Press Release: WARNING FOR HEAVY TO VERY HEAVY RAINFALL

Chief amount of Rainfall in last 24 Hours (> 5 cm):

Tezpur (dist Sonitpur) 9 Bhomoraguri (dist Sonitpur) 7 N/Lakhimpur (dist Lakhimpur) 4 Nt Xing (Ranganadi) (dist Lakhimpur) 4 Hazuwa (dist Barpeta) 4 Chouldhowaghat (dist Lakhimpur) 4 Kheronighat (dist Karbi Anglong) 4

Current Meteorological Conditions:

- 1. An upper air cyclonic circulation lies over northeast Assam & neighbourhood at 0.9 km above mean sea Level.
- 2. An upper air cyclonic circulation lies over Bangladesh & Adjoining Gangetic West Bengal in between 1.5 and 5.8 km above mean sea Level tilting southwards with height.


Under the influence of the above synoptic condition moderate rainfall at many to most places with heavy to very heavy rain at isolated places on 22nd & 23rd June 2025 along with thunderstorm and Lightning over the districts Mentioned below.



Forecast & Warnings (Heavy to very Heavy with Extremely Heavy) Based Upon (0830 hrs. IST)	22-06-2025	Heavy (7-11 cm in 24 Hrs) to Very Heavy rain (12-20 cm in 24 hrs) is very likely to occur at isolated places over the districts of Dhubri, Kokrajhar, Dibrugarh, Tinsukia accompanied by Thunderstorm with Lightning.
	23-06-2025	Heavy (7-11 cm in 24 Hrs) to Very Heavy rain (12-20 cm in 24 hrs) is very likely to occur at isolated places over the districts of Dibrugarh, Tinsukia accompanied by Thunderstorm with Lightning.
Impact Expected	Water logging, flooding may occur in some low-lying areas Landslides, landslips and mud-slips may occur in vulnerable areas Uprooting of trees & breaking of tree branches may take place Boats and ferry services may be affected Water logging in roads/ uprooting of trees/ breaking of tree branches/ strong wind may affect road & Rail traffic leading to increased travel time. Visibility may become poor due to intense spell of rainfall. Heavy rainfall may damage the crop in the maturity stage. Partial Damages to vulnerable structures due to wind, rain & uprooting of trees. Temporary disruption of power and municipality services. Lightning may injure people and cattle at open place. Temporary disruption to the communication and power etc. Possibilities of Flash floods due to intense spell of rainfall.	

Action Suggested

- People are requested to keep a watch on the weather for worsening conditions.
- Follow traffic advisories.
- Avoid staying in vulnerable structure.
- Take safe shelters.
- Provide proper drainage in the cropped field if heavy rainfall is expected.
- Avoid/minimize commuting to areas that face water logging problem often.
- Avoid landslide, landslip, mud-slip, flash flood prone areas. Follow latest weather warning, SDMA and NDMACAP.
