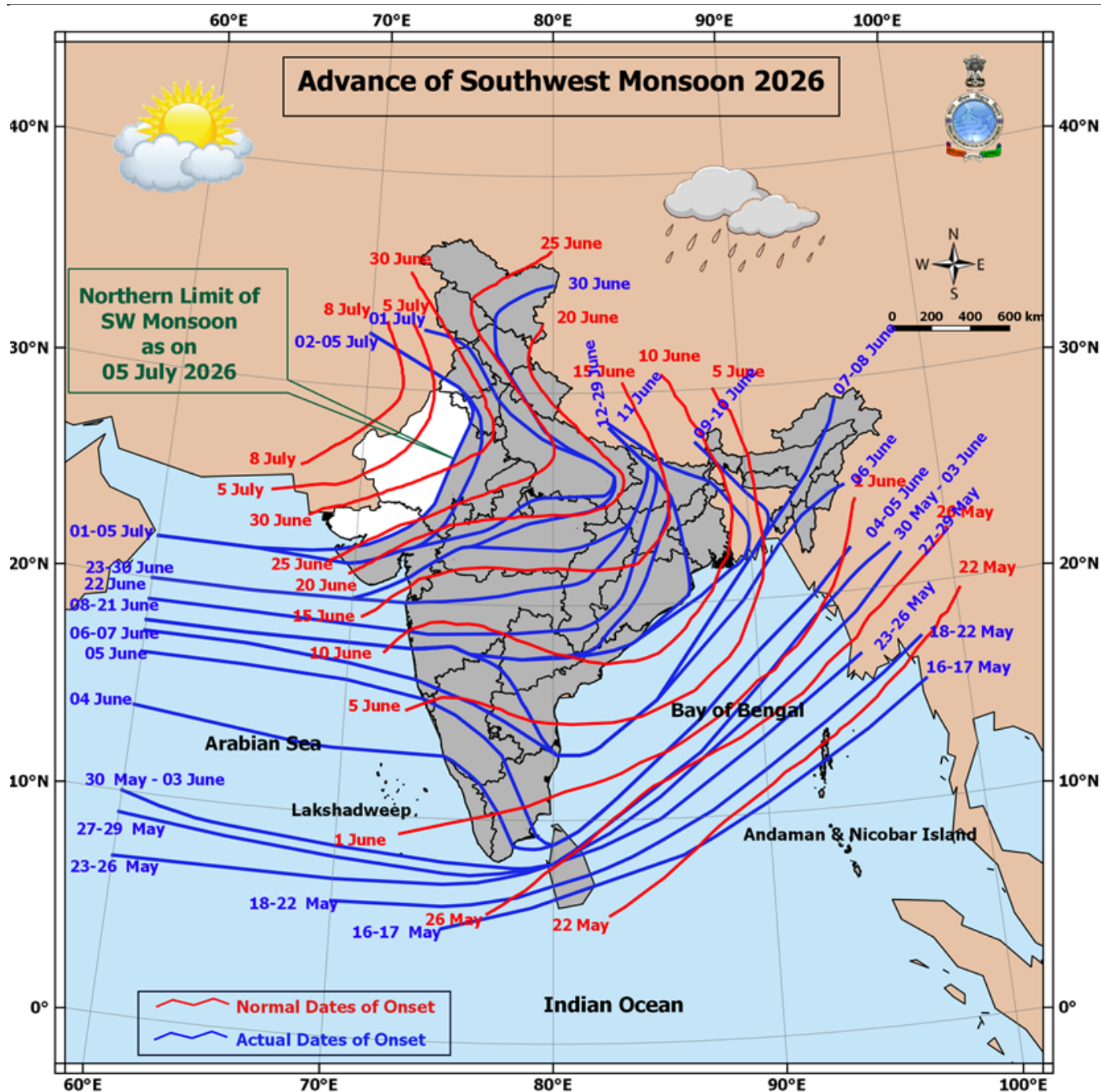

Meteorological Analysis (Based on 0830 hours IST)

