



## Public Weather Bulletin

Thursday 13 February 2020  
Time of Issue: 1630 IST

### Realised Weather (from 0830 hours IST of yesterday to 0830 hours IST of today)

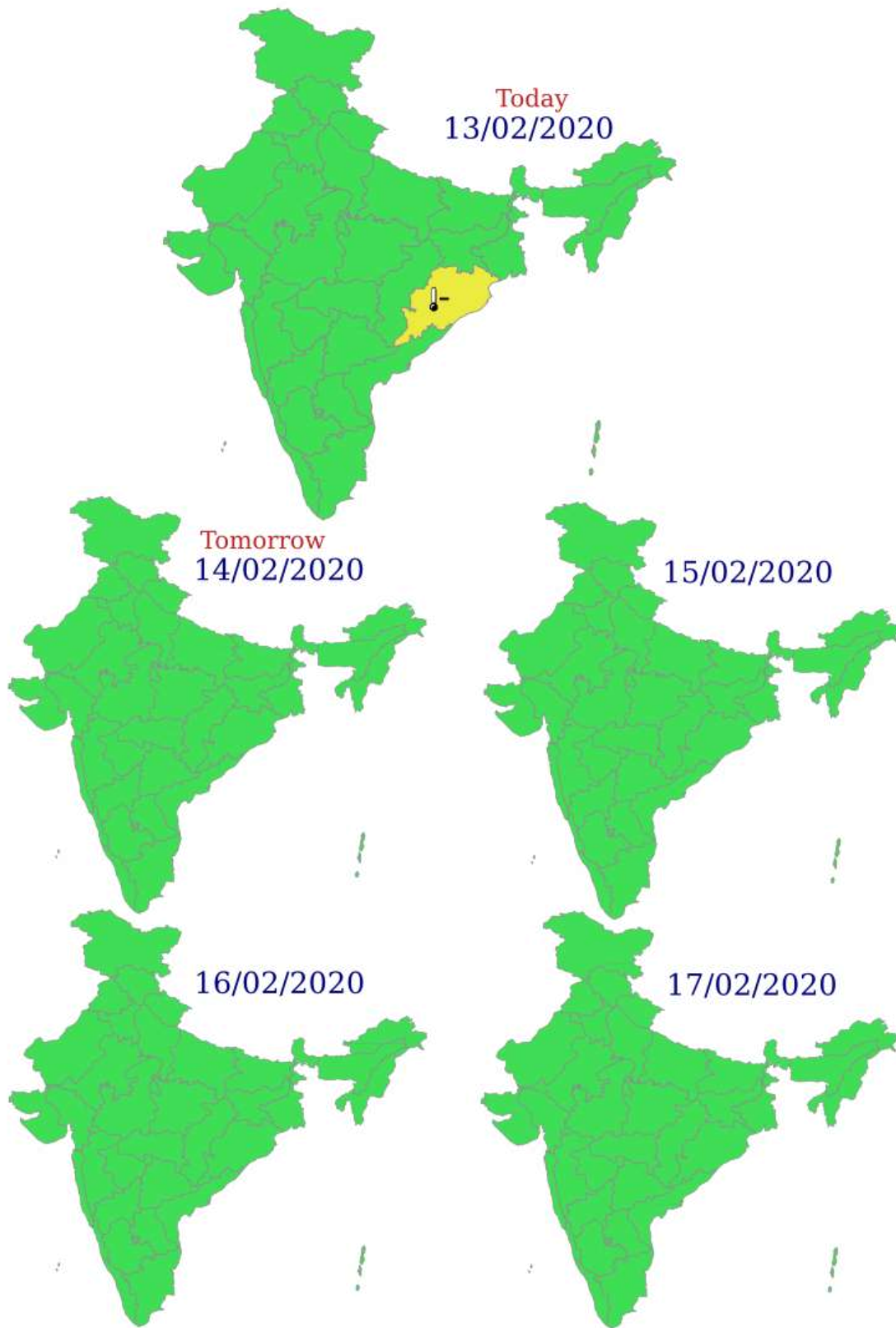
1. **Light Rain/Thundershowers** are observed at most places over Jammu & Kashmir. **Chief amount of Rainfall (1 cm or more):** Kupwara and Baderwah-1.
2. **Cold wave conditions** are observed in isolated pockets over Coastal Odisha.

### Weather System

1. A western disturbance as a trough in westerly winds lies over south Afganistan at middle tropospheric level.
2. It is very likely to move gradually eastwards causing light rainfall/snowfall over western Himalayan region during next 24 hours and over northeastern states during 14<sup>th</sup>-17<sup>th</sup> February, 2020.

### Weather Forecast

1. Fairly widespread light to moderate rain/snow very likely over Jammu & Kashmir, Gilgit-Baltistan, Muzaffarabad and isolated light rain/snow likely over Himachal Pradesh during next 24 hours.
2. Isolated light rain/snow very likely over Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur and Sikkim during 14th-17th February, 2020.
3. Dry weather very likely to prevail over remaining parts of the country during next 5 days.
4. **Cold wave conditions** likely at isolated pockets over Odisha during next 24 hours.
5. **Strong surface winds** (speed reaching 20-30 kmph) very likely over the plains of Northwest India on 13th & 14th February, 2020.



**Legends:**

**Light rain:** 2.5-15.5 mm/day; isolated rain ( $\leq 25\%$  of stations gets rain), scattered (26% to 50% of stations gets rain).
