Lakshadweep area	Day 1 (25.05.2026) to Day 4 (28.05.2026): Squally Weather with wind speed 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph is likely to prevail over Lakshadweep area.
Karnataka coast	Day 1 (25.05.2026) to Day 4 (28.05.2026): Squally Weather with wind speed 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph is likely to prevail along and off Karnataka coasts.

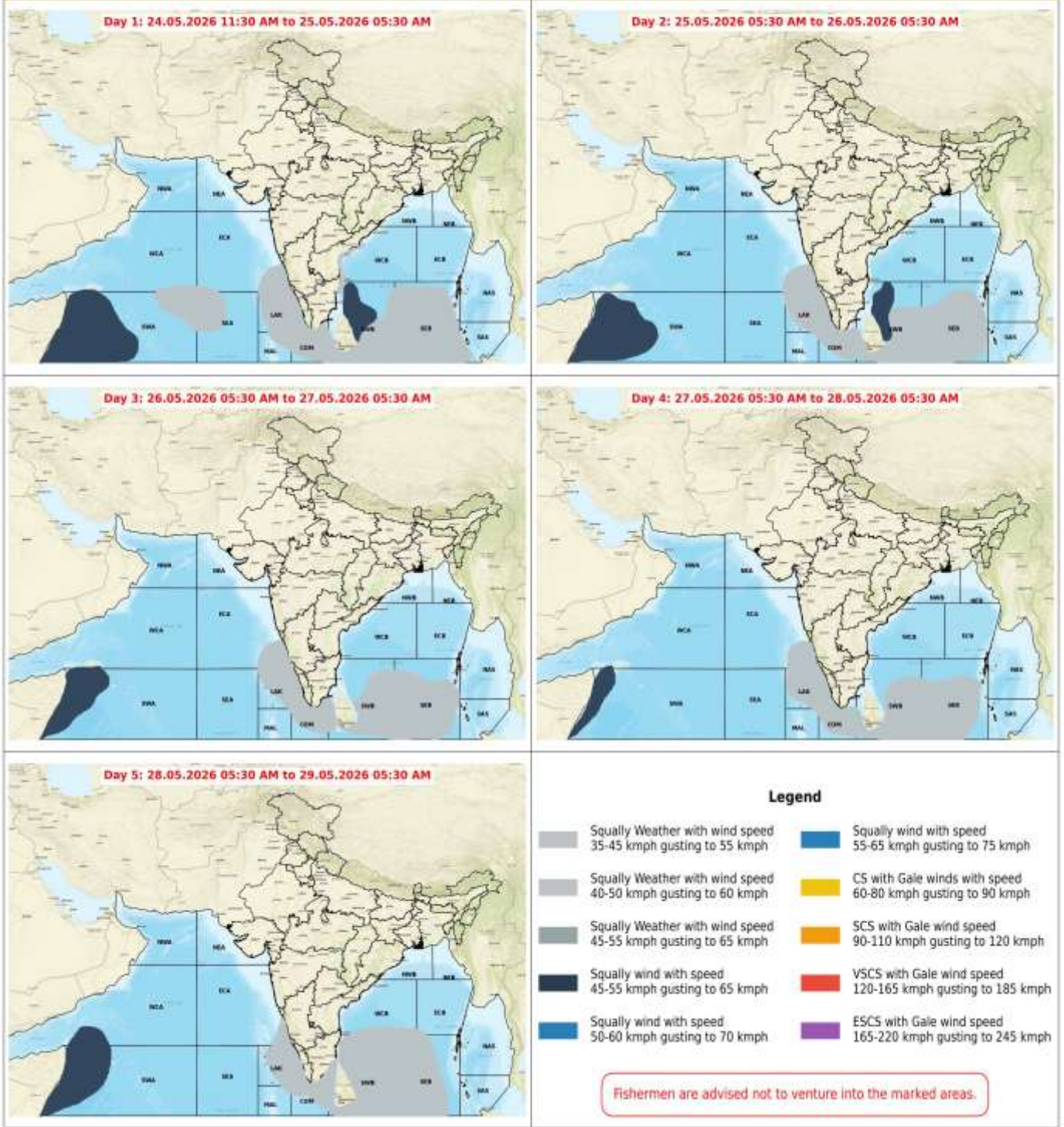