- The **Northern Limit** of Monsoon continues to pass through 22°N/60°E, 22°N/65°E, Jamnagar, Udaipur, Ajmer, Jhunjhunu, Hisar, Bhatinda and 32.5°N/70°E as on 5th July.
- **Conditions are favourable** for further advance of southwest monsoon into some more parts of North Arabian Sea, Gujarat, remaining parts of Haryana & Punjab, and some more parts of Rajasthan during next 3 days.
- The **Well Marked Low Pressure Area** over northwest Bay of Bengal and adjoining areas of North Odisha-West Bengal coasts concentrated into a **Depression** and lay centred at 0830 hrs IST of today, the 5th July 2026, over the same region near Lat. 21.1°N and Long. 87.2°E, about 50 km south-southeast of Balasore (Odisha), 60 km northeast of Chandbali (Odisha) and 60 km south-southwest of Digha (West Bengal). It is very likely to move west-northwestwards and cross North Odisha coast between Chandbali and Digha close to Balasore during next 24 hours. It is very likely to continue to move further west-northwestwards, across North Odisha and North Chhattisgarh during subsequent 24 hours.
- The **seasonal trough** at mean sea level now runs from southwest Rajasthan to eastcentral Bay of Bengal across Madhya Pradesh, north Chhattisgarh, north Odisha and the centre of Depression over Northwest Bay of Bengal & adjoining north Odisha-West Bengal coasts and extends upto 1.5 km above mean sea level.
- The **shear zone** roughly along latitude 21°N between 3.1 & 7.6 km above mean sea level persists.
- The **off-shore trough** at mean sea level from south Gujarat to Karnataka coast now runs from south Gujarat to Kerala coast.
- The **Western Disturbance** as a trough in middle & upper tropospheric westerlies with its axis at 5.8 km above mean sea level runs roughly along Long. 72°E to the north of Lat. 30°N.

