**Subject: Weather forecast for Uttarakhand**

**Realized Weather during past 24-hours (from 0830 hrs IST of yesterday to 0830 hrs IST of today):** Light rainfall occurred at many places over Uttarakhand including Chamoli district along with isolated snowfall over higher reaches of north Uttarakhand as per meteorological observations. Realized rainfall (mm): Dehradun-2.3, Mukteshwar-1.6, Tehri-9.8, Joshimath-4.8, Tapovan-2.5.

**Weather forecast for Uttarakhand:**

Under the influence of Western Disturbance, scattered light to moderate rainfall with thunderstorm/hailstorm/lightning likely over Uttarakhand on 27<sup>th</sup> February. Isolated snowfall is also likely over higher reaches of north Uttarakhand on 27<sup>th</sup> February.

Rainfall activity is likely to decrease from 28<sup>th</sup> February. Only isolated light rainfall is likely over Uttarakhand with light snowfall over higher reaches on 28<sup>th</sup> February. Weather is likely to remain dry on 01<sup>st</sup> & 02<sup>nd</sup> March followed by isolated light rain/snow on 03<sup>rd</sup> March due to a fresh Western Disturbance.

**The maximum temperatures are above normal by 6-8°C over most parts of Uttarakhand as per the observations. The maximum temperatures likely to fall by 2-4°C by today, the 27<sup>th</sup> February.**

**Date-wise weather forecast for Chamoli district of Uttarakhand:**

<b>28 Feb 2021</b>	Generally cloudy sky becoming partly cloudy sky from afternoon. <b>Light rainfall (upto 2.5 mm)</b> over northern parts of the district with possibility of <b>light snowfall (upto 2.5 cm)</b> over higher reaches of the district during forenoon.
<b>01 March 2021</b>	Partly cloudy sky. No rainfall/snowfall likely, mainly dry weather likely to prevail.
<b>02 March 2021</b>	Partly cloudy sky. No rainfall/snowfall likely, mainly dry weather likely to prevail.

<b>03 March 2021</b>	Partly cloudy sky. No rainfall/snowfall likely, mainly dry weather likely to prevail.

Maximum Temperature : 17.0 °C Minimum Temperature: 8.0 °C
<b>28 Feb 2021</b>	Generally cloudy sky becoming partly cloudy sky from afternoon with possibility of <b>light to moderate rainfall (upto 2.5 mm) /snowfall (upto 2.5 cm) during forenoon</b>  Maximum Temperature : 19.0°C Minimum Temperature : 5.0°C
<b>01 March 2021</b>	Partly cloudy sky. Dry weather likely to prevail.  Maximum Temperature : 19.0°C Minimum Temperature : 6.0° C

**Outlook for 04<sup>th</sup> -08<sup>th</sup> March, 2021 for rainfall/snowfall over Chamoli District:**

In association with two more fresh Western Disturbances, in quick succession, **light rainfall (5 mm)** over northern parts of the district with possibility of light **snowfall (upto 5 cm)** over higher reaches of the district during 04<sup>th</sup>-08<sup>th</sup> March, 2021.
