Daily Weather Report & Forecast Bulletin

- The line of withdrawal of Southwest Monsoon continues to pass through 32.5°N/72.5°E, Gurdaspur, Chandigarh, Muzaffarnagar, Aligarh, Dholpur, Udaipur, Deesa, Naliya and 23.0°N/67.8°E.
- The Low-Pressure Area over northern parts of central Uttar Pradesh has become less marked at 0530 hrs IST of today, the 28th September 2026. However, the associated upper air cyclonic circulation lies over East Uttar Pradesh between 1.5 & 3.1 km above mean sea level.
- The Western Disturbance now seen as a cyclonic circulation over north Pakistan & adjoining Jammu between 5.8 & 7.6 km above mean sea level.

SIGNIFICANT WEATHER FEATURES

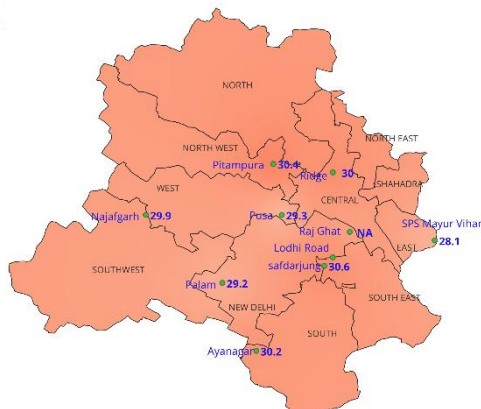
- Southwest Monsoon has withdrawn from Delhi on 23rd September 2026 against its normal date of withdrawal 25th September (1971-2019). In 2025, it withdrew from Delhi on 24th September 2025.
- Since 1961, the earliest withdrawal of monsoon was in 1982 when it withdrew from Delhi on 3rd September and the most delayed withdrawal was in 2013 when it withdrew on 17th October.
- This year, monsoon made its onset over Delhi on 2nd July, 2026 against its normal onset date of 27th June (1961-2019).
- Up to September 23rd, 728.6 mm of rainfall has been recorded over Delhi (Safdarjung) since 1st June 2026 against the normal value of 629.7 mm. The actual rainfall is 16% above the normal rainfall which lies in the category of 'normal rainfall' (Departure +19% to -19%).

PAST WEATHER

- No large change in minimum temperatures and fall in maximum temperatures by 1-2°C over Delhi during the past 24 hours.
- The minimum temperatures are in the range of 19-23°C and maximum temperatures were in the range of 29-31°C during past 24 hours over Delhi.
- The minimum temperatures are appreciably below normal (-3.1°C to -5.0°C) at a few places normal (-1.5°C to 1.5°C) over remaining parts of Delhi.
- The maximum temperatures were below normal (-1.6°C to -3.0°C) at isolated places, appreciably below normal (-3.1°C to -5.0°C) at many places and markedly below normal (-5.1°C or less) at isolated places and over Delhi.
- Northeasterly winds speed 20-25 Kmph prevailed over Delhi during the past 24 hours.

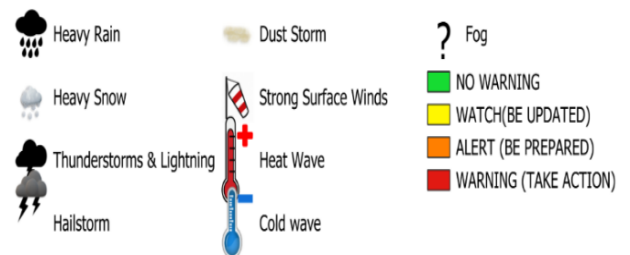