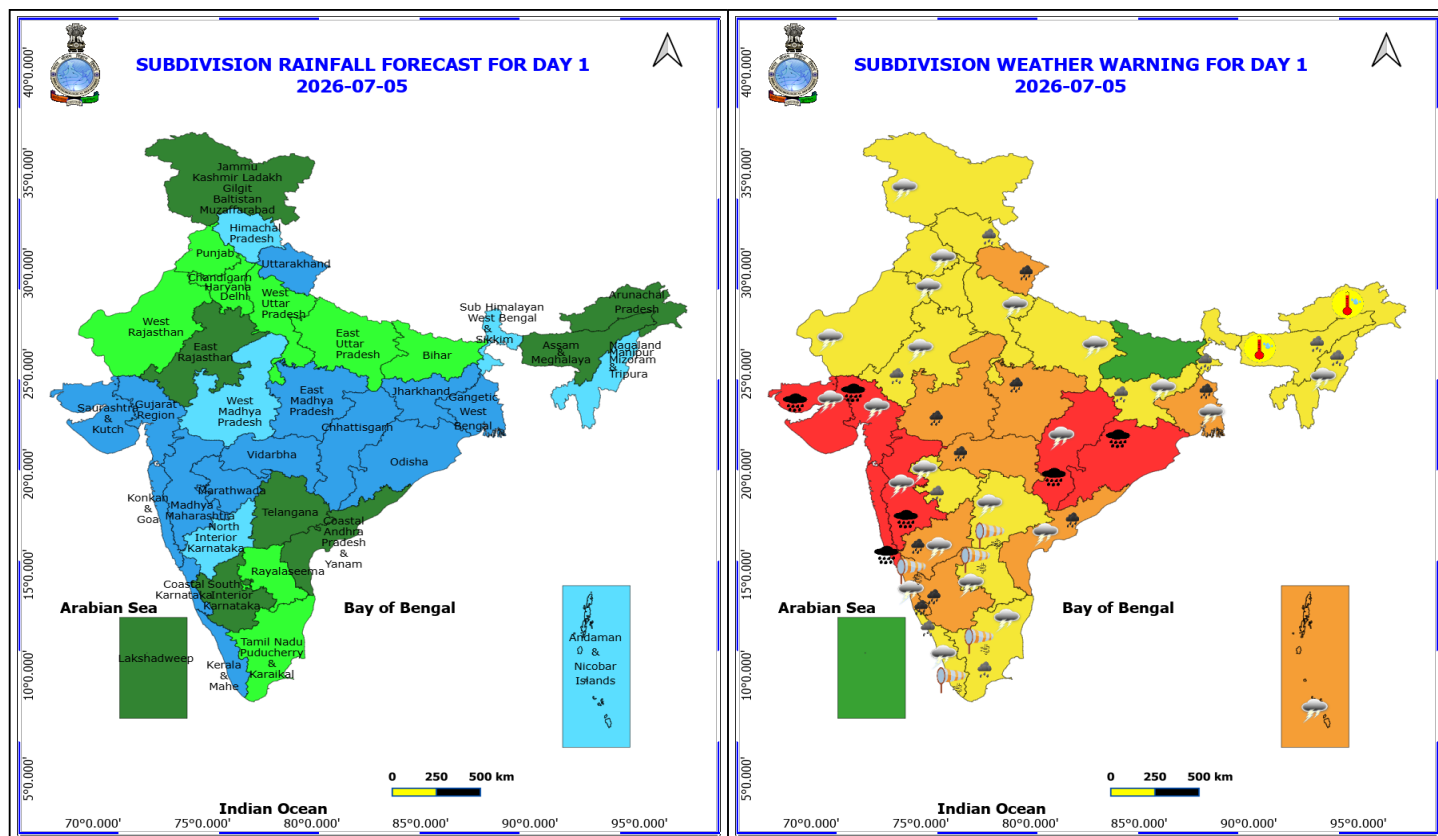

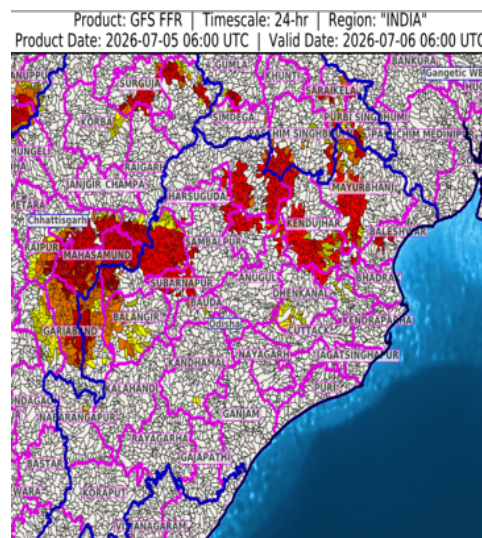

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Fig. 1: Maximum Temperatures Dated 2026-07-04

