



## Public Weather Bulletin

Thursday 14 February 2020

Time of Issue: 1530 IST

### Realised Weather (from 0830 hours IST of yesterday to 0830 hours IST of today)

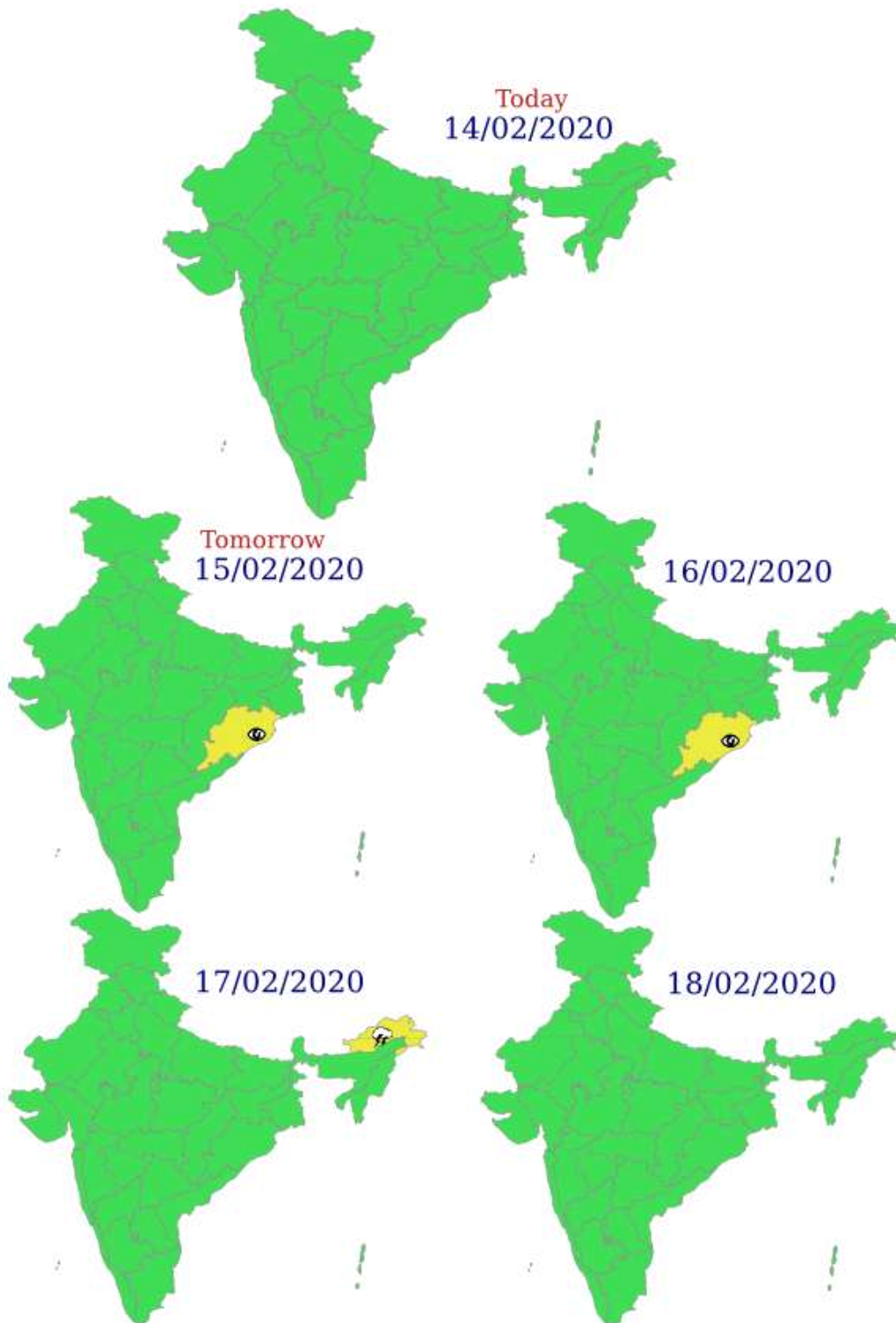
1. **Light Rainfall reported** at few places over Jammu & Kashmir. **Chief amount of Rainfall (1 cm or more): Kupwara-1.**
2. **Cold wave conditions** are observed in isolated pockets over Odisha.

### Weather System

1. A Western Disturbance as a cyclonic circulation lies over North Pakistan and adjoining Jammu & Kashmir at 3.1 km above mean sea level with a trough aloft with its axis at 5.8 km above mean sea level roughly along Long. 73°E to the north of Lat. 35°N.
2. A cyclonic circulation lies over northern parts of Bangladesh and neighbourhood between 1.5 & 2.1 km above mean sea level.
3. A fresh Western Disturbance is likely to affect Western Himalayan Region from 18th February onwards.

### Weather Forecast

1. Isolated light rain/snow very likely over Jammu & Kashmir, Gilgit-Baltistan, Muzaffarabad during next 24 hours.
2. Isolated to scattered light rain/snow very likely over Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur and Sikkim during 14th-18th February, 2020 and isolated rain/snow likely over Jammu & Kashmir, Ladakh and Himachal Pradesh on 18th February.
3. Dry weather very likely to prevail over remaining parts of the country during next 5 days.
4. **Strong surface winds** (speed reaching 20-30 kmph) very likely over the plains of Northwest India on 14th & 15th February, 2020.



### Legends:

**Light rain: 2.5-15.5 mm/day; isolated rain ( $\leq 25\%$  of stations gets rain), scattered (26% to 50% of stations gets rain).**