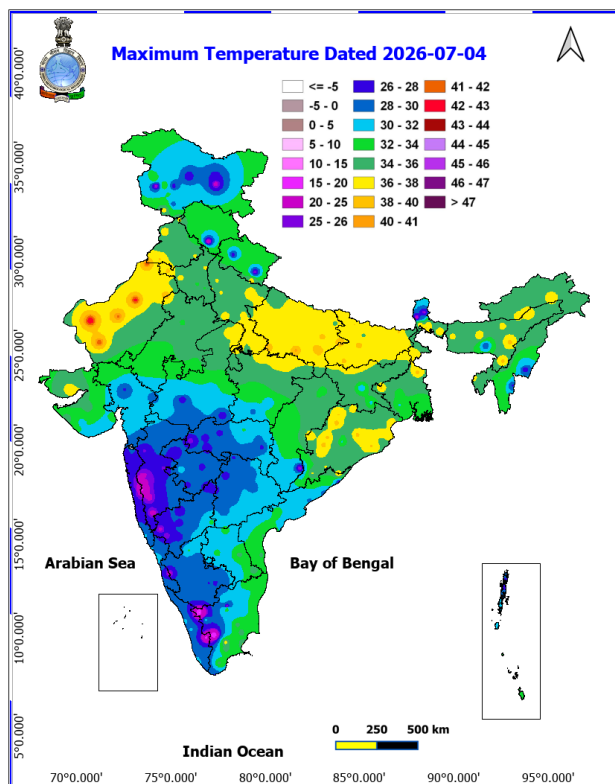


Fig. 2: Departure of Maximum Temp. Dated 2026-07-04

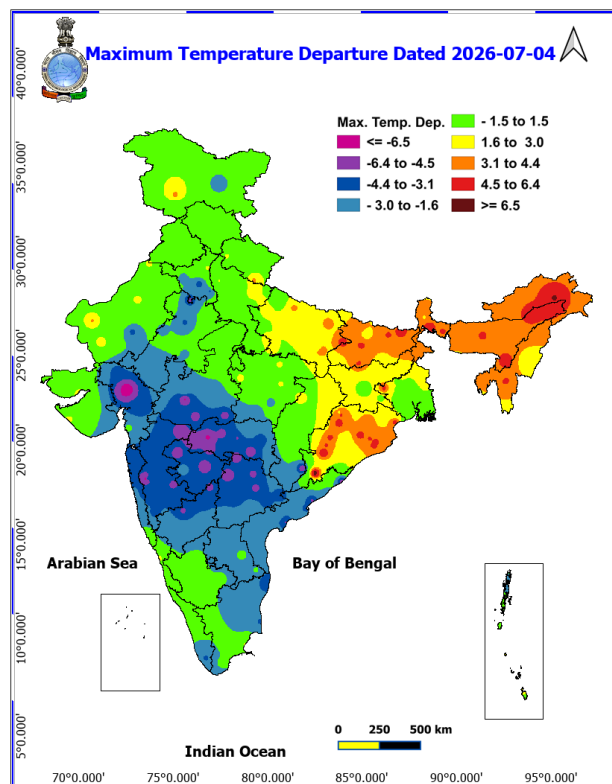


Fig. 3: Minimum Temperatures Dated 2026-07-05

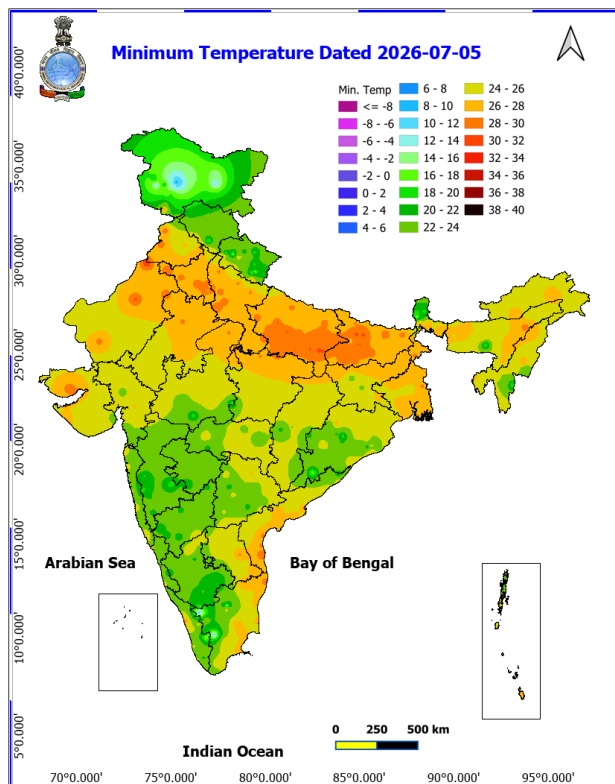
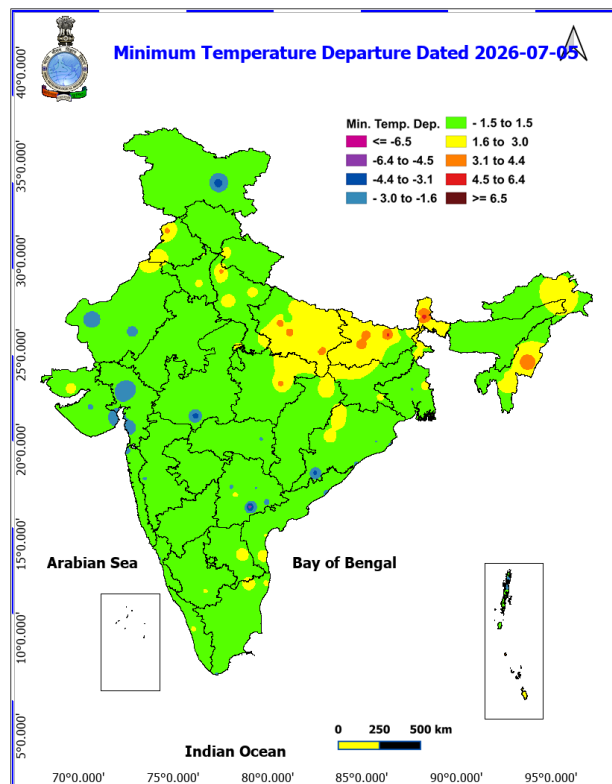
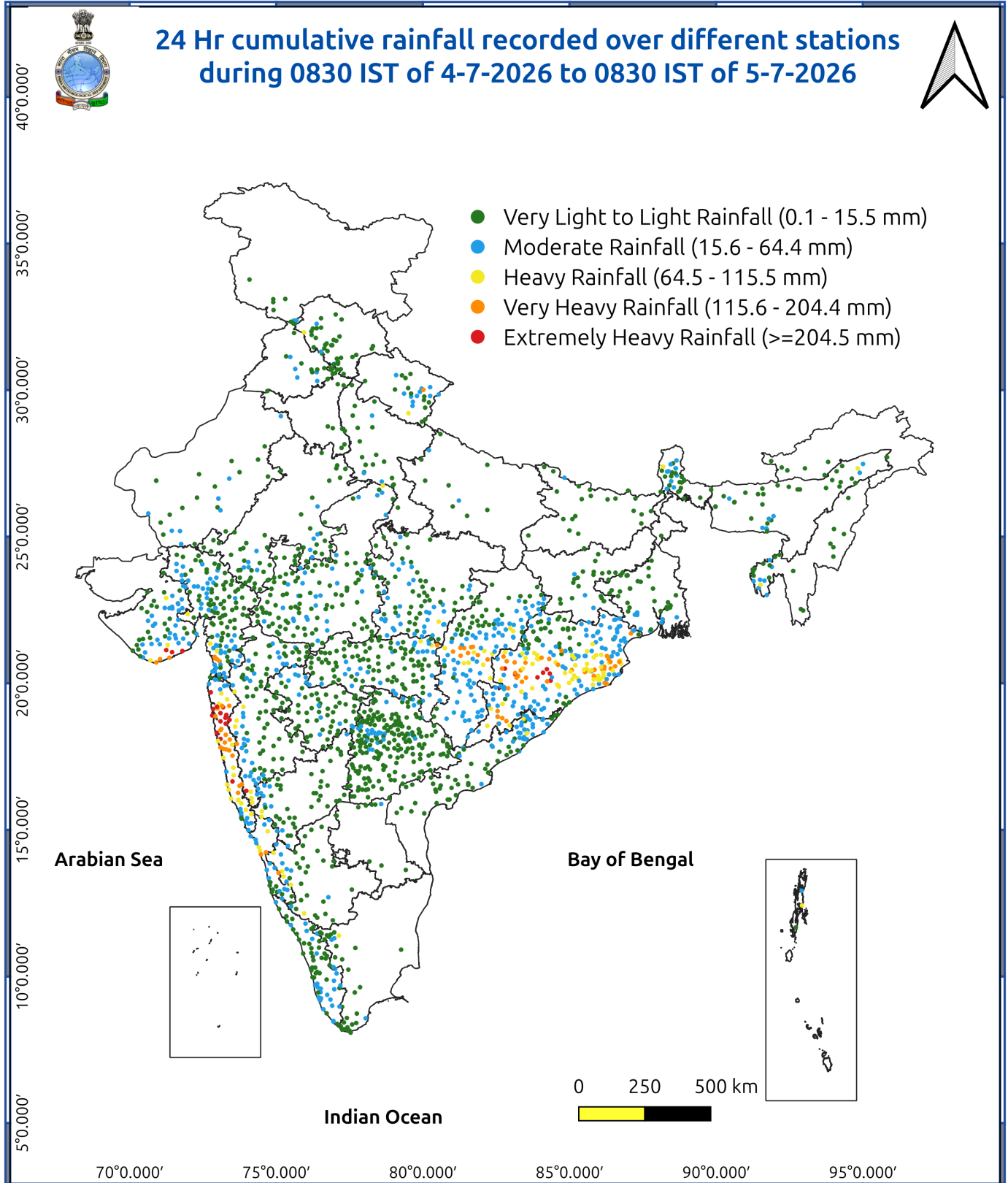


Fig. 4: Departure of Minimum Temp. Dated 2026-07-05





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Impact and Actions

Impact Expected & Action Suggested due to heavy/very heavy rainfall over

- Heavy to very heavy rainfall with extremely heavy rainfall likely at isolated places over Chhattisgarh on 05th & 06th July; Odisha on 05th July; Konkan & Goa, Gujarat Region during 05th -07th; Madhya Maharashtra on 05th & 06th; Saurashtra & Kutch on 05th July.

Impact Expected

- Localized Flooding of roads, water logging in low lying areas and closure of underpasses mainly in urban areas.
- Occasional reduction in visibility due to heavy rainfall.
- Disruption of traffic in major cities due to water logging in roads leading to increased travel time.
- Minor damage to kutcha roads.
- Possibilities of damage to vulnerable structure.
- Localized Landslides/Mudslides/landslips/mudslips/landsinks/mudsinks.
- Damage to horticulture and standing crops in some areas due to inundation.
- It may lead to riverine flooding in some river catchments (for riverine flooding please visit Web page of CWC)

Action Suggested

- Check for traffic congestion on your route before leaving for your destination.
- Follow any traffic advisories that are issued in this regard.
- Avoid going to areas that face the water logging problems often.
- Avoid staying in vulnerable structure.

Impact expected and action suggested due to isolated thunderstorm with lightning, gusty/squally winds

- **Thundersquall (wind speed reaching 50-60 kmph gusting to 70 kmph)** likely over Andaman & Nicobar Islands during 5th-6th July; Coastal Karnataka, North Interior Karnataka and Telangana during 5th-7th July; Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam on 5th July.
- **Moderate to intense lightning activity over West Madhya Pradesh on 05th; Bihar on 06th July.**

Impact expected:

- Breaking of tree branches, uprooting of large avenue trees. Large dead limbs blown from trees. Damage to Standing crops.
- Minor to Major damage to banana and papaya trees.
- Minor to major damage to power and communication lines due to breaking of branches.
- Strong wind/hail may damage plantation, horticulture and standing crops.
- Partial damage to vulnerable structures due to strong winds.
- Minor damage to kutcha houses/walls and huts.
- Loose objects may fly.

Action suggested:

- People are advised to keep a watch on the weather for worsening conditions and be ready to move to safer places accordingly.
- Stay indoors, close windows & doors and avoid travel if possible.
- Take safe shelters; do not take shelter under trees.
- Do not lie on concrete floors and do not lean against concrete walls.
- Unplug electrical/ electronic appliances.
- Immediately get out of water bodies.
- Keep away from all the objects that conduct electricity.

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Agromet advisories for various parts of the country

Agromet advisories for likely impact of Heavy Rainfall

- In **Sub Himalayan West Bengal**, protect rice nursery beds with straw mulch, dry grass, or temporary polythene / agro-net covers to prevent seed washing, poor germination and seedling loss. Drain out excess water from jute, ginger, chilli, tomato and dalley khorsani fields and nurseries of *kharif* rice, finger millet and vegetables.
- In **Gangetic West Bengal**, harvest mature sesame pods promptly and keep the harvested produce in safer place. Arrange proper drainage in vegetables, ginger and turmeric fields and betel vine gardens to avoid waterlogging.
- In **Odisha**, postpone transplanting of rice seedlings and sowing of *kharif* crops till cessation of heavy rainfall. Drain out excess rain water from rice and vegetable nurseries and fields of rice, maize, cotton, millets, vegetables and pulse crops and fruit orchards to prevent waterlogging.
- In **Jharkhand**, construct channels around the rice nursery bed to maintain proper drainage.
- In **Bihar**, harvest the mature pods of summer green gram and keep harvested produce in safer places. Provide adequate drainage facilities in rice nurseries and maize fields.
- In **Madhya Pradesh**, harvest mature green gram, vegetables and fruits and store the produce in safe place. Postpone sowing of soybean. Maintain effective drainage channels in rice and vegetable nurseries and fields of ginger and turmeric during heavy rainfall to avoid water stagnation.
- In **Chhattisgarh**, ensure proper drainage in nurseries of rice and vegetables.
- In **Gujarat**, postpone sowing and transplanting of *kharif* crops until rainfall intensity decreases and fields conditions become favourable. Delay transplanting of rice in submerged fields until excess water recedes. Provide adequate drainage in nurseries to prevent seedling damage and waterlogging. Drain out excess water from rice nursery; fields of sugarcane, okra, vegetables, yam and sapota orchards.
- In **Konkan**, postpone nursery sowing of rice, finger millet and vegetables; sowing of groundnut and cucurbitaceous vegetables and planting of new orchards like mango, coconut, cashewnut and arecanut. Drain out excess water from nurseries of rice and finger millet and fields of rice and vegetables.
- In *ghat* areas of **Madhya Maharashtra**, drain out excess water from nurseries of rice, finger millet and vegetables.
- In **Vidarbha**, ensure proper drainage in vegetable nurseries and fruit orchards.
- In **Keralam**, provide adequate drainage facilities in banana, coconut, cardamom, ginger, black pepper and vegetables. Provide staking support in banana plants and strengthen the pandals of vegetable crops. Avoid transplanting of rice during heavy rain.
- In **Coastal Karnataka**, ensure proper drainage in rice seedbeds, rice fields and fruit orchards to prevent water stagnation. Avoid transplanting of rice during spells of heavy rains.
- In **South Interior Karnataka**, provide proper drainage in arecanut and coconut fields.
- In **Himachal Pradesh**, maintain proper drainage channels in fields of maize, finger millet and vegetables to prevent waterlogging. Delay sowing of rajma until the weather becomes clear.
- In **Uttarakhand**, postpone sowing of maize and soybean. Ensure proper drainage in fields of rice, maize, tomato, chilli, barnyard millet and finger millet to drain out excess rain water from the field.
- In **East Rajasthan**, postpone irrigation in summer crops. Make arrangements for draining out excess water from rice nurseries and fields of groundnut, green gram and cotton.
- In **Arunachal Pradesh**, maintain drainage channels in fields of rice, maize, soybean, finger millet and vegetables.
- In **Assam**, make provision for draining out excess water from rice nurseries, soybean, jute, ginger, turmeric, vegetables, banana, citrus and papaya. Provide mechanical support to the sugarcane crop to prevent lodging.
- In **Meghalaya**, ensure proper drainage channels in rice nurseries, maize, ginger, cowpea, vegetable fields and banana plantations. Protect young seedlings from direct exposure to heavy rainfall. Use propping (bamboo or wooden poles) to support heavily laden plants.
- In **Tripura**, ensure adequate drainage arrangements to remove excess water from rice and vegetable fields during heavy rainfall.

Agromet advisories for likely impact of Thunderstorm / Gusty Winds

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- Shift the harvested produce in safer places or cover the produce with tarpaulin sheets in the fields. Tie the harvested crops securely and cover them to minimize the risk of displacement from strong surface winds.
- Provide mechanical support to horticultural crops and staking or support to vegetables and young fruit plants / fruit-bearing plants to avoid lodging due to strong winds.

Livestock / Poultry / Fisheries

- Keep the animals inside the shed during heavy rainfall and provide them balanced feed.
- Store the feed and fodder in a safe place to prevent spoilage.
- In regions with high temperatures and heat wave conditions, provide clean, cool drinking water to animals, and cover the roofs of poultry sheds with grass to reduce the adverse effects of heat.
- Construct an outlet with proper netting around the ponds to drain excess water, thereby preventing fish from escaping in the event of overflow.

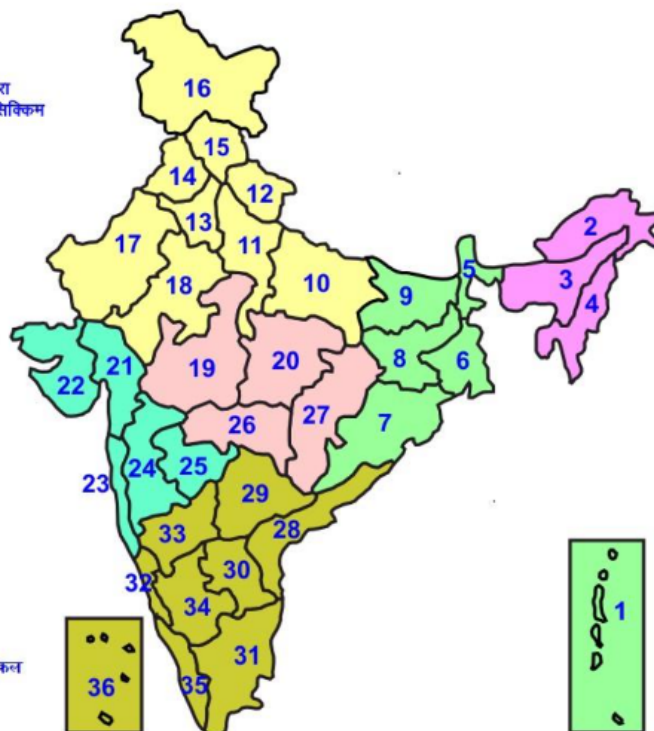
